## India climbs to 38<sup>th</sup> rank in global innovation index 2025 from 66<sup>th</sup> in 2019

New Delhi, Jan. 30

India's innovation ecosystem has shown strong and steady progress over the past few years, with the country climbing to 38<sup>th</sup> position in the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2025 from 66<sup>th</sup> in 2019, the Economic Survey said. The Survey highlights how Government initiatives in manufacturing, research, startups and technology have helped India emerge as a growing global hub for innovation and industrial development.

The Economic Survey noted that the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme has played a major role in boosting domestic manufacturing, especially in the smartphone sector. Many global mobile phone companies have shifted their production to India, turning the country into an important manufacturing centre.

**Leap towards a Robust Industrial Sector**

India's Global Innovation Index rank steadily improved to 38<sup>th</sup> in 2025 from 66<sup>th</sup> in 2019

Till September 2025, actual investments under the PLI scheme crossed 2 lakh crore rupees, leading to additional production and sales of over 18.70 lakh crore rupees. The scheme has also generated employment for more than 12.60 lakh people, both directly and indirectly.

The Economic Survey highlighted that India now leads among lower-middle-income countries in innovation and ranks first in the Central and Southern Asia region. Cities such as Bengaluru, Delhi and Mumbai are among the world's top 50 innovation-intensive clusters. Overall innovation output in the country has also increased significantly. India has also become an important global player in intellectual property.

In 2024, the country ranked fourth in trademark filings, sixth in patents and seventh in industrial designs worldwide. The Economic Survey also pointed to strong progress in the semiconductor sector. As of August 2025, ten semiconductor manufacturing and packaging projects have been approved across six states, with a total investment of around 1.60 lakh crore rupees. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

## DAUC mandatory for dealers selling used vehicles: Transport Deptt.

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 30

The Transport Department has informed that several second-hand vehicle sellers are carrying on business without obtaining the mandatory Dealer Authorization Certificate (DAUC) is a violation of the provisions of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. As per Rules 55A to 55E of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, no individual or firm shall engage in the business of buying, selling, stocking or facilitating the transfer of ownership of used motor vehicles without

purchase of second-hand motor vehicles that operating such business without obtaining a valid Dealer Authorization Certificate (DAUC) is a violation of the provisions of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. As per Rules 55A to 55E of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, no individual or firm shall engage in the business of buying, selling, stocking or facilitating the transfer of ownership of used motor vehicles without authorization granted by the Registering Authority.

The Rules 55A to 55E specifically prescribe the procedure, eligibility conditions, responsibilities and validity relating to authorization of second-hand motor vehicle dealers, including maintenance of records, online transfer of ownership and compliance with V A H A N - r e l a t e d processes.

Strict enforcement action shall be taken against persons or establishments operating purchasing/selling of used vehicles without obtaining Dealer Authorization Certificate (DAUC) by enforcement agency.

The general public have been advised to buy or sell used vehicles only through dealers holding a valid Dealer Authorization Certificate to safeguard themselves from future legal and financial liabilities, a press release received from Registering Authority, Transport Deptt. said.

## POSH Act Awareness Session for Officers/ Officials of Directorate of IP&T held at TGCE

Sensitized on provisions and workplace conduct

An awareness session on the Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act was conducted for the Officers/ Officials of Directorate of IP&T in the seminar hall of TGCE here this morning, with the objective of sensitizing officials about the Act and its provisions. The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (POSH Act) is an Indian law designed to protect women from sexual harassment, ensure a safe workplace, and provide redressal for complaints. It mandates organizations with 10 or more employees to form an Internal Committee (IC) to investigate complaints.

In his inaugural address, the Director of



Information, Publicity and Tourism, Shri Vinayak Chamadia, IAS, underlined the significance of such interactive sessions for departmental officials. He stated that the primary purpose of the programme is to make officials "crystal clear" about the POSH Act and its provisions, thereby ensuring awareness, compliance and sensitivity in day-to-day professional conduct. He emphasised that understanding the spirit of the Act is essential not only for legal compliance but also for fostering a culture of mutual respect and dignity in the workplace.

**Exposure visit for Onge Tribe school students to CLF Nanjappa Nagar, Hut Bay inspires young minds on Animal Husbandry and Safety**

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services organised a special exposure visit for students from the Onge Tribe School to the Community Livestock Farm (CLF), Nanjappa Nagar, Hut Bay recently. The visit aimed to introduce young tribal students to scientific animal husbandry practices, departmental programmes and basic animal welfare and safety awareness in an engaging and interactive manner.



The students were taken on a guided tour of the entire farm, where they observed various livestock sections including pigs, poultry, and other birds. Field staff and veterinary personnel explained the importance of proper housing, balanced feeding, disease prevention, clean production practices and the role of the Department in supporting rural and tribal livelihoods through quality animal health services, vaccination drives, artificial insemination and backyard poultry promotion. The children showed keen interest and excitement, particularly while interacting with the farm animals, which they saw up close for the first time.

To make the experience memorable and nutritious, the students were provided refreshing tender coconuts and 80 fresh quail eggs for their consumption and learning. The Department also conducted a short awareness session on prevention of dog bites, immediate first-aid measures (such as thorough wound washing with soap and water for 15 minutes and prompt reporting), and the importance of not teasing or disturbing animals. These simple but life-saving messages were delivered in an age-appropriate and engaging way. The students appeared visibly happy and enthusiastic throughout the visit, expressing joy at seeing the farm animals and learning about their care. Teachers and accompanying staff appreciated the Department's thoughtful initiative in reaching out to tribal children, providing hands-on exposure and combining education with refreshment and practical gifts.


