Seven airports to get rid of hand baggage tags from April 1

New Delhi, Mar 31
Stamping and tagging of the hand baggage of flyers at seven major airports, including Delhi and Mumbai, will be done away with from April 1. The CISF said today, the other airports which will see the new system of baggage security coming in include the ones in Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Cochin and Ahmedabad. CISF Director General Shri O P Singh said that it has put in place the required security systems that will help us in ushering in this passenger-friendly move. The move, the CISF chief said, will enhance "passenger experience and provide hassle free security environment to them".

The move was earlier announced by the Aviation Security Regulator, the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS). However, the Central Industrial Security Force wanted to deploy appropriate security infrastructure before such a regime could be ushered in without any compromise on the security aspect at these sensitive facilities. Shri Singh said his personnel have been updated about the new protocol and that he himself had seen the preparations made in this regard at the Bengaluru airport yesterday.

Over 14 lakh consumers rewarded for embracing Digital Payments so far

New Delhi, Mar 31
More than 14 lakh consumers and 77 thousand merchants have been rewarded till now for embracing Digital Payments. NITI Aayog said, 226 crore rupees were rewarded under Lucky Grahak Yojana and Digi Dhan Vyapar Yojana, which were launched on 25th December last year. The Ayog said, as part of the government initiative in popularizing Digital Payments, DigiDhan Melas

are being organized in 100 cities over a period of 100 days. As on 30th March, which was the 90th day, the Melas have been held in 26 States and 7 Union Territories. The 100 days of the DigiDhan Melas will end with the Mega Draw on 14th of April. NITI Aayog said, since demonetization, there has been a phenomenal 584 per cent increase in transactions made through the UPI. In this same period, payments using Adhaar have also

seen an unprecedented jump of 1352 per cent. It said, the BHIM App, the UPI payment App launched by the Prime Minister on 30th December last year, has been downloaded a record 18 million times since its launch. Besides there has been an increase of nearly 13 percent in the number of PoS machines, indicating that more number of merchants are willingly accepting digital (Contd. on last page)

Stage set for July roll-out of uniform tax regime with passage of four key-bills on GST in Lok Sabha

New Delhi, Mar 31
After an eight-hour long debate, the Lok Sabha passed four Goods and Serviced Tax (GST) related bills on Wednesday night rejecting amendments moved by the opposition. The bills passed are the Central GST bill, the Integrated GST bill, the Union Territories GST bill and the GST Compensation. The move has put the government on course for the launch of country's biggest tax reform on first of July. The bills will now be presented in the Rajya Sabha. The upper house can only suggest changes as the bills have been

presented as money bills. After Parliament's nod, a state GST bill will be

presented in State Assemblies for their (Contd. on last page)

Candidates above 25 years can appear for NEET: SC

New Delhi, Mar 31
Supreme Court allows candidates above 25 years to appear for the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) for various undergraduate courses. The apex court also extended the date for filing the forms till April 5. Earlier, a fresh petition was filed in the apex court, alleging that NEET-2 was tougher than the earlier one and the CBSE came out with a common result without

"normalization" or "rationalization" of marks obtained by the medical aspirants in these two tests. Meanwhile, the two-judge bench of the Allahabad High Court heard the affidavit from the Medical Council of India (MCI) and the Centre. The High Court had earlier on February 15 ordered the MCI, CBSE and the Centre to clarify about the imposed upper age limit of 25 years in the NEET application.

Short course on 'office procedure' organized by PTS

Revised method of Property Tax Transparent & citizen friendly; people can do self-assessment and make payment easily: PBMC

Port Blair, Mar 31
The revised method of Property Tax is being implemented by Port Blair Municipal Council w.e.f. Apr 1, 2017. In a press release received here, today, the Secretary, PBMC, Shri Yashpal Garg said that this system is better than the earlier system because of being transparent, fair, citizen friendly and professional way of assessment. It is simple to understand

and one need not visit PBMC office, instead can do self-assessment and make payment easily. There is no discretion with the Assessing Authorities, hence no scope of discrepancy. Good data base and information systems will enable better tax planning and policy making. This system is widely implemented in most of the Municipalities of the Country. The eligible persons can

avail only one of the following discounts at a time:
* 25% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of widow as per the Revenue Records.
* 25% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of handicapped person as per the certificate issued by the Social Welfare Department.
* 10% discount in case of

the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of a female as per the Revenue Records. Till 30.06.2017, a special rebate of 10% is also allowed for early payment. Expecting heavy rush for payment of Property Tax, the AXIS Bank branches at Middle Point and Bathu Basti have also been authorized to collect payment of Property Tax and self-assessment form, the release added.

Government notifies simplified ITR forms

New Delhi, Mar 31
Government today notified a new simplified Income-Tax Return Forms, ITR Forms, for individuals for the Assessment Year 2017-18. The Central Board of Direct Taxes, CBDT, in a release said, one of the major reforms made in the forms is the designing of a one page simplified ITR Form-1, called Sahaj. This ITR Form-1 can be filed by an individual having income up to 50 lakh rupees and who is receiving income from salary, one house property and other income including interest. Port Blair Municipal Council vide Resolution No. 250/MC/2016 dated 08/12/2016 resolved to adopt the method for calculation of Annual Value for Property Tax on Land and Building on Unit Area Rental Value Basis. Further the Council in its meeting held on 11.03.2017 vide Resolution No. 35 / MC/2017 dtd. 11/03/2017 has resolved to revise the Property Tax calculation. However, the rate of Property Tax will remain un-changed i.e. as provided in the By-Law-4 of the PBMC Property Tax Bye-Laws-1999. The revised methodology to work out the Annual Value is as under:

2. The rate of Property Tax on Land shall be 3% of the Annual Value as per clause-4 (a) of the PBMC Property Tax Bye-Laws notified vide Gazette Notification dated 16.12.1999.
3. Total Property Tax payable shall be sum of (1) & (2) above.

Discounts for Residential Properties

The total Property Tax calculated as per above under the Unit Area Rental Value method, will be subject to following discounts. However, eligible person can avail only one of the discounts at a time:

- 25% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of widow as per the Revenue Records.
- 25% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of a handicapped person as per the certificate issued by the Social Welfare Department.
- 10% discount in case of the Residential Property recorded exclusively in the name of a female as per the Revenue Records.

Rebate for early payment of Property Tax on all type of properties

Total Property Tax minus discount as per above, will be eligible for 10% rebate on payment of Property Tax in advance of the financial year i.e. by 30th June. For example to avail this rebate, the Property Tax for the year 2017-18 need to be paid before 30th June, 2017 and the Property Tax for the year 2018-19 needs to be paid before 30th June, 2018 and so on. This rebate will not be available for payment of earlier dues of Property Tax.

Exception: For the period upto 30th June, 2017, if some eligible person chooses to clear the past dues of property tax (for 2016-17 and earlier years) under the Revised Unit Area Rental Value method, the rebate of 10% will be available as an exception. There after the rebate of 10% for early payment will not be available for dues of property tax for earlier years.

Terms and Conditions:

- The revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment will be applicable w.e.f. 01.04.2017.
 - For the period prior to 01.04.2017, the revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment can be adopted by the eligible persons as their choice. Accordingly, those persons who have not yet paid Property Tax for the year 2016-17 or of earlier years, they may either pay as per the existing system (where the assessor will visit and calculate the tax) or may avail following options:
 - In case of hotels to have self-assessment as per the revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment and clear the dues by 30.06.2017 with interest @12% per annum from 01.01.2011 onwards.
 - In case of other properties to have self-assessment as per the revised Unit Area Rental Value method of assessment and clear the dues by 30.06.2017.
 - Those persons, who have already paid their applicable Property Tax, are not eligible for re-assessment and claim of refund.
- All concerned may download the self-assessment form from the website of www.andaman.gov.in. Further the self-assessment forms can also be obtained from the Revenue Section, Port Blair Municipal Council on any working day.

India Open Super Series 2017: PV Sindhu downs Saina Nehwal to enter semi-final

New Delhi, Mar 31 PV Sindhu defeated Saina Nehwal in a fiercely contested women singles quarter-final of the 2017 India Open Super Series here on Friday. It was a contest that was the talk of the town right after the draws for the India Open Super Series were announced - Saina and Sindhu in the same half. India's two leading shuttlers up against each other at an international event - only the second time at this level. However, Sindhu engaged Saina in engaging dribble game to chalk out a 21-16, 22-20 win in straight games and enter the semi-finals. A good crowd had gathered at the Siri Fort Complex to witness the two Olympic medallists. And it was hard to ascertain whose side it was on.



They were quickly drowned out by an equally loud "Sindhu! Sindhu!". Amidst the vociferous crowd, both the players refused to give each other any edge with the initial exchanges and lucky escapes locking them at 7-7 in the first game. Both forced each other back and forth, attacking and defending. But Saina slowly started committing errors allowing Sindhu to take the lead and despite some lovely deft shots and controlled play, ended up conceding the first game to the Rio Olympic silver medallist at 16-21. When the play recommenced, Saina took the serve and the lead. A lead of 4-1 signalled Saina, the London Games bronze medalist had picked up the pace. Hailing the move Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi congratulated the countrymen on passing of GST Bill in Lok Sabha. In a tweet Shri Modi said, it is New Year, New Bill and New India. Union Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley calling it a very significant step forward said, we seem to be on time and are reasonably optimistic about meeting the deadline. Replying to the debate, Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley said, the GST will ensure free flow of goods and services across the country. He said, the goods will become slightly cheaper after multiplicity of taxes is removed. To the opposition's objection to a GST with multiple rate slabs, the Finance Minister said, if there are no multiple rates, it will become a highly regressive tax as some goods are essential for the poor. Shri Jaitley also said the division of powers between the centre and the states on taxes are clearly defined in the bill.
