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India and Turkey agree to strengthen co-operation in Combating terrorism

New Delhi, May 2
India and Turkey have strongly condemned the "use of double standards" in combating terrorism and agreed to strengthen cooperation in effectively dealing with the menace both bilaterally and at multilateral fora.
In a joint statement, both sides urged all countries and entities to work sincerely to disrupt terrorist networks and their financing and stop cross-border movement of terrorists.
The joint statement was issued after extensive talks between Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and Turkish President Mr Recep Tayyip Erdogan in New Delhi yesterday. The two leaders also called for early conclusion of negotiations on the Comprehensive Convention on International Terrorism (CCIT).
The statement said Shri Modi thanked Mr Erdogan



for Turkey's support for India's membership of the MTCR (Missile Technology Control Regime) and its application to join the Nuclear Suppliers Group as well as Wassenaar Arrangement, an export control regime. On terrorism, the statement said the two leaders reiterated their strong condemnation of and resolute opposition to terrorism in all its forms and

manifestations, wherever committed and by whomever, and declared that there could be no justification for terrorism anywhere. Referring to multilateral export control regimes, it said India and Turkey are united by common interests in preventing the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction (WMD) and their delivery systems. On reforms of the UN, Shri

Modi and Mr Erdogan stressed on the need for comprehensive reform of the global body including expansion of the Security Council to make the body more representative, accountable and effective. The statement said Mr Erdogan extended invitations to President Shri Pranab Mukherjee and to Shri Modi for visiting Turkey at mutually convenient time.

Union Minister asks CMs to soon notify rules under Real Estate Act

New Delhi, May 2
Union Minister Shri M Venkaiah Naidu has asked the Chief Ministers to soon notify the rules under the Real Estate Act, which has come into force yesterday. The Minister also expressed "deep concern" over reports that some states/UTs have diluted the key provisions of the Act.
In his letter to the Chief Ministers, Shri Naidu said the Act of Parliament has a certain inviolable sanctity and there can no such dilution of the provisions of the Act and the spirit of the Act.
He said it is a matter of concern that the real estate rules have so far notified only in respect of 14 states and UTs. Shri Naidu asked the states to set up the regulatory authority and the appellate tribunal under the Act. The Minister said no new (Contd. on last page)

Since the boat was not carrying Distress Alert Transmitter (DAT) and there was no communication equipment onboard, they could not inform owner / authorities regarding the distress situation, till their boat was sighted by helicopter. Coast Guard has also diverted ICGS Durgabai Deshmukh to retrieve the disabled boat to handover to the owner.

Coast Guard has reiterated that it is important for all fishermen to carry DAT, communication and lifesaving equipment on their boats, so that they can inform Coast Guard authorities about any distress situation and can be saved. Carrying of DAT is very important especially for those boats, which operate beyond the mobile tower range. Fishermen can also inform about any distress situation at sea to Coast Guard on Helpline Number 1554, a communication received from PRO Coast Guard said.
