Government approves supply of improved-quality rice under PMGKAY; over 80 crore beneficiaries to receive better-quality rice

Broken grain content reduced to 10% in raw rice and 5% in parboiled rice; phased rollout to begin from KMS 2027-28

New Delhi, July 2 (PIB)

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved a landmark reform to improve the quality of rice supplied under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) and Other Welfare Schemes. For the first time in nearly three decades, the Government has revised the quality specifications of rice supplied under the Public Distribution System ensuring that beneficiaries receive rice with substantially lower broken grain content while maintaining their existing entitlements.

Under the approved policy:

- > Raw rice supplied under PMGKAY will contain up to 10% broken grains, replacing the existing specification of up to 25%.
- > Parboiled rice will contain up to 5% broken grains, replacing the existing specification of up to 16%.

Procurement of improved-quality rice will commence immediately and will

be rolled out across all procuring States by the Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2027-28 in a phased manner.

Distribution of improved-quality rice under PMGKAY and Other Welfare Schemes will also be undertaken in a phased manner, ensuring a smooth transition to the revised specifications across all States.

Better quality for beneficiaries

The decision reflects

the Government's commitment not only to ensuring food security but also to improving the quality of food grains supplied to more than 80 crore beneficiaries under PMGKAY and Other Welfare Schemes. Beneficiaries will receive rice with better grain integrity, improved appearance and higher consumer acceptability without any change in their entitlement.

Farmers sensitized on Sustainable Agriculture under National Mission on Natural Farming

Urged to adopt natural farming practices by utilizing locally available resources

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 2

The Department of Agriculture, A&N Administration, recently organized a series of Orientation and Awareness Programmes under the National Mission on Natural Farming (NMNF) for farmers of the newly identified clusters at Karmatang and Webi villages under Rampur Gram Panchayat, Mayabunder Block, North & Middle Andaman District. The programmes were aimed at equipping farmers with the knowledge and skills required for adopting sustainable, climate-resilient and chemical-free farming practices.

The National Mission on Natural Farming (NMNF) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Government of India being implemented by the Department of Agriculture to promote eco-friendly agriculture through the use of locally available natural resources. During 2025-26, the Mission covered 100 hectares under two



clusters at Ferrargunj (South Andaman) and Adazig (North & Middle Andaman), benefiting 250 farmers. Building upon the encouraging progress achieved, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare has sanctioned an additional 100 hectares under NMNF for the year 2026-27, leading to the identification of two new clusters at Karmatang and Webi.

This will ensure that superior edible rice reaches beneficiaries under PMGKAY.

Fiscal and operational gains

The reform is expected to lead to rationalisation of transportation, storage and handling costs, as broken rice will be auctioned directly from millers' premises. Jute bag requirements will also reduce, with broken rice being stored in HDPE bags. This is expected to lead to annual cost rationalisation of Rs 2161 crore through reduced logistics, storage and packaging cost. In addition, the sale of broken rice will generate additional revenue, further helping to reduce the food subsidy burden.

Pilot Implementation

The proposal has already been validated through pilot implementation in multiple States like Haryana, Andhra Pradesh, Punjab, Odisha, Telangana and Chhattisgarh. The pilot has demonstrated the operational feasibility of producing improved-quality rice at scale. Following the Cabinet approval, the improved-quality rice generated under the pilot will also be supplied to beneficiaries under PMGKAY and Other Welfare Schemes.

Strengthening Transparency

The reform also envisages QR-code tagging of rice bags to enable end-to-end traceability across the supply chain, strengthening transparency, accountability and inventory management in the Public Distribution System, effectively plugging any scope for leakages.

The Government has ensured food security for every eligible household. The next step is to achieve food security with improved quality. This historic decision ensures that poor families receive better-quality rice with dignity while also improving efficiency, transparency and fiscal prudence in foodgrain management.

Conservator of Forests (Wildlife)-cum-Chief Wildlife Warden emphasized on the importance of continuous capacity building and the adoption of advanced scientific approaches in wildlife conservation.
