Hon'ble Prime Minister to launch Nasha Mukht Yuva for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Abhiyaan on Aug. 2

Nationwide 100-week Jan Bhagidari movement against substance abuse

New Delhi, July 31 (PIB)

In a major step towards realising the vision of a Nasha Mukht Bharat and Viksit Bharat 2047, the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will launch the "Nasha Mukht Yuva for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Abhiyaan" on Aug. 2, calling upon the youth of the nation to lead a people's movement against substance abuse through the spirit of Jan Bhagidari.

Responding to the Hon'ble Prime Minister's call, the campaign will be launched as a nationwide mass movement led by MY Bharat, with active participation from youth across the country. The initiative seeks to unite young citizens in a collective national mission to build a drug-free India by promoting awareness, community engagement and sustained public participation.

Inspired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister's address, nearly 10,000 locations across the country will organise simultaneous pledge ceremonies, with more than one crore youth to participate in the Nasha Mukti Pledge, reaffirming their commitment towards a drug-free



society and dedicating themselves to nation-building as Nasha Mukht Yuva Volunteers.

The campaign will witness unprecedented

participation from MY Bharat Volunteers, MY Bharat National Service Scheme (NSS) volunteers, Youth Clubs, schools, colleges, universities, non-governmental

organisations, industrial associations, and over 125 spiritual organisations, making it one of the largest youth-led public movements against substance abuse in the country.

Unlike a conventional awareness programme, the Nasha Mukht Yuva for Viksit Bharat Sankalp Abhiyaan has been conceptualised as a 100-week sustained Jan Bhagidari movement. Every Sunday over the next 100 weeks, youth-led activities will be organised across the country to encourage healthy lifestyles, strengthen community engagement and channel the energy of young people towards constructive nation-building.

The weekly activities will include sports competitions, walkathons, meditation sessions, cultural programmes, art and creative competitions, nukkad natak (street plays), awareness drives and other community engagement initiatives, aimed at sensitising society about the harmful effects of substance abuse while promoting positive social values.

Cabinet approves 'Samudra Manthan' (National Offshore Exploration Scheme) with an outlay of Rs.84,084 crore

New Delhi, July 31 (PIB)

The Union Cabinet chaired by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has approved 'Samudra Manthan' - the National Offshore Exploration Scheme, a Central Sector Scheme of the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas with an approved outlay of Rs.84,084 crore for implementation up to FY 2030-31.

The Scheme translates the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision, articulated from the Red Fort on Independence Day 2025, of a modern-day Samudra Manthan to unlock India's vast offshore energy potential. It marks a landmark step towards strengthening India's energy security, accelerating domestic exploration and production, promoting technological leadership, and advancing the vision of Viksit Bharat.

The Scheme

encompasses a comprehensive set of interventions across the offshore exploration value chain. It provides for large-scale acquisition, processing and interpretation of high-quality seismic data, accelerated deepwater and ultra-deepwater exploratory drilling, scientific drilling in frontier basins, development of common offshore production and evacuation infrastructure, and establishment of an integrated Oil & Gas Manufacturing and Services Zone. It also includes dedicated provisions for digital programme management, capacity

adoption, stakeholder engagement and international outreach, creating an integrated ecosystem to accelerate offshore exploration and production in the country.

Samudra Manthan is expected to catalyse reserve accretion of over 600 Million Metric Tons of Oil Equivalent (MMTOE), substantially increase offshore exploration activity, promote higher domestic oil and gas production, generate large-scale employment, strengthen indigenous manufacturing under Make in India and Atmanirbhar Bharat, (Contd. on last page)

Reproductive and Child Health - II, Union Territory Health Mission, A&N Islands in association with Directorate of Health Services will be observing World Breastfeeding Week across the Andaman & Nicobar Islands from 1st August to 7th August, 2026 under the theme "Breastfeeding for a Sustainable Start in Life: Strengthen What Works." The theme emphasizes tracking progress, evaluating impact, and scaling up proven interventions that improve breastfeeding outcomes while strengthening support systems for mothers and infants.



During the week, awareness activities will be organized to inform, educate, and empower governments, health systems, workplaces, communities, and families to create and sustain breastfeeding-friendly environments. Special emphasis will be laid on breastfeeding within 1 hour of birth, exclusive breastfeeding for the

first six months of life, followed by continued breastfeeding along with appropriate complementary feeding up to two years of age or beyond.

The Directorate of Health Services, in collaboration with the Union Territory Health Mission, will undertake extensive Information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities at both

community and health facility levels. Health-care providers will utilize every available contact opportunity to counsel pregnant women, lactating mothers, and family members on the importance and benefits of optimal breastfeeding practices.

Government Officers will be penalised up to Rs. 10,000 for delay in public services

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 31

The Andaman & Nicobar Administration has drafted the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Right to Public Services) Regulation, 2026, a major citizen-friendly reform that makes Government officials personally accountable for delays in delivering notified public services.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

> Get notified Government services within the prescribed time.
> If your service is delayed, you do not need to file the first appeal. The case will be automatically sent to the Grievance Redressal Officer.

> The Grievance Redressal Officer must acknowledge your grievance within 3 days and ensure action is taken.

> If you are still not satisfied, you can appeal to the Designated Authority and then to the UT Appellate Authority, whose decision will be final.

DELAY HAS A COST

Government officers responsible for unnecessary delays can face a penalty of Rs. 1,000 to Rs. 10,000 per service.

The penalty will be recovered directly from the

salary of the concerned officer.

COMPENSATION FOR CITIZENS

In deserving cases, citizens may also receive compensation from a portion of the penalty recovered from the defaulting officer.

Pashu Pushti Kits & Hybrid Napier Stem Cuttings distributed to livestock farmers

The Department of AH&VS distributed Pashu Pushti kits and Hybrid Napier stem cuttings to livestock farmers at their doorstep today in New Bimblitan village and Kamraj Nagar. These nutritional support kits distributed through the Senior Veterinary Officer, Veterinary Hospital Garacharma & team is aimed at improving the overall health, immunity and productivity of the animals.

During the distribution, the team



briefed the beneficiaries about the proper usage of the kits and advised them on scientific animal husbandry practices, including balanced feeding, provision of adequate clean water and regular health monitoring for better results. A total of five

Pashu Pushti kits consisting of chelated mineral mixture, mineral block, protein extract, Hercul-P and probiotic Hepacin were provided to farmers whose animals had undergone Embryo Transfer Technology (ETT).

In addition, with the

objective of promoting fodder cultivation among livestock owners, 3000 Hybrid Napier stem cuttings were distributed to 10 livestock farmers at their doorstep in New Bimblitan. The fodder cuttings were supplied by the Senior Veterinary Officer, Government Fodder Farm, Livestock Farm Complex, Dollygunj. Hybrid Napier is a high-yielding perennial fodder variety that can significantly improve the availability of green fodder at the farm level
