Lt. Governor holds meeting to review progress of filling up of vacancies

Port Blair, Apr. 2

The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) held a meeting at Raj Niwas today to review the progress of filling up of the vacancies in various Departments of the Administration. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration alongwith other Secretaries & Heads of Departments were present, wherein progress made in filling up the vacancies by the respective Departments after the last meeting was reviewed.

The Lt. Governor noted that a number of DPCs to fill up approximately 500 vacancies under the promotional quota in various departments of the Administration have already been held in the last one to two months and that the consequent promotion orders for the same are likely to be issued by the respective Departments within the next few days.

Simultaneously, while reviewing the progress, the Lt. Governor directed that all the Departments should invariably make all out efforts to fill up the resultant balance promotional vacancies and also to initiate and complete the process of filling up the vacancies under the direct recruitment quota at the earliest.

MP meets HRD Minister Requests for exemption of re-exam of Economics subject for Class 12 students

Port Blair, April 2 The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray met the Minister of HRD, Shri Prakash Javedekar today and requested for exemption of re-examination of Economic subject for Class 12 students of this UT Islands. The MP besides submitting a fresh letter also presented various points to protect the interest of the students of this UT Islands. He mentioned that the matter regarding paper leakage was verified with various intelligence agencies as well as print media & electronic media of this UT Islands and as such there was no information of paper leakage for any subject of 12th standard so far. Similarly, there are no reports or evidence to prove that the Economics



question paper has been leaked in this UT Islands, until it was declared by the CBSE, that too after the students had given the examination for economic subject. Meanwhile, in the year of 2011, there was an issue of question paper leak, in which the CBSE had taken the matter seriously and conducted a fresh examination exclusively for

the A & N Islands. The Nodal Department i.e. the Education Department also has not received any such report of leakage of question paper from the Centre Superintendents of various examination centre of this UT Islands. Aberdeen Police seizes ganja; accused arrested under NDPS Act

Port Blair, Apr. 2 The team of Police Station Aberdeen has arrested one person with over 2.36 Kg of illicit Ganja near School Line School recently and a case has been registered at this PS under Narcotic Drug and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985. After receiving credible information by SHO PS Aberdeen, that a person namely Rajesh Kumar Bepari is going to sell illicit ganja at School line area, a raiding team led by Insp. A.

K. Singh, SHO PS Aberdeen, HC V. Henthoo, PC D. Shiv Kumar, PC Suresh Kumar was formed under the direct supervision of SDPO (SA) Shri Nishant Gupta. The team busted the NDPS racket and recovered 2.36 Kg of illicit ganja from the possession of accused person namely Rajesh Kumar Bepari R/o School Line. He was arrested on the spot under the relevant sections of Narcotic Drug and

Psychotropic Substances Act 1985. John Isner earns biggest title, beating Alexander Zverev in Miami Open final

Miami, Apr 2

John Isner punctuated his unexpected run to the Miami Open title with a surprising display of agility, dancing across the court while basking in a breakthrough. The 6-foot-10 Isner looked twice as tall skipping about with a grin brighter than the Florida sunshine. He had just won the biggest title of his 14-year career, holding every service game and rallying past Alexander Zverev 6-7 (4), 6-4, 6-4 on Sunday. Isner, who turns 33 this month, previously had been 0-3 in ATP Masters 1000 finals.

"You can't replicate moments like this," Isner said during the trophy ceremony. "I'm toward the latter part of my career; this is the best moment of my career."

Isner's win came in the last



singles match on Key Biscayne before the Miami Open moves next year to the NFL Dolphins' stadium.

Seeded 14th, Isner became the first American man to win the tournament since Andy Roddick in 2010. Isner joined Sloane Stephens, who won the women's title Saturday, for the first U.S. sweep in the event since 2004, when the champions were Roddick and

Serena Williams.

The start of the last game was delayed by the crowd's chants of "U-S-A!" Isner then held at love, and on the final three points he smacked aces, giving him 18 for the match and 79 for the tournament.

"I was just ready for this moment," he said. "I've been here three other times, and I've lost three times on this stage. I was just ready for it."

Rafael Nadal reclaims ATP top spot as Roger Federer slips

Paris, Apr 2

Rafael Nadal reclaimed top spot in the men's ATP rankings on Monday with Swiss rival Roger Federer slipping to the second spot following his defeat to American John Isner at the Miami Open. Nadal, who hasn't hit a ball in anger since pulling out of the Australian Open quarter-finals in January, saw Federer take over top spot on February 18. The Swiss veteran, however, slipped 10 points behind his Spanish rival and into second place after a second-round defeat to Isner that saw the towering American leap eight places to ninth thanks to his eventual victory Sunday in the Masters 1000 event. Isner thus equals his previous best ranking of ninth, reached in April 2012, while beaten finalist Alexander Zverev of Germany moved up one place to fourth. South Korea's Hyeon Chung meanwhile continued to chip away at the rankings, the 21-year-old breaking into the top 20, to 19th, for the first time in his fledgling career thanks to his quarter-final appearance in Miami.

Deborah Herold is an Indian cyclist who was born in

Andaman and Nicobar in February 1995 and has been residing in Delhi since 2011. Deborah is one of the survivors of the 2004 Tsunami. She was at Port Blair when the calamity hit. She spent over a week on a tree. Herold now trains at Velodrome at the Indira Gandhi Sports Complex. In 2014, Herold made her name after

winning two gold medals at the Herald Track Asia Cup in the 500-meter time trial and the team sprint. Later, in 2015, five medals in Taiwan Cup Track International Classic and followed it by winning three medals in Track India Cup. Deborah Herold is the first Indian cyclist in the UCI rankings in 500m time trial and is at number four.

Indian stars Smriti Mandhana and Poonam Yadav accomplish career-best ICC T20 rankings

New Delhi, Apr 2

Australia pacer Megan Schutt has grabbed the number one ranking among bowlers in the ICC Women's T20I Player Rankings after her fine effort in the tri-series in India.

Schutt picked up three for 14 in the final against England to finish with nine wickets in the tournament.

Her performance not only contributed to her team's victory in the final but also helped her move up to reclaim a position she held briefly last year.

In the latest rankings, which also take into account the three-match series between Sri Lanka and Pakistan, which the latter won 2-1 and the five-match series featuring New Zealand and the Windies, which the former won 4-0, New Zealand's Leigh Kasperek is another major gainer.



The off-spinner has moved up seven places to take the second spot after finishing with 10 wickets in the series. Kasperek's previous best was the fourth position in November last year. India leg-spinner Poonam Yadav (up six places to a career-best fifth ranking), Pakistan off-spinner Nida Dar (up four places to 13th) and Sri Lanka left-arm spinner Sugandika Kumari (up 18 places to 24th) are the others to move up in the list of bowlers.

Among batters, Australia captain Meg Lanning has gained one slot to take the third position after scoring 175 runs in the tri-series, including an unbeaten 88 in the final.

Beth Mooney (up three places to fourth), India opener Smriti Mandhana (up 13 places to a career-best seventh position), Windies' Hayley Matthews (up four places to 15th) and Pakistan's Javeria Khan (up two places to 22nd) are the others to make significant gains.
