Port Blair would be developed as an IT hub Optical fiber cable connecting Chennai & P/Blair to get approval soon: Minister

DT Correspondent Port Blair, Jan.02 The Govt. of India, Ministry of Communication and Information Technology has decided to lay submarine optical fiber cable, connecting Chennai and Port Blair to improve connectivity in the Islands, the Minister of Communication & Information Technology, Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad addressing a press conference in the conference hall of Megapode Nest here this evening. Once the project is cleared, open tender will be floated and the project will be taken up for execution, the Minister said adding that the work is expected to be completed in 2-3 years. The Minister stated that in the second phase all other Islands will be connected to Port Blair. This is going to be a big infrastructure development in IT sector in the Islands, the Minister said.

General Manager BSNL Kolkata to initiate action for providing connectivity of 20 MBPS Bandwidth to Havelock direct from Kolkata to improve ATM and internet services as well. Since Havelock has a great tourism potential, plan should be framed for providing goalless connectivity to facilitate tourists service providers including hoteliers, operators and also other tourism related activities, the Minister added.

The Minister mentioned that similar steps will also be taken to connect small Islands such as Neil, Little Andaman, Kamorta and Campbell Bay. With the projects to come up soon, there will be a distinctive improvement in the broadband connectivity, the Minister said adding that it would be monitored by CGM Kolkata. The



Minister informed the scribes that GSM 2G mobile service will come up at Kala Patthar to facilitate tourists in that area.

Other projects to come up that the Minister had stated include setting up Telephone Exchange at Radhanagar, Havelock and

Shadipur with satellite link, new Sub-Post Office at Oralkatcha, Post Office Shoppe. He also stated that Special Counter for 'My Stamp' will be opened at Port Blair Head Post Office.

The Minister also highlighted the achievements of Telecom

and Postal Services during the NDA Government and said that both the departments had made tremendous progress in terms of revenue generation. A volley of questions raised by the scribes, were replied by the Minister, to the satisfaction of the scribes.

Novak Djokovic Begins 2016 Season in Qatar

Doha, Qatar, Jan 2
Six weeks after completing one of the greatest seasons in tennis history, Novak Djokovic begins his 2016 campaign and warm-up for his Australian Open defence in Qatar. The Serbian, also current holder of Wimbledon and the US Open, heads a strong field at the Qatar Open starting in Doha on Monday, which also includes Rafael Nadal, Tomas Berdych and defending champion David Ferrer.



All eyes though, at least at the start, will be on Djokovic to see if he can maintain the exceptional heights he achieved last year and to gauge his form ahead of the first Grand Slam of the year, which begins in Melbourne on January 18.

The 28-year-old dominated men's tennis last year, all but sweeping away the competition to take three majors, make 15

consecutive tour finals and win more than 21 million USD (19 million euros) in prize money. He also became the third man to reach all four Grand Slam finals in a year, losing out only in the French Open to Stan Wawrinka. Given his achievements last season, Djokovic must be looking to become the first player since Rod Laver, in 1969, to win all four Grand Slams in a single

season. There is also the extra prize of a "fifth major" this season, with an Olympics gold medal up for grabs in Rio in August. "Here we come again to a new season," Djokovic said in an upbeat statement before arriving in Qatar on December 30. "I'm so excited to come back and perform at my best in this season opening tournament, stay tuned!"

Govt to roll out LPG-like DBT scheme for kerosene from April 1

New Delhi, Jan 3
Government will roll out LPG-like DBT scheme for kerosene from 1st of April this year. According to an official release, the scheme will be implemented in selected 26 districts of eight states. These states are Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Punjab and Rajasthan.

Under the scheme, people will buy kerosene at market rate but will get subsidy directly in their bank accounts. The cash subsidy to be paid to users, will be equivalent to the difference between current Public Distribution System price and market rate of kerosene. The subsidy outgo for kerosene for the financial year 2014-15 was about

24,799 crore rupees. With a view to incentivize States and Union Territories to implement DBT in kerosene, it has been decided that the states be given cash incentive of 75 per cent of subsidy savings during the first two years, 50 per cent in the third year and 25 per cent in the fourth year. In case, the states voluntarily agree to undertake cuts in kerosene allocation, beyond the savings due to DBT, a similar incentive will be given to those States.
