Farm Scientists should make Agriculture viable, profitable and sustainable: VP

New Delhi, Mar 31
The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu called upon Farm Scientists to focus on making agriculture viable, profitable and sustainable, besides ensuring home-grown food security to meet the needs of a burgeoning population. He was interacting with the Agricultural Researchers on 'Doubling Farm Income by 2022 in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana' at ICAR - Indian Institute of Rice Research, in Hyderabad today.

The Vice President posed several questions to the scientists and elicited their responses on how their research was translating to empower the farmers. Asking them to come out with innovative and out-of-



box solutions to meet the challenges faced by farmers, the Vice President said "A happy farmer makes a happy country". "We know the problems. What are the solutions, what are the new ideas... what is the way forward to take technology to the farmers" he asked.

He pointed out that lack of quality seeds is one of the problems faced by farmers. Similarly, another issue that needed attention was rising input costs. Crop diversification and promoting allied farming activities like backyard poultry were equally important to increase

farmers' income. He also wanted the scientists to make e-NAM more popular with the farming community. Stressing the need for home-grown food security, he said both productivity and production have to be increased as the country

An ICAR- CIARI Initiative

Drudgery reduction in coconut cultivation; devices distributed to tribal farmers

Port Blair, Mar. 31

Coconut is the mainstay crop of the Nicobarese tribe of the Bay Islands. To support these tribal farmers with superior technologies on drudgery reducing machineries, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair organized a demonstration and distribution programme at the Harminder Bay village of Little Andaman Island. Under the All India Coordinated Research Project on Palms of the Institute, Dr. Ajit Waman, Principal Investigator of the project, carried out demonstrations on use of coconut climbing devices for harvesting of coconut from palms and machinery for dehusking the mature coconuts. Local youth took active participation in the demonstration and they agreed the ease of operation of the devices



for routine works. Under the Scheduled Tribe Component scheme of the Institute, these devices were distributed to about

45 tribal farmers of the village. Smt. Kitty Hilton, First Headman and Shri N. Festus, Secretary, Tribal Council, Harminder Bay

appreciated the efforts of ICAR-CIARI in improving the livelihood of tribal community. They also expressed happiness over the usefulness of the climbing devices distributed during last year by the Institute. The tribal farmers felt improvement of efficiency in coconut cultivation and processing activities through use of drudgery reducing machineries. The whole

Carrying out digging, other works close to power line People urged to obtain prior permission from Electricity Department

Port Blair, Mar. 31
It has been reported by the site engineers of Electricity Department that high tension underground power cables laid alongside the road are getting damage due to excavation / digging of earth. The damage of underground cable is causing serious threat of electrocution while doing such works without taking clearance and also consumers of the concerned area are forced to face prolonged power interruption. Sudden

failure of UG power cables are also damaging the DG sets and allied equipments. In-spite of repeated notices through media, the activity of earth digging/excavation in Port Blair and South Andaman areas are continuing unchecked, without notice to Electricity Department.

All such Departments, Telecom companies, semi-private organizations, private organization and general public have been once again asked to obtain prior permission from the

Electricity Department before carrying out the digging work or other work close to power line.

The Electricity Department will not be held responsible for any accident occurred in the due course of unauthorized work without obtaining prior permission. Cost of the damaged underground cables and loss of revenue due to interruption of power supply shall be levied from the party, a communication from the Electricity Department said.

Towards more accountable & transparent functioning

A&N Islands Municipal Regulation amended

Port Blair, Mar. 31
The Central Government vide the notification dated 26th March 2018 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Municipal) Amendment Regulation, 2018 in the Gazette of India has amended the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Municipal) Regulation 1994. The amendments have already come into effect from the date of Gazette notification i.e. 26th March 2018. The notification is available on the websites like www.egazette.nic.in,

www.andaman.gov.in, www.and.nic.in
The amendments in the Municipal Regulations are the part of ongoing reform measures to ensure more efficient, effective, accountable and transparent functioning. The main features of the amendments are as follows:
1. Appointment of Ombudsman for making investigations and inquiries, in respect of charges on any action involving corruption or maladministration or irregularities in the

discharge of administrative functions by the member or the Municipality. The Ombudsman shall investigate into any allegation contained in a complaint or on a reference from the Government, or that has come to the notice. The Ombudsman to inquire into any complaint in which corruption or maladministration of a member or a Municipality is alleged.
2. The provisions of anti-defection have been made

Women T20I tri-series: Australia beat England to claim series after record total

Mumbai, Mar 31
Skipper Meg Lanning's blazing knock helped Australia reach a record total before Megan Schutt led a brilliant bowling performance to beat arch-rivals England by 57 runs in the title clash of the women's T20 tri-series here on Saturday. Australia rode on a stunning display by Lanning (88*) and Elyse Villani (51 of 30 balls) as they amassed 209/4, the highest-ever total in a women's T20 International, surpassing the previous best of 204/1 posted by South Africa against Netherlands in 2010. The Southern Stars then performed with the ball by restricting England to 152/9, winning the game with ease. England had a bad start and were teetering at 14/2 with Breyonny Smith and Tamsin Beaumont falling for ducks on a placid track at the Brabourne Stadium. But Opener Danielle Wyatt (34



off 17 balls) made her intentions clear by hitting three boundaries in the very first over. Wyatt was going well and was poised for a big score, but after two consecutive boundaries she failed to get the elevation and gave a sitter to Lanning at cover off Delissa Kimmince, with England struggling at 47/3. Natalie Sciver (50 off 42 balls) waged a lone battle but that was not enough as the target was

well out of their reach. Wickets kept tumbling at regular intervals as Australian bowlers did not allow the English batters to settle. Amy Jones (30), Fran Wilson (14), Alice Davidson Richards (1), Sophie Ecclestone (2) fell cheaply as England were never in the game. For the Aussies Schutt (3/14) was the pick of bowlers, claiming two wickets in the 18th

over. She was superbly aided by Ashleigh Gardner (2/20), Delissa Kimmince (2/35) and Ellyse Perry (1/35). Earlier, asked to bat, Australia had a shaky start with opener Beth Mooney (0) falling early. But then Alyssa Healy (33 off 24 balls) and Gardener (33 off 20 balls) steered the team out of trouble in their 61-run second wicket stand. The Aussies raced to 62/1 in seven overs.

Sameer Verma enters semifinals of Orleans Open

Orleans, France, Mar 31
Sameer Verma has entered the semi-finals of the Orleans Open World Super 100 Badminton tournament in France. At the Palais des sports which is an indoor sports complex in the city of Orleans, the Indian recorded a hard-fought win over local hope Lucas Corvee in three games 17-21, 21-19, 21-15.



The match lasted an hour and eight minutes. The top-seeded Sameer will next face fourth-seeded Mark Caljouw of the

Netherlands. In another fixture, fifth-seeded Parupalli Kashyap lost 18-21, 14-21 to third-seeded Rasmus Gemke of Denmark. In the men's doubles, the Indian pair of Francis Alwin and K Nandagopal also suffered a 21-19, 14-21, 8-21 loss to third-seeded German combo of Mark Lamsfuss and Marvin Emil Seidel.

applicable and a member of the Municipality may be disqualified in case of joining another political party.

3. Any no-confidence motion against Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson shall also contain a proposal for election of new Chairperson or Vice-Chairpersons.
4. Specific provisions for elections through Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs).
5. The duties and functions of the Municipal Authorities have been fine-tuned to maintain balance of authority and responsibility for better accountability.
6. The procedure of disciplinary action and imposition of penalty against the officers/officials of the Municipality has been provided on the lines of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules.
7. The amounts of fines for violation of provisions will now be notified from time to time.

The amendments in the Municipal Regulation will bring more stability with efficiency, effectively, accountability and transparency in functioning of the PBMC. The institutionalized oversight mechanism in the form of Ombudsman will be a deterrent for corrupt activities and it would also function as a grievance redressal mechanism for the public. The provision for disciplinary actions on the lines of CCS(CCA) Rules will not only bring fairness but will also ensure better accountability of the Officers/officials of the Council. The revision and rationalization of penalties through notifications in Rules will make these more realistic to the changing times and circumstances for better enforcement, a communication said.
