verdict 27.2.2018 sentencing accused Subrata Biswas, a resident of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to imprisonment for life and to pay a fine of Rs. 50,000 in default to suffer rigorous imprisonment for

a further period of three months for the offence punishable under section 6 of the POCSO Act for ravishing his step daughter, a minor aged 13 years, studying in class IX.

CBSE grants one time relaxation in passing marks for class 10 students

New Delhi, Feb 28

In a major relief to students of class 10th who will write their board exams next week, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has decided to grant a one-time relaxation in pass marks. The board has decided to implement overall 33 per cent pass mark criteria for this batch of students only. They will not require to secure 33 per cent separately in board exams and internal assessments.

Earlier, the board had put in place a mandatory clause of securing 33 per cent in the board exams and another 33 per cent in internal assessment. The class 10 exams will be mandatory from this year after a gap of seven years. The Human Resource Development Ministry had made the board examination for class 10 optional from 2010-11 batch.

Roger Federer wins Sportsman & Comeback of the Year awards at Laureus

Monaco, Feb 28
Twenty-times Grand Slam champion Roger Federer has won the 2017 Laureus World Sportsman of the Year and Comeback of the Year awards. The 36-year old Swiss star bagged the honour last night at the 18th edition of the awards ceremony in Monaco. Federer, who returned to the world number one ranking, had clinched the Australian Open and Wimbledon titles last year after the seven year break of winning any major. He won this year's Australian Open also. Serena Williams took home the World Sportswoman of the Year



award after winning her 23rd grand slam in 2017. Formula 1 constructors' champions Mercedes picked up the Team of the Year trophy, while wheelchair athlete Marcel Hug bagged the Sportsperson of the Year with a Disability.

Jhulan Goswami, the experienced pacer, hasn't been named in the 15-member Indian squad for the upcoming three-match ODI series against Australia Women as she is undergoing a rehabilitation programme after sustaining a heel injury during the recently-concluded tour of South Africa. Sukanya Parida, the 24-year-old medium pacer from Bengal, will replace the veteran cricketer. Parida made her ODI debut against the Windies in Vijayawada in November

community based model which will help patients during emergency. The model is made up of natural resources like Bamboo and cane and is equipped with GPRS, offline map, infrared sensor, sonar, magnetic compass, rain sensor and camera. At the time of distress, the patient can be evacuated from the remote location to the nearby hospital for medical care. The model also has medical kit for blood pressure, blood sugar and ECG monitoring and the real time data will be stored in the attached mobile, which will be useful for the doctors. Considering the geographical situation of the Islands, the model will be very useful. The Principal of the school, Shri. Shara Chandran G has lauded the team for their achievement.

Prosecution paraded as many as 14 witnesses through the witness box. Accused also examined two witnesses to prove the defence of his alibi. On an overall consideration of the evidence of the witnesses examined, documents proved and the medical evidence of the doctor, the learned Special Judge found the accused guilty under section 5(b) of the POCSO Act and convicted him on 26.2.2018. The offence being visited with the punishment which may extend to imprisonment for life and fine, the Special Judge, gave the convict opportunity of making submission on the quantum of sentence till 27.2.2018 and remanded the convict to custody for reflexion of his mind. On 27.2.2017 after hearing the Special Public Prosecutor and the accused, the Special Judge observed that when the perpetrator of the crime of penetrating sexual abuse is the step father, who is the fortress refuge and the trustee of his own step daughter, it is more grave and rarest of rare, warranting a strong and deterrent judicial hand and that in ordinary criminal terminology rape is a crime more heinous than a murder as it destroys the very soul of helpless girl and when Judges do bear the Sword of Justice, they should not hesitate to use that sword with the utmost severity to the full and to the end if the gravity of the offence so demands. Having considered the entire aspect of the nature and gravity of the offence and the circumstance under which it was committed, the Special Judge considered it to be a fit case where the maximum punishment provided under law should be imposed upon the accused and passed the sentence of life imprisonment upon the accused. Miss AS Zinu, Special Public Prosecutor, conducted the prosecution in the case.

FIH announces match schedule for Hockey World Cup 2018

New Delhi, Feb 28
Sixteen of the world's best international hockey teams will take to the field to compete in the FIH Men's Hockey World Cup 2018 at the 16,000-capacity Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneswar, scheduled from November 28 to December 16. The venue is currently undergoing extensive refurbishment in preparation for the prestigious event. Hosts India were joined by teams who qualified through the last year's Hockey World League Semi-Finals competitions in London and Johannesburg or by being crowned as continental champions. The 16 teams have been split into four pools of four, with Rio 2016 Olympic champions Argentina (current FIH World Ranking: 2) competing in Pool A alongside New Zealand (9th ranked), Spain (8th) and

France (18th), while reigning world champions Australia (world no. 1) take on England (7th), Ireland (11th) and China (17th) in Pool B. Rio 2016 Olympic silver medallists Belgium (3rd ranked) will compete in Pool C alongside home favourites and 1975 world champions India (6th), Canada (11th) and African continental champions South Africa (15th), with European title holders and three-time world champions the Netherlands (4th) taking on two-time champions Germany (5th), Malaysia (12th) and Pakistan (13th) - World Cup winners in 1971, 1978, 1982, 1994 - in a tough Pool D. The pool phase of the competition will take place from November 28 to December 9, with two matches per day being played at 1700 and 1900 IST respectively. Each day of action will be pool focused, with the opening day's play featuring two matches in Pool C as Shane McLeod's Belgium take on Canada before host nation India target a winning start when they face South Africa. The Kalinga Stadium is already a familiar location for hockey fans. Not only did they successfully host the 2014 Men's Hockey World League Trophy and, most recently, the Men's Hockey World League Final in 2017, it is also home to the Hockey India League franchise Kalinga Lancers, winners of the 2017 title.

Thingalaya to represent India at World Indoor C'ship

Mumbai, Feb 28
Track and field athlete Siddhant Thingalaya will represent India at the World Indoor Championship 2018 starting in Birmingham on Friday. The 27-year-old specialises in 60 metre and 110 metre hurdles and is currently training in California, a media release said. Thingalaya currently holds the National Record in both 60m indoor hurdles with a timing of 7.70 seconds set at UW preview meet at Seattle in January last year and 110 m hurdles with a time of 13.48 seconds, set at Altis Invitational Meet in the United States held in June 2017.

(Civil) No. 17135/2008 and Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, New Delhi Notification No. GSR 424(E) dated 1st May, 2017, read with Clause (f) of sub-section (1) Section 110 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) and in supersession of A & N Administration's Notification No. 36/2017/F.No.3-37/MVD/Speed Governor/ 2016 dated 10-03-2017, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby notifies that the following classes of Transport Vehicles specified conforming to the standard AIS: 018/2001 as amended from time to time, namely:-

Sl. No.	Type of Vehicle	Max. speed limit in Kms. per hour
1.	Stage carriage buses	60 kms.
2.	Buses / Vans used for transporting students	45 kms.
3.	Contract carriage with passenger and goods with seating capacity not exceeding eight passenger in addition to driver seat and not exceeding 3500 kilograms GVW (M1 Category)	60 kms.
4.	Contract carriages with seating capacity exceeding 8+1	60 kms.
5.	Goods vehicles exceeding 3500 kilograms gross vehicle weight (GVW) except dumpers, tankers and those carrying hazardous goods.	60 kms.
6.	Dumpers, tankers and those carrying hazardous goods.	45 kms.

Conditions:

The Speed Governor shall be fitted in respect of:-

- (a) Vehicles manufactured on or after the 1st October, 2015 shall be equipped or fitted by the vehicle manufacturer either in the manufacturing stage or at the dealership stage with a speed governor (speed limiting device or speed limiting function), having maximum pre-set speed as specified in the above Table.
 - (b) The above categories of transport vehicles registered prior to 1st October, 2015, which are not already fitted with a speed governor (speed limiting device or speed limiting function) shall be equipped or fitted by the operators of those vehicles with a speed governor (speed limiting device or speed limiting function), having maximum pre-set speed as specified in the above Table within 120 days from the date of publication of the Notification in the Official Gazette/The Daily Telegrams.
- The maximum speed of such vehicles is fixed as per the above Table, under sub-section (2) of Section 112 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act 59 of 1988);
- (2) The permit granting Authority/ Registering Authority concerned in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands shall ensure that "speed governor" is fitted in each of the aforesaid classes of vehicles and the "official seal" of the permit granting Authority/ Registering Authority concerned shall be put up on such "speed governor" in such a manner that the seal cannot be removed or tampered, without the seal being broken;
 - (3) The speed governor so fitted shall be functionally capable of limiting the speed of the vehicles to the maximum speed as specified by the Government, from time to time;
 - (4) The manufacturer of the speed governor shall obtain a type approval certificate in respect of the speed governor to be fitted from any of the testing agencies referred to in rule 126 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989;
 - (5) The Registering Authority concerned or any officer authorized by the Registering Authority shall seal the points with the official seal after satisfying himself that the speed governor is capable of limiting the speed of the vehicle as specified by the Government;
 - (6) No notified vehicle required to be fitted with a speed governor shall be used in any public place unless it bears the official seal;
 - (7) No person shall open, tamper or otherwise interfere with the official seal on a speed governor;
 - (8) In case, the official seal is broken, damaged or opened due to any reason whatsoever, the vehicle shall not be used in any public place unless a new official seal is affixed by the authority concerned;
 - (9) The owner of the vehicle shall provide an inspection window on the floor of the vehicle just above the gear box or otherwise, where sensor of the speed governor is connected to the gear box for applying the official seal or for inspection of the same;
 - (10) Any officer of the Transport Department not below the rank of Motor Vehicle Inspector is authorized to stop a vehicle for such reasonable time, as is necessary to satisfy himself that the official seal is intact and the speed governor is capable of limiting the speed as specified for such vehicle notwithstanding that the official seal on the speed governor appears to be intact;
 - (11) It shall be the duty of the owner of the vehicle to train or educate the driver of the vehicle about the necessity and importance of the speed governor and the official seal therein;
 - (12) Every vehicle required to be fitted with a speed governor shall display the words "SPEED GOVERNOR INSTALLED" legibly written in English at the bottom of both front and rear wind screen. The letters shall be written in white colour and shall be of 15 cms. height with appropriate thickness;
 - (13) If, at any time, it is observed by the driver or the owner that the speed governor is not functioning properly or by any means it is observed that the speed of the vehicle does not limit to the prescribed speed, the driver or the owner shall ply the vehicles, only after necessary rectification. In such an event, it shall be necessary to obtain fresh official seal of the concerned Registering Authority or any officer authorized by the Registering Authority on the speed governor;
 - (14) The penalty provided under Section 177 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act 59 of 1988) shall apply for violation of this Notification.
