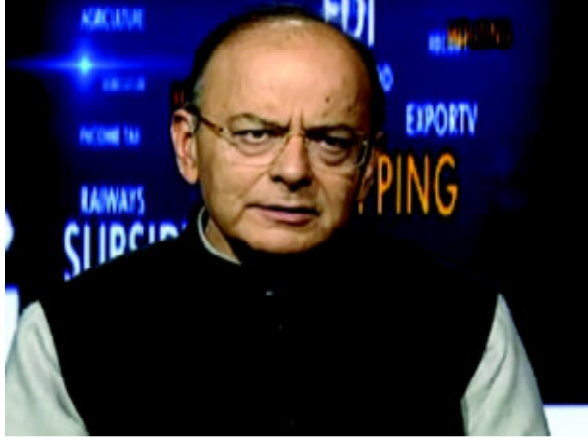

He said manufacturing sector has picked up in last few months and there was a need to focus on infrastructure sector. Shri Jaitley said India



has a serious challenge in terms of compliance and increased tax base. He said, no other country has five

percent tax slab and can't get slabs lower than the current ones. Shri Jaitley said long-term capital gains

tax was a tough call pending for years now. The Finance Minister said the health care was a priority area and another priority was to increase farmer income. He said the health scheme will be commencement from 1st April this year. Shri Jaitley said it takes care of hospitalization, secondary and tertiary care. He said it can be a trust model or insurance model.

## All arrangements in place for health schemes implementation: Minister

New Delhi, Feb 2  
Health Minister, Shri J P Nadda today said the government is committed to implement the health schemes announced in the Union Budget under 'Ayushman Bharat' in letter and spirit. Addressing media in New Delhi, Shri Nadda said, the National Health Protection Scheme announced in the budget will provide medical cover of up to 5 lakh rupees per annum to 10 crore poor and vulnerable families. He said, fifty crore of the

country's population will be benefited from this scheme. Shri Nadda said, all arrangements are in place for its implementation and there will be no financial constraint. He said, 2000 crore rupees have been allocated for the scheme. The Health Minister said, the government has decided to allocate an additional 600 crore rupees to provide nutritional support to all tuberculosis patients at the rate of 500 rupees per patient till the duration of the treatment.

He said, the sub-centres are being upgraded in the health and wellness centres and 1,200 crore rupees have been allocated towards 1.5 lakh such wellness centres. Minister of State for Health, Ms Anupriya Patel said, in the budget, government has announced to set up 24 new government medical colleges and hospitals by upgrading existing district hospitals in the country. Ms Patel said, of them 8 medical colleges will be opened in Uttar Pradesh and five each in West Bengal and Bihar.
