CCEA approves initiatives to address issues ailing to construction sector

New Delhi, Aug 31 Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) today approved short term and long term initiatives to address the issues ailing the construction sector. Briefing media in New Delhi today, Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley said, the new norms will help in quicker resolution of disputes to kick start stalled projects and make access to easier financing. He said, it is important to quickly address the issues related to the construction sector, which contributes eight per cent to the country's gross domestic product. The Finance Minister said, the government and the Reserve Bank of India will also consider to de-stress stalled construction projects to help improve liquidity in the short run. Highlighting some advantages of the new norms, Shri Jaitley said, wherever there are disputes pending between public bodies and construction sector under the old arbitration Act, which was time consuming, there will be an option with consent to shift toward to the new arbitration procedures where there is a procedure (Contd. on last page)

The Town & Country Planning Unit of APWD in association with Town & Country Planning Organisation, Ministry of Urban Development and National Remote Sensing Centre, Hyderabad organised the workshop. The Chief Secretary (I/c), & Principal Secretary (Urban Development) A&N Administration, Shri Raajiv Yaduvanshi inaugurated the workshop. Bhuvan-NUIS is primarily meant for urban planners, it provides the data of 152 towns created under National Urban Information System (NUIS) through internet.



Addressing the gathering on the occasion, the Chief Secretary i/c stated that Port Blair is one among the Smart Cities while PBMC is also availing funding under AMRUT for development of infrastructure and services in addition to Housing for All and 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan'. Formulation of Geographical Information System (GIS) based Master Plan is one among the component of AMRUT and we have Master Plan Port Blair prepared based on GIS platform. New Delhi, Aug 31
US Secretary of State Mr John Kerry said, terror groups and extremism cannot be fought by one nation and all countries have to confront the menace together. Interacting with the students of IIT Delhi this morning, he said, both India and US know the pain of terrorism and it is important to strike its root cause. He said, security threat is the biggest challenge. Speaking on the Indo-US

relationship, the Secretary of State said, in recent years, trade between the two nations has doubled and Washington is now New Delhi's top export market. Talking on India, John Kerry said, India is an established power and is playing a crucial role in the world today. He said, India is an essential partner and the US has welcomed its rise. Both countries are the two largest democracies in the world bound with common values for

tolerance, equality, respect of religious pluralism and peace. Replying to a query on India's bid for permanent UNSC seat, Mr Kerry said, there is a way but it is a bit complicated. He said, polarization anywhere in the world is not good as it reflects intolerance and frustration. He said, relationship between India and the US is not just only important for the two democracies but also for the rest of the world.

A&N Police arrests one for possession of contraband items

Port Blair, Aug 31
Ensuring strict action against contraband items, on Aug 28, a Police team of PS Hut Bay on reliable source of information, conducted a raid at 8 KM, Sunderpur Beach, Little Andaman and arrested one person namely Ghan Shyam from whose possession 1 Kg and 68 grams illicit Ganja was recovered. Upon this, a case vide Crime No. 77/16 dated 28/08/16 under

Section 20(b)(ii)(B) of NDPS Act 1985 was registered against him at PS Hut Bay and he will be produced before the Hon'ble Court at Port Blair. The investigation conducted so far revealed that the culprit is a resident of Caddlegunj, South Andaman and recently went to Hut Bay. South Andaman Police also managed to recover another 1 Kg. and 32 grams

of Ganja from his possession, after sustained interrogation. Meanwhile, general public have been requested to pass on any credible information on any illegal activity on the telephone numbers: 233077, 284208, 100 and 9434289982. The informant will be suitably rewarded and his/her identity will be kept secret, a communication said.

Govt to organise BRICS convention on tourism

New Delhi, Aug 31
The government will organise a two-day 'BRICS Convention on Tourism' in Madhya Pradesh from September 1 to promote intra-regional tourism, ahead of the BRICS Summit to be hosted by India.

As a precursor to the BRICS Summit in Goa on October 15-16, the convention in Khajuraho will be attended by a delegation from the BRICS countries, an official release said. Apart from inter-governmental exchange of views and ideas, the event organised by the Tourism Ministry will also witness panel discussions on technology, innovation in



tourism, and cooperation between the BRICS countries for promoting intra-regional tourism, it added. Elements of culture, handicrafts and cuisine from different regions of India will also be showcased during the convention. Tourism Ministers and officials from the BRICS

countries - Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa - will address the inaugural session on September 1. Post-convention, familiarisation tours will be organised for the delegates during September 3-6 which will cover important tourist destinations in Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar.

A six days training programme (157th Batch) on 'Disaster Management & Disaster Preparedness' in Collapse Structure Search & Rescue & Medical First Responder (CSSR & MFR) which commenced on Aug 22, in the Conference Hall of SP (District), SA's Office, Port Blair to sensitize the Police personnel of various units as well as the staff from Forest and APWD concluded on Aug 27. All the participants were enlightened about MFR Course Introduction & Emergency Medical System, Soft tissue injuries, Oxygen therapy, Haemorrhage & shock, musculoskeletal injuries, skull, spinal & chest injuries. Shri. B. Saigal, Asst. Nodal Officer for Disaster Management of A&N Police Dept. was present in the



valedictory function. In his address, he briefed about the vulnerability surrounding the UT as it falls under Seismic Zone-V (very high prone to earthquake), which was experienced in the recent past earthquake followed by Tsunami that struck the Islands on 26/12/2004. He highlighted the role of Police personnel and the staff of various Deptt in responding such scenario. At the end of the course, a live demonstration on

operation and maintenance of various search and rescue equipments. Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi has issued orders for strict compliance of the "Guidelines for Idol Immersion" issued by Central Pollution Control Board, New Delhi to all the States and Union Territories. In this connection, all concerned, Puja Committee & Idol makers are hereby requested to comply the following guidelines:

- > Idols should be made from the natural material as described in the holy script preferably traditional clay, baked clay, Plaster of Paris should not be used for making Idols.
- > Idols are to be painted with water soluble and toxic natural dyes. User of toxic & non-biodegradable chemical dyes for painting is strictly prohibited.
- > Worship materials like flowers, vastras (cloth) and decorating material (made of paper & plastic) should be removed before Idol Immersion. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting. Non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills. Clothes may be sent to local orphan house(s).
- > Burning of solid waste comprising of used flowers, clothes, decorating materials etc. is prohibited at the immersion site.
- > Idol immersion should be done between low tide lines (irrespective of its depth) in an identified places with permission of District Administration only.

Murray, Serena ride strong serves into US Open second round

New York, Aug 31
Wimbledon champions Andy Murray and Serena Williams powered into the second round of the US Open as the stars came out on Arthur Ashe Stadium court on Tuesday night.

Williams, launching her latest bid to rewrite the record books, started strong and didn't let up in 6-3, 6-3 victory over 29th-ranked Ekaterina Makarova. The US world number one appeared untroubled by the balking right shoulder that has hindered her in recent weeks, delivering a dozen aces and 27 winners overall in the 63-minute contest.

"I knew today I needed to be focused because I've played her. She's gotten to the semi-finals. She goes deep in majors," Williams said of the Russian left-hander who beat her in the fourth round of the 2012 Australian Open. "She knows how to play big matches on big courts. She's



not intimidated. I knew I had to really come out today. It was my only option really." Williams said she wouldn't know until she'd slept on it how her shoulder might respond to the effort. "Every day, I'll just see how it goes," said Williams, who is chasing a record seventh title on the hardcourts of Flushing Meadows where she first triumphed in 1999. A victory would see her break the Open Era record of 22 Grand Slam titles she now

shares with German Steffi Graf and close in on Margaret Court's all-time mark of 24 major titles. While Williams has struggled since Wimbledon, Murray went from claiming a second title at the All England club to a successful defence of his Olympic gold in Rio. Vying to become the fourth man in the Open Era to reach all four major finals in a calendar year, Murray, too, produced a dominant service performance in a 6-3, 6-2, 6-2 victory over Czech Lukas Rosol.

Virat Kohli retains No. 1 spot, Ashwin returns to top five in ICC T20 rankings

Dubai, Aug 31
India's star batsman Virat Kohli has maintained his number one position in the ICC T20 batsmen rankings, while off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin returned to the top five in the bowlers' list, climbing up to fourth spot from seventh. Meanwhile, KL Rahul has moved up as many as 67 places to be at 31st spot, riding on his unbeaten century during the two-match series against the West Indies in Lauderdale, USA.



The first match of the T20 series, in which a T20I record aggregate of 489 runs were scored, saw Rahul scoring an unbeaten 110 in India's reply of 244 for four to West Indies' 245 for six.

With the second match of the series being called off due to wet conditions, the West Indies won the two-T20 series 1-0 on the basis of their thrilling one-run win in the opening game

and that helped the Caribbean side narrow the gap with India in the team rankings.

Two-time ICC World Twenty20 champion West Indies, which was six points behind second-placed India's 128 points before the series, is now just one point adrift at 125 with India on 126. New Zealand lead the table with 132 points.

West Indies' Evin Lewis' 49-ball 100 in the first T20 has helped him move up 288 slots to reach 51st position.

Bhuvneshwar Kumar (67th) and Mohammad Shami (82nd) were the others to move up the bowlers' rankings for India. Leg-spinner Amit Mishra, playing his first match since the ICC World Twenty20 in 2014, has re-entered the rankings at 104th position with three for 24 in the second match.

After Olympics success, PV Sindhu sets eyes on All England title

Hyderabad, Aug 31

After tasting success in her maiden Olympic campaign, star shuttler PV Sindhu has now set her eyes on the upcoming Superseries this year and the All England championships in March. The 21-year-old athlete who scripted history by bagging silver at the recently concluded Rio Olympics called the feat a 'dream come true'. "It's a totally different feeling...a definite dream come true. It was my first Olympics and to get a medal in the very first attempt really makes it much more special," Sindhu said. "Though it's getting tiresome repeating the same words in every interview, I am enjoying every moment of it," Sindhu added.



Recalling her preparation for the Games, Sindhu said she had worked on each and every stroke of hers with coach Pulella Gopichand. "Each one of the rivals have their own style and technique and I have played against them previously. We prepared strategies before every game which worked in my favour," she said. "There were no tournaments in the last two months, which helped us in the preparations. Each and every day, the focus was on the Olympics."

for a cheaper and quicker arbitral process. He said, in all new contracts relating to construction, there will be a conciliation board provision and this board will comprise of independent subject experts. Among the measures approved are, Circulation of a model draft for turnkey projects, release of 75 per cent of money earmarked for infrastructure companies towards completion of existing projects and coverage of disputes between companies and civic bodies under a new arbitration law. The proposals were set forth by NITI Aayog to give a boost to the construction sector.
