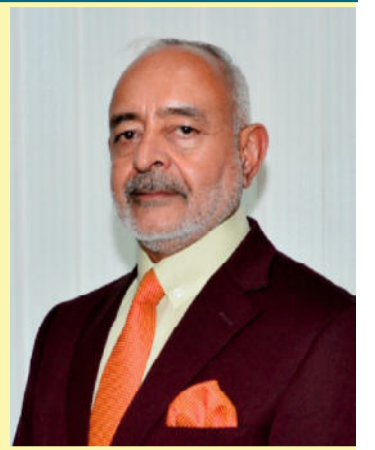
MESSAGE

Minimum Wages based on Variable Dearness Allowance across all employments revised in A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 30

The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands has revised the Minimum Rates of Wages across all Employments in addition to Govt. Departments/Offices/ Industrial Establishments by taking into account the Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) based on average rise in All India Consumer

Price Index as mandated under the provisions of "Code on Wages, 2019" in the UT of A & N Islands w.e.f. 1st July, 2026. The Revised Rates of Minimum Wages are as under:

Category of employee	Minimum wage per day
Unskilled	660.00
Semi-Skilled/Unskilled Supervisory	741.00
Skilled/Clerical	864.00
Highly Skilled	947.00

All employers of the establishments have been requested to comply with the revised rates failing which punitive action as per the provisions of Code on Wages, 2019 shall be initiated, a press release from Labour Commissioner & DET said.

Central sector scheme financing facility under Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF)

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 30

The Modern agricultural infrastructure is vital for enhancing agricultural growth and productivity in the Islands. It improves post-harvest management, reduces losses and strengthens market access and value addition. Infrastructure development also ensures balanced regional growth and optimum utilization of limited resources, thereby supporting sustainable agriculture and better farmer livelihoods.

Under the Central Sector Scheme -

Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF) medium long-term debt financing facility for investment in viable projects for post-harvest management infrastructure and community farming through assets incentives and financial support is provided to improve agriculture infrastructure in the country.

The financing facility will be provided by banks and financial institutions as loans to Primary Agriculture Credit Societies (PACS), Marketing Cooperative Societies, Farmer

Producers Organizations (FPOs), Self Help Groups (SHGs), Farmers, Joint Liability Groups (JLG), Multi purpose Cooperative Societies, Agri-entrepreneurs, Startups and Central/State agency or Local Body sponsored Public Private Partnership Project for investment in viable projects for post-harvest management infrastructure and community farming through assets incentives and financial support in order to improve agriculture infrastructure in the country.

All loans under this financing facility will have interest subvention of 3% per annum upto a limit of Rs. 2.0 Crore. This subvention will be available for a period of 7 years.

The eligible projects which can be taken under AIF include Post Harvest Management Projects and viable projects for building community farming assets include:

Post Harvest Management Projects:

- ♦ Supply Chain Services including e-marketing platforms
- ♦ Warehouse/Pack

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Healthcare Facilities urged to ensure strict adherence to Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 30

It is brought to the knowledge of all concerned that, under the provisions of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, every biomedical waste generator is required to obtain authorization for the generation, handling, treatment, processing and disposal of biomedical waste. Further, under the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, all such facilities are mandated to obtain Consent to Establish (CTE), Consent to Operate (CTO) and renewal thereof, from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC).

However, it has been observed that several Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) operating in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands are required to strengthen compliance with the above statutory provisions.

Therefore, all Healthcare Facilities



both Government and Private are hereby urged to ensure strict adherence to the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 (as amended), particularly with respect to the following:

1. All HCFs shall obtain valid Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent

to Operate (CTO) under the Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981, along with authorization under BMWM Rules, 2016 from the Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) through the OCMMS portal (<https://anocmms.nic.in>).

The general public have been informed that the Town Vending Committee (TVC), SVPNC shall conduct a survey of street vendors within the jurisdiction of SVPNC, in accordance with the provisions of the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014.

The survey shall be conducted Ward-wise from 6th July, 2026 onwards, as per the following approved schedule, by duly

constituted Survey Teams, for the purpose of establishing the genuineness of street vendors.

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South Andaman Forest Division seizes wildlife articles in three different cases

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 30 On 25/06/2026, during a routine vehicle check at the Forest Check Post, Ferrargunj under Tusnabad Range, the Forest Department intercepted an LMV at about 1700 hrs coming from Mayabunder proceeding towards Sri Vijaya Puram. On inspection, the checking team recovered 0.720 kg of Wild Boar meat, 0.800 kg of Sea Turtle meat, and 35.350 kg of suspected venison from the vehicle. All the contraband were seized alongwith the vehicle and the accused were arrested as per the provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. After completing all codal formalities the accused was produced before the Hon'ble Court. The accused has been remanded in judicial custody.

On 28.06.2026 based on credible inputs received from reliable source, the staff of Manglutan Range conducted a surprise check at the Chouldari Sunday market and detected a person selling

Giant Grouper fish, a species listed under Schedule I, Part E of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. Upon detection of the offence a case was registered under relevant provisions of the said Act and the accused was produced before the Hon'ble Court. The Court remanded the accused to judicial custody for 14 days. Further investigation is on to trace the source of the contraband.

On 28.06.2026 the Police staff of Police Out Post, Wimberlygunj detected a wildlife offence in which 14 Kg of Venison

was seized from the possession of two persons from Shoalbay 10 No and handed over the seized produce and the accused to the Range Officer, Mannarghat. On receipt of the seized items and the accused a case was registered under the relevant provisions of Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and arrested the accused persons. They were produced before the Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate at Sri Vijaya Puram who remanded the accused to judicial custody, a press release from DFO (SA) said.

All the Zonal Officers/DDOs/Head of Institutions have been directed to re-engage the Part time employees in their respective schools with immediate effect and to send their consolidated joining report to the Directorate by 10/07/2026 without fail for issue of DDO-wise formal engagement orders from the Directorate of Education, a press release from Department of Education said.

Healthcare Facilities urged to ensure

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As per the revised classification issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), industries are categorized into Red, Orange, Green, and White categories based on their pollution potential. Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) falling under the Red category are required to have adequate wastewater management systems and scientific waste disposal mechanisms. HCFs with 501 to more than 1000 beds are classified under the Red category, those with 201 to 500 beds under the Orange category, and HCFs with up to 200 beds under the Green category. Further, all HCFs having more than 10 beds required to install appropriate Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs) for treatment of effluents prior to discharge.

HCFs having captive incineration facilities shall have installation of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring Systems (OCEMS) with real-time data transmission to CPCB servers. The HCFs in isolated/ far flung areas can practice deep burial method for biomedical waste management (Yellow category), however shall be duly authorized and designed in accordance with standards prescribed under Schedule II of BMWM Rules, 2016.

HCFs (bedded) not connected to sewerage systems or without terminal treatment facilities shall comply with standards specified under Schedule II of BMWM Rules, 2016. HCFs connected to public sewers with terminal treatment facilities shall comply with general discharge standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. HCFs with less than 10 beds shall comply with discharge standards under Schedule II (S. No. 8). Non-bedded occupiers shall treat infectious liquid waste through disinfection prior to disposal, as per prescribed guidelines. For more information, follow the guidelines.

In view of the provisions, all the Healthcare Facilities in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands are hereby advised to ensure strict compliance with the above provisions, a press release received from Member Secretary, A&N Pollution Control Committee said.
