New Delhi, Sept 1 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has asked BJP's Rajya Sabha members to focus on bringing in the poor and deprived sections of society into the party's fold. Addressing a meeting of BJP Rajya Sabha MPs in New Delhi yesterday, Shri Modi urged them to play an effective role in Parliament to raise the issues concerning their States. He also said the MPs should play an active role in publicizing the NDA government's initiatives among the people. Briefing reporters, senior



BJP leader and Union Minister Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad said, the Prime Minister asked the members to use social media for disseminating information about the achievements of the government. Earlier, BJP President Shri Amit Shah asked the Rajya Sabha MPs to adopt one Lok Sabha seat for developmental work where it had lost in last General elections.

## PM to start Vietnam & China visit today

New Delhi, Sep 1 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will embark on a two nation tour to Vietnam and China beginning tomorrow. During his first leg of the four day visit, Shri Modi will go to Vietnamese capital Hanoi tomorrow. Briefing media in New Delhi this evening, Secretary (East) in the External Affairs Ministry, Ms Preeti Saran said, the Prime Minister's visit is aimed at further strengthening defence and security ties between the two countries.

She said, Shri Modi will also meet President Tran Dai Quang and Prime Minister Nguyen Xuan Phuc. The Prime Minister will leave for China on Saturday evening from Vietnam to attend the G-20 Summit in Hangzhou. Secretary (West) in the MEA Smti Sujata Mehta said, Shri Modi will be the lead speaker at the session on inclusive and inter connected development. She said, India will press for reduction in remittance transaction cost, cross-border mobility of professionals among others.

Leander Paes and his mixed doubles partner Martina Hingis also had a light workout at the court. They secured a 6-3, 6-2 win against Americans Sachia Vickrey and Frances Tiafoe. Meanwhile, French Open champion Garbine Muguruza and Wimbledon finalist Milos Raonic made shock exits in the second round of the US Open. Spanish third seed Muguruza lost 7-5 6-4 to Latvia's Anastasija Sevastova. Canada's Raonic, the fifth seed, struggled physically as American qualifier Ryan Harrison won 6-7 (4-7)

Nadal rolls into third round under new US Open roof

New York, Sept 1  
Rafael Nadal glided into the third round of the US Open on Wednesday as smoothly as the new roof over Arthur Ashe stadium slid shut for the first time during a match. Two-time champion Nadal, seeded fourth, defeated Italy's Andreas Seppi 6-0, 7-5, 6-1 to book a meeting with Russian Andrey Kuznetsov for a place in the round of 16. The \$150 million retractable roof on top of the Arthur Ashe Stadium court at the US Open was called into action for the first time as rain hit the tournament on Wednesday. The giant structure took only a

few moments to close, allowing Rafael Nadal and Andreas Seppi to resume their second round match beneath it. "Play was suspended at 0238 GMT and play resumed at 0246 GMT — total suspension of play was 7 minutes and 22 seconds," said a statement by the US Tennis Association (USTA). "The roof closed in 5 minutes and 35 seconds. The closing occurred prior to Nadal serving at 3-3 in the second set. Nadal won the first set 6-0. "Rafael Nadal has the distinction of hitting the first practice and match ball under a closed roof in Arthur Ashe Stadium."
