## Solar power projects: PM asks states to create policy frameworks for speedy implementation

New Delhi, Sep 30 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has asked states to work proactively towards creating conducive policy frameworks for speedy implementation of solar power projects. Shri Modi today reviewed the progress of development of solar energy parks in 17 states across the country through PRAGATI, the ICT based, multi-modal platform for Pro-Active Governance and

Timely Implementation. He also reviewed the progress of key infrastructure projects in the Railway, Metro Rail, Coal and Iron Ore Mining, Road, Power, and Aviation sectors, spread over several States. On the progress of important Indian projects in Afghanistan including the Parliament Building, the Prime Minister asked all concerned departments to ensure speedy implementation

of projects in the SAARC region. Shri Modi emphasized speedy implementation of the Food Security Act and Aadhar enrollment across the country. During the interaction, the Prime Minister expressed concern at the undue delay in processing of requests for patents and trademarks and directed to bring these processes in line with global standards within a reasonable time frame.

Port Blair, Sept. 30 The Lt Governor, Lt Gen A K Singh (Retd), called on the Union Minister for Civil Aviation, Shri Puspapati Ashok Gajapati Raju at New Delhi. He discussed a host of issues relating to the Civil Aviation sector in the A&N Islands. One of the important issues discussed by the Lt Governor relates to the special status for Andaman & Nicobar Islands in RDG/New Civil Aviation Policy which is to ensure all airlines operate to Port Blair as there is no other easy alternative connection from Port Blair to any other city/town in mainland. This situation cannot be compared to other cities in mainland. He also urged the Minister to take up Car Nicobar as alternative airfield for emergency diversions. Further modernization and expansion of existing helicopter fleet also figured in the discussion. He apprised the Minister of the need for commencing the

night flight to Port Blair. Spice jet has already done the test flight while other airlines, including the Air India need to do so soon. This is essential to improve connectivity to Port Blair. He also raised the issue of deployment of new aircrafts on Delhi-Vizag-Port Blair sector by Air India, which the

Minister agreed to. The Lt Governor also requested for immediately starting Air India chartered flight service on Kolkata-Port Blair sector. On this, the MD, Air India responded positively. Besides, issues such as introduction of international flights to Port Blair,

rationalization of airfares by fixing an upper cap, as the high air-fares especially during the peak season is a big deterrent for development of tourism as well as a burden on the Islanders, were also raised with the Minister. The Lt. Governor requested the Minister's intervention on

expediting the construction of the New Terminal building at VSI Airport. The Civil Aviation Minister assured the Lt. Governor that his Ministry will extend all possible support for the expansion and development of the Civil Aviation sector in the A&N Islands.

**MCOCA court awards death to 5, life imprisonment to 7 in Mumbai 7/11 train blasts' case**

Mumbai, Sept 30  
The Special MCOCA court in Mumbai pronounced the much awaited verdict on Mumbai 7/11 train blasts' case today. A Special Maharashtra Control of Organised Crime Act (MCOCA) court judge, Yatin D Shinde today pronounced death sentence to Ehtesham Siddiqui, Asif Khan, Faisal Shaikh, Naveed Khan and Kamal Ansari, for planting the bombs in suburban local trains in Mumbai on July 11, 2006. Other seven accused including Tanveer Ansari and Mohammed Ali, who provided the premises in Govandi for assembling the bombs, and Sajid Ansari, who made the timers and the electric circuits used to set off the bombs were given life sentences.

As per this Act, a Senior Citizen including parent who is unable to maintain himself from his own earning or out of the property owned by him, shall be entitled to make an application before the Tribunals for maintenance allowance against one or more of his children not being a minor and relatives means any legal heir of the childless senior citizen who is not a minor.  
If children or relatives, as the case may be, neglect or refuse to maintain a senior citizen, the Tribunal may, on being satisfied of such neglect or refusal, order such children or relatives to make a monthly allowance (maximum of Rs. 10,000/-) at such monthly rate.  
The children or relative who is required to pay any amount in terms of such order shall, within thirty days of the date of announcing the order by the Tribunal, deposit the entire amount ordered in such manner as the Tribunal may direct.  
The Assistant Commissioners are the Chairpersons of Tribunal and all Deputy Commissioners are the Chairpersons of Appellate Tribunal.  
All Child Development Project Officers are Maintenance Officers for the purpose of representing a parent during proceedings before the Maintenance Tribunal.
