Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin)

To accelerate the efforts to achieve universal sanitation coverage and put focus on sanitation, the Govt. of India has restructured 'Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan' (NBA) as 'Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin)', launched on 02nd October, 2014 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

The main objective of the SBM(G) is to bring about an improvement in the general quality of life in the rural areas, by promoting cleanliness, hygiene and eliminating open defecation to achieve the vision of Swachh Bharat by 2nd October 2019.

Financial Incentives under the SBM-G

The incentive amount provided by the Ministry of Drinking Water & sanitation under SBM(G) are as follows:

- For Below Poverty Line (BPL) / Identified APLs households financial incentive is Rs. 12,000/- for construction of one unit of Individual Households Latrines.
- For Community Sanitary Complex, the maximum support per unit prescribed is Rs.2 lakh. The Community contribution, however, can be made by the Panchayat out of its own resources.
- For Solid & Liquid Waste Management (SLWM) under SBM(G), the total assistance projects shall be worked out on the basis of total number of households in each GP, subject to a maximum of Rs.7 lakh for a GP having up to 150 households, Rs.12 lakh up to 300 households, Rs.15 lakh up to 500 households and Rs.20 lakh for GPs having more than 500 households. 100 % Funding for SLWM project under SBM(G) is provided by the Central Government.

• APL families not covered by the above incentives will be motivated and triggered to take up construction of the household latrines on their own. APL families facing fund problems may be assisted through the Revolving fund as outlined in the guidelines, or through low cost financing from NABARD, Banks and Financial Institutions.

The Government of India has desired that the UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands should complete the construction of toilets under SBM-G before 31.03.2018 so that this UT could be declared Open Defecation Free (ODF) and Swachh by March, 2018.

All the general public of rural areas of this UT are hereby requested to avail the benefit of the scheme and contribute to make this UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands "Swachh" by March, 2018.

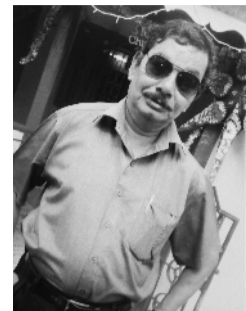

Jitu wins bronze in ISSF World Cup

New Delhi, Feb 28
Ace pistol shooter Jitu Rai staged a remarkable comeback to clinch the bronze medal in the 10m air pistol event for India's fourth podium finish in the ongoing ISSF World Cup here on Tuesday. The 29-year-old shot a total of 216.7 in the eight-man final to finish third on the podium. The Asian Games and World Championships silver-medallist was languishing at the seventh position after the end of the first competition series that included an 8.8. But he clawed his way back with two 10.6 and a 10 in the second competition series. At the end of that series, Rai was placed sixth with a total of 98.7. He managed to maintain the status quo even as the final entered the elimination stage at the Dr Karni Singh Shooting Range. He shot two 10s in the following shots to continue his gradual ascent. The Army man roared back to contention with a couple of 10.6 and ensured a bronze with a 9.9, finishing ahead of China's Zhanyi Xu (197.9). With a lead of 0.1 point over Vietnam's Xuang Vinh Hoang, Rai was in the hunt for a silver but an 8.6 meant he had to be content with the bronze. The gold went to Japan's Tomoyuki Matsuda with a world record total of 240.1 points, while Vietnam's Xuan Vinh Hoang claimed silver with 236.6 points. The other Indian shooters in the fray in the air pistol event -- Omkar Singh and Amanpreet Singh -- failed to cross the qualification stage.

reasons like mismatch in aadhaar number, incorrect account number and technical failure during the initial period of August to Oct. 2016. To set right these issues, departments has made public awareness campaign through Print Media, PRIs, Anganwadi Workers and camps to inform those beneficiaries to submit details who have not been credited monthly allowances. Besides, grievance redressal camps were also conducted in many places (Rangat, Diglipur, Mayabunder, Wimberlygunj, Kamorta, Ferrar Gunj, Little Andaman etc). Accordingly altogether 3329 beneficiaries whose payments were earlier rejected have been paid. Still, department is receiving aadhaar number from the beneficiaries (who have not submitted earlier) and is being attended on case to case basis. Their pensions are credited in their respective account through PFMS. The issue of the nonpayment is basically for the initial months from August to Oct. 2016 for which action has already been initiated as mentioned above.
