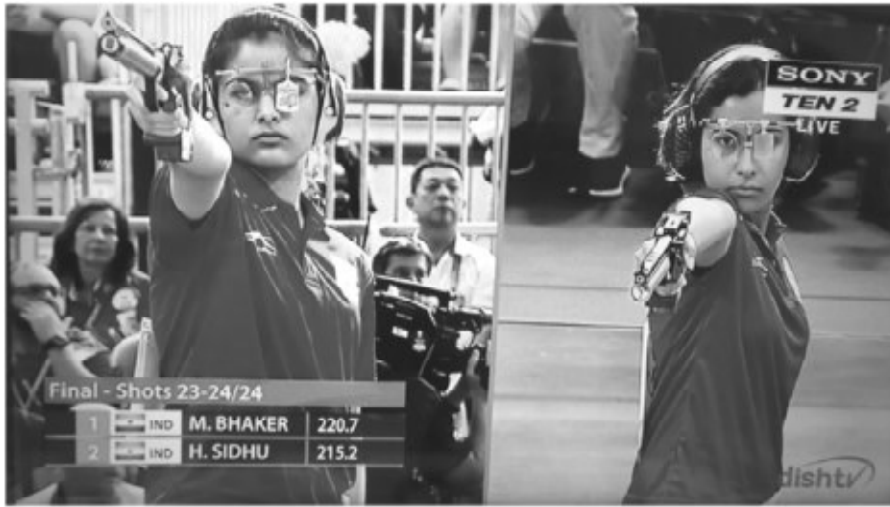

Manu Bhaker wins Gold, Heena Sidhu bags Silver for India in women's 10-m air pistol

Gold Coast, April 8
The Indian shooters made the country proud on Day 4 of the Commonwealth Games by winning the Gold and Silver for India. Manu Bhaker brought the 6th Gold home while Heena Sidhu bagged Silver in women's 10-m air pistol. 16-year-old Manu Bhaker was comfortably positioned throughout the match whereas Heena staged a remarkable recovery to secure silver. Bhaker shot 240.9 to break the Commonwealth Games record, finishing well ahead of her senior teammate Sidhu, who aggregated 234. The bronze medal went to Australia's Elena Galiabovitch who ended with 214.9. The two Indians had also



dominated the qualification stage, claiming the top two spots going into the final. In the qualification stage also, Manu finished at the top spot while Sidhu stood at the second. Manu had topped the qualification stage with a total of 388 points and Heena had qualified at the second spot with 379 points. Bhaker was the overwhelming favourite to win the event, having bagged gold medals at the 2018 ISSF World Cup in Guadalajara, Mexico and the following Junior World Cup in Sydney. Sidhu too did well to win silver after she was on the verge of elimination at one stage. She had also won a silver at the Delhi Games in 2010.

Punam Yadav claims gold medal for India in Weightlifting

Gold Coast, April 8
Indian weightlifter Punam Yadav added a fifth gold medal to the country's medal tally at the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast on Sunday. Yadav, who made the jump to 69kg category this year, lifted a total of 222kg (110kg + 112kg) for the gold medal. England's Sarah Davies had to settle for silver after failing to lift 128kg in her final clean and jerk attempt. The bronze medal was won by Fiji's Apolonia Vaivai with an effort of 216kg (100kg+116kg). Yadav, a bronze-medallist from the 2014 Glasgow edition,



entered the Commonwealth Games after claiming a silver at last year's Commonwealth Championships. This was her first event after making the jump from 63 kg to the 69kg category this year. Earlier Mirabai Chanu (48kg), Sanjita Chanu (53kg), Sathish Sivalingam (77kg) and Venkat Rahul Ragala (85kg) had claimed gold medals in the ongoing edition. Indian weightlifters are likely to add more to the tally with a few more weight categories left.

India women win gold in table tennis team event

Gold Coast, April 8
Indian women's table tennis team scripted history by clinching the first ever gold medal at the Commonwealth Games with a 3-1 victory over Singapore in the final on Sunday. This was the second time the women's team reached a CWG final, having made its maiden appearance in the 2010 edition in Delhi. Manika Batra recorded a hard-fought 11-8, 8-11, 7-11, 11-9, 11-7 victory over World No. 4 Tianwei Feng to hand India 1-0 lead. Singapore drew level after Mengyu Yu got the better of Madhurika Patkar in straight games 13-11, 11-2, 11-6. The doubles pair of Mouma



Das and Madhurika Patkar restored the lead defeating Yihan Zhou and Mengyu Yu 11-7, 11-6, 8-11, 11-7 as Indian tightened their grip on the match. Manika, who was the recipient of the Times of India Sports Award (TOISA) for Table Tennis Player of the Year (People's Choice) in February, came out all guns blazing in her second match of the final as she outplayed Yihan Zhou in straight games 11-7, 11-4, 11-7 to clinch the seventh gold for India. It took the country's total medal tally to 12 in the CWG.

India's Ravi Kumar wins bronze in Men's 10m Air Rifle



Gold Coast, April 8
Indian shooter Ravi Kumar won the Bronze medal in Men's 10m Air Rifle on Day 4 of the Commonwealth Games at Gold Coast. He settled for Bronze third position on the podium after having been on top of the chart for a few rounds. Another Indian

shooter Deepak Kumar was eliminated in the final. Ravi shot a total of 224.1 to finish behind Australian Dane Sampson (245) and Bangladesh's Abdullah Hel Baki (244.7), who won the gold and silver, respectively at the Belmont Shooting Centre.

Women's hockey team stuns Olympic champions England



Gold Coast, April 8
The Indian women's hockey team rallied from a goal down to script a stunning 2-1 triumph over Olympic champions England in its third Pool A match of the 21st Commonwealth Games here today. India, aiming to do better than the fifth-place finish at the last two CWG editions, are now second on the points table behind England and look set to qualify for the semifinals. Gurjit Kaur and Navneet Kaur sounded the board for India in the 42nd and 48th minute after England captain Alexandra Danson had put her team ahead just 35 seconds into the game. "This is the first time we have beaten England, they are the Olympic champions so we are very happy," India captain Rani Rampal said after the match. "It's always a special moment and achievement when you beat the Olympic champions. We've had very little chance to compete against them, and today was our day. We had to grab the chances and work hard," she added.

Gold Coast, April 8
India overcame Wales 4-3 in a closely fought match in the Commonwealth Games 2018 here on Sunday. Dilpreet Singh, Mandeep Singh, Harmanpreet Singh and SV

Sunil scored for India. India, have now sealed a victory and a draw to settle on 4 points with England in Pool B. India, will next face Malaysia on Thursday and pool toppers England after that.

Vikas adds bronze to CWG weightlifting haul



Gold Coast, April 8
Vikas Thakur added a shade of bronze to Indian weightlifters' golden run at the Commonwealth Games, claiming the third position in the 94kg category by equalling his personal best in Gold Coast on Sunday. Vikas lifted a total of 351kg (159kg+192kg) on a day when Papua New Guinea's Steven Kari broke the

Commonwealth as well as the Games record in clean and jerk for a total lift of 370kg (154kg+216kg). The silver went to Canada's Boady Santavy, who lifted 369kg (168kg+201kg). His snatch effort was a new Games record. For Vikas, the medal was a climbdown from the 2014 edition where he had claimed a silver with a lesser lift of 333kg.
