Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley will present the Union Budget in Parliament tomorrow. This year's budget session is crucial as it comes after government's two very big financial decisions - Demonetization and Goods and Services Tax implementation. It is also National Democratic Alliance Government's fifth and last budget presentation before the Lok Sabha polls in 2019. Shri Jaitley will present the Union Budget first in the Lok Sabha and then in the Rajya Sabha.

Skygazers in Isles witness rare celestial occurrence 'Super Blue Blood Moon'

Port Blair, Jan 31
Skywatchers witnessed a rare celestial occurrence called a 'Super Blue Moon' here this evening. This rare phenomenon also called 'Blood Moon',

refers to a view of the Moon during a total lunar eclipse. It happens when a full Moon is closest to the Earth, appearing bigger and brighter than normal. It's the first total lunar

eclipse since 2015 and the first Blue Moon Blood Moon visible from the U.S. since 1866. People were seen in large numbers near the road leading from Marina Park to Govt Press.

The Port Blair Municipal Council has cautioned the candidates, who appeared for the written examination for 33 posts of LGC in PBMC on Jan.21, not to fall prey to any fraud calls & cheaters. Following some newspapers reports about some calls being received by candidates that their marks are low and these can

be increased by transferring some specified amount in particular bank accounts, the PBMC Secretary, Shri Yashpal Garg, in a press release received here today has clarified that candidates are aware that their details like names, father/husband names and telephone numbers were uploaded on the website so that they can ensure correctness of the

details and get it corrected in case of any error. This was a considered decision to ensure that all applicants with correct details are allowed to participate in the recruitment process. Since the details of the candidates were available in public domain, anyone can see that the data and hence the question of leakage does

Anu wins first gold medal of Khelo India Games in 1500m; TN wins two gold, Uttarakhand, UP, Kerala and Haryana win one each

New Delhi, Jan 31
Anu Kumar of Uttarakhand grabbed the first gold medal of the Khelo India School Games, as Tamil Nadu won two of the six gold medals on offer on the opening day of the athletics programme of the Games. While Tamil Nadu athletes took two gold medals, the rest were shared between Uttarakhand, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh and Haryana at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium this morning. Anu Kumar who trains at the sports college Raipur and is a past 800m silver medallist for India at the World School Games in France, won the 1,500m final comfortably in 4:04.77 seconds. An established middle distance star, Uttarakhand's Anu, who won the 800m silver in 1:53.59 seconds in France, has in the

past run below four minutes and at these Games. He is aiming for 800m-1,500m double. Anu dominated the race pushing B Mathesh of Tamil Nadu and Sandeep Kumar of Uttar Pradesh to silver and bronze medals. The girls 1500m saw Kathiriyi Shradha of Gujarat cross the tape first, but following a protest from one of the other teams, she was disqualified as the judges deemed her compatriot in the final lap illegally paced her. The judges awarded the gold to Kerala's promising C Chanthini, who clocked 4:50.81. In the field events there were some good performances in the boys Shot Put and triple jump events. Abhishek Singh of Uttar Pradesh won the Shot Put with an excellent throw of 18.73m while Praveen of Tamil Nadu

won the triple jump in his sixth attempt with 15.22m. Abhishek Singh had four successful throws beyond 18 metres with the best of 18.73 in his second last attempt winning him the gold. He had two other good throws of 18.54m on the last attempt and 18.38m in his second shy. Kartikay Deswal (Madhya Pradesh) bagged the silver with his sole 18 metres plus mark of 18.29. In boys Triple jump, C Praveen won with 15.22 metres in his sixth jump, while Sachin Gujar (UP) with 14.46m were second and Akash M Varghese (Kerala) with 14.27m was placed third. Haryana girls excelled in the Shot Put with two medals out of three. Pooja won the gold with a best of 13.88m while the bronze went to Rekha with a best effort of 13.20m. Ajenci

Susan of Tamil Nadu claimed the Silver with 13.39m. Pooja dominated the event with three of her throws better than silver medallist. In girls triple jump J Coleshiya was the winner with a best leap of 12.29m, while Sandra Babu (Kerala) was right behind her in second place at 12.27m and PM Tabitha (TN) was third with a best of 11.95m. Day 2 of the athletics competition will see nine more medals being decided with three in boys section and four in girls. The boys finals will be in Long Jump (10 am), Javelin throw (10 am) and 200m (12.30 pm), while the scheduled girls finals are Pole vault (10 am), long jump (11.40 am), javelin (11.45 am) and 200m (12.40 pm).

Virat Kohli and crew eye No 1 rank while taking on upbeat Proteas in ODI series

Capetown, Jan 31
After a gruelling Test series that did not quite end the way the Indians would have imagined, it's time for Virat Kohli and Co to shift their attention to the limited-overs leg of the ongoing tour and aim for a fresh start. The Indian contingent received a wake-up call from the South Africans in the first two Tests following a dominant run back home, and in challenging overseas conditions, were outdone both in terms of planning as well as execution, eventually going on to surrender the series. Winning the third and final Test at the Wanderers, especially on a pitch that started misbehaving as early as the second day and was later rated "poor" by the ICC, would come as a much-

needed morale booster for the Indian camp and they will certainly hope to carry that momentum as they take off the whites to don the blue jerseys in the six-match ODI series that starts on Thursday. MS Dhoni turning up in South Africa will be of great help for Virat Kohli in his captaincy. While it remains to be seen how Dhoni fares against the South African seam attack on the fast wickets, Kohli surely will have less trouble taking reviews with him around. And given the amount of on-field banter that TV viewers got to hear in the Test series, especially from the slip cordon, one can well imagine what it will be like with Dhoni behind the stumps. For the Indians, avenging the

Test series loss won't be the only motive in the one-dayers, as the No 1 spot in the ICC rankings is also up for grabs provided they win the series by a 4-2 scoreline or better. Kohli, who has had a lot of tough press conferences to deal with in recent weeks, will hope to keep the pumped up celebrations going come Thursday. **Squads:**

All concerned may refer the repeated advisories that neither any officer nor any political person has any authority to interfere with the process. All were clearly advised not to approach anybody either in the Council or elsewhere and in case any person approaches with false promises then a complaint should be immediately lodged with the Police. In one case a complaint was received by the PBMC Secretary in the evening of 30.01.2018 about receiving a call for Rs. 50,000/- to get higher marks. The matter was immediately reported to the Police for further investigation and action as per the law. Since the complainant gave details like phone number and the bank account number of the caller, every effort will be made to take the complaint at logical conclusion. There is every possibility that few more candidates may be approached by such fraud/cheats. All have been advised not to come in their trap and immediately lodge complaint with the Police. The whole process of the examination is being done in highly transparent and fair manner. Those candidates who have performed well will surely get selected, the release added.
