Lt Gen Praveen Bakshi, AVSM, VSM assumes Command of Eastern Army

Port Blair, Aug 2

Lt Gen Praveen Bakshi, AVSM, VSM took over as the 25th General Officer Commanding-in-Chief of Eastern Command in Kolkata on 01st Aug 2015. An alumnus of National Defence Academy (NDA), Lt Gen Bakshi was commissioned into Skinner's Horse regiment and has rich operational and command experience. Several other important positions held by him include the command of an armoured brigade in the Western sector, a division in the Desert Sector, and a Corps in Punjab and Jammu and Kashmir. The Eastern Command has its territorial jurisdiction in West Bengal and over all the eight north-eastern states, including Sikkim. It is responsible for the Borders with Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, Myanmar and Nepal.



The OSD to the Lt. Governor informs us that Lt Gen Praveen Bakshi has served under the Lt. Governor on many occasions and is highly regarded for his professionalism and dynamic approach. Lt Gen Bakshi is tipped to succeed Gen Dalbir Singh Suhag as Indian Army's next Chief in January

2017. Out of the present top brass of the Indian Army, most have served in the team of Lt Gen A K Singh when he was GOC Strike 1 and GOC-in-C Southern Command. These include the Vice Chief of Army Staff, Army Commanders of Western, South Western, Eastern, Strategic Forces and Army Training Command's.

Income Tax Department notifies tax return forms for non salaried class

New Delhi, Aug 2

The income tax department has notified tax return forms for non-salaried class, including companies, partners in firms and individuals deriving their income from proprietary business or profession.

The Central Board of Direct

Taxes (CBDT) has notified ITR3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 for Assessment Year 2015-16. These forms are used by non-salaried entities to file income tax returns. As per the notification, companies and firms filing returns under ITR-5 and 6 would be required to specify whether they are Foreign Institutional

Investors (FII)/Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPIs) and will have to furnish SEBI registration numbers. The government has earlier notified ITR forms 1 (Sahaj), 2, 2A and 4S (Sugam) for Assessment Year 2015-16. These are used for filing income tax returns by salaried individuals.

Parliamentary panel suggests single window clearance system to resolve all investor grievances

New Delhi, Aug 2

A Parliamentary panel has suggested single window clearance system to resolve all investor grievances. The panel has suggested bringing the grievance redressal mechanism under the proposed Investor Education and Protection Fund, IEPF

Authority. The suggestion comes against backdrop of rising instances of investors getting duped by fraudulent investment schemes and dubious companies. The proposed IEPF Authority would be responsible for administration of investor

education and protection funds, undertaking investor awareness, refund of unclaimed amounts, and reimbursement of legal expenses under class action suits. The Corporate Affairs Ministry is to set up the IEPF Authority under Companies Act, 2013.

New simplified Guidelines for Adoption of Children come into effect

New Delhi, Aug 2

The new simplified Guidelines Governing Adoption of Children 2015 have come into effect from yesterday. Women and Child Development Ministry has notified the revised guidelines on 17th of last month for governing adoption of children issued by the Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA). An official release said, the revised guidelines have been framed keeping in mind the

issues and challenges faced by CARA, Adoption Agencies and Prospective Adoptive Parents. It said, the new guidelines are intended to provide for more effective regulation for adoption of orphan, abandoned and surrendered children. The Ministry said, this will bring more transparency and efficiency in the adoption system.

The completely revamped Central Adoption Resource Information Guidance

System (CARINGS) will facilitate the adoption of maximum number of adoptable children and ensure a smoother adoption process by curbing undue delays.

CARINGS will contain a centralized data bank of adoptable children and Prospective Adoptive Parents. The Ministry said, all the District Child Protection Units will be connected online to CARINGS.

Eight more trains on Delhi Metro from today

New Delhi, Aug 2

Eight more trains will run across the Delhi Metro network from tomorrow. The decision to increase the number of trains was taken keeping in view the trend of increased ridership in the months of August and September over the last few years. The trains will run

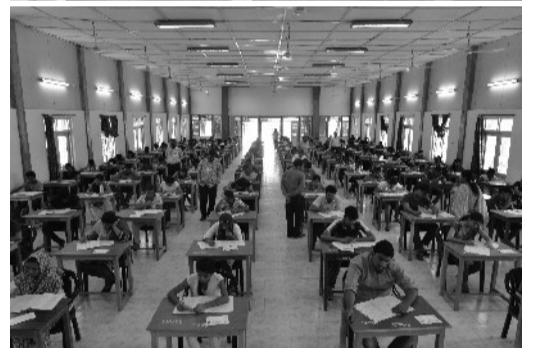
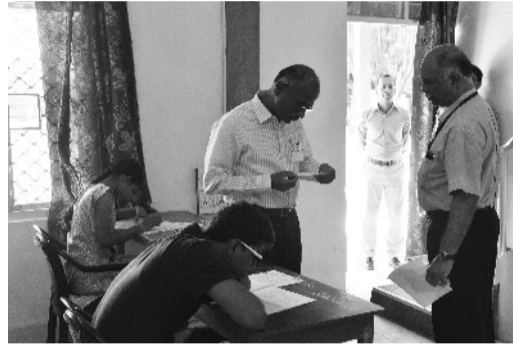
across the metro's busiest corridors during peak hours. Metro officials said the arrangement will continue for two months as of now and may remain in place depending on the requirement. These trains were added from the operational maintenance reserve kept in the metro train.

First ANIPMT held successfully amid tight security; 858 candidates appear for the exam at JNRM & KV-1

Port Blair, Aug 2

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS), Port Blair, which is due to start its first year MBBS classes from 1st September, 2015, has taken the first step by conducting the Andaman Nicobar Islands Pre-Medical Test (ANIPMT-2015) successfully today. About 900 candidates had registered for the ANIPMT, out of which 858 candidates appeared for the test, which was conducted at two venues, namely, JNRM College, Port Blair and Kendriya Vidyalaya No.1, Port Blair.

The examination was completed successfully without any untoward incident. Around 125 personnel, apart from 50 security personnel were engaged to ensure free and fair conduction of the ANIPMT -2015. The ANIIMS, on behalf of Andaman and Nicobar Administration, has thanked all the candidates and their parents for the cooperation received in conduction of ANIPMT-2015. ANIIMS has also thanked the Principals and staff of JNRM College, Port Blair and Kendriya Vidyalaya -1, Port Blair for



their efforts and cooperation in smooth conduct of the first ever ANIPMT in the Islands. **DT Reporters add:** Students from across the A&N Islands appeared for the ANIPMT amid tight security measures, who were allowed inside only after being frisked at both the centres around 9.30 am for the exam which started at 10 am. Students from outstations were seen gathering outside

the exam centres since 8 am. As the exams ended at 1 pm, coming out from the centre at KV. 1, some of the students shared their views with the DT Reporter after giving their exams. Vennila Ravichandran, from K.V-2 said her exam was quite good. Similarly Mridul from GSSS Baratang said he has done quite well in all the three papers. The confident looking

duo of Roseline and Bhuvaneshwari of Sabri School, Rangat said they had done well and completed it on time. Outside the JNRM College, another centre for the ANIPMT, Sarmistha Bhowmick, a passed out student from JNV Panchawati told the Reporter that she was satisfied with the examination.

Some of the parents outside the JNRM College said that this was one of the strictest security arrangements they have seen for an entrance examination in A&N Islands. "We are happy that best arrangements were made for this exam by the authorities and hope that our wards come out with flying colours", they expressed.

Central regulatory regime for AYUSH drugs

New Delhi, Aug 2

The Government has considered setting up a structured central regulatory regime for AYUSH drugs. In this regard, the current proposal is to have a vertical structure for AYUSH in the Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO).

Procedural steps for setting up this structure have been initiated but the timeframe for which cannot be specified at this stage.

Presently, the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules thereunder have exclusive provisions for AYUSH drugs, which are

enforced by the State Governments.

For regulating the practice of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy, the Government has established Central Council of Indian Medicine and Central Council of Homoeopathy under the provisions of Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 respectively.

UPSC refrains civil service aspirants from bringing gadgets, valuable items to prelims

New Delhi, Aug 2

The Union Public Service Commission has asked the candidates appearing for civil services preliminary examination, not to bring mobile phones, IT gadgets and valuable items with them. It said, these items are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. The Commission said, any infringements of these instructions shall entail

disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.

It said, the candidates are advised not to bring any valuable or costly items and bags to the examination halls, as safekeeping of the same cannot be assured. The Commission said, it will not be responsible for any loss in this regard. The civil services preliminary exam, 2015 is scheduled to be held on August 23. It will be held in

two sessions and each session will have two hours plus twenty minutes per hour extra time for visually impaired candidates. The physically handicapped candidates, who have been permitted by the Commission to bring their own scribe to write the exam, will be allowed to avail the assistance of such scribe only if he or she carries a valid admit card duly issued by the Commission for such purpose.

BCCI to introduce Player Agent Accreditation System

New Delhi, Aug 2
Continuing its efforts to clean up the game, the BCCI on Sunday said it will put in place a Player Agent Accreditation System to ensure that those handling the cricketers' commercial interests are bound by a code of conduct. "In order to make the structure thorough enough and to ensure that player agents are bound by the set of laws and the code of conduct, a thorough and extensive Player Agent Accreditation System would be in place soon," BCCI President Jagmohan Dalmiya said in statement. "Discussions and consultations involving all stakeholders would be held shortly in order to achieve a high degree of acceptance and to propose a new system that is transparent and easier to administer," added Board Secretary Anurag Thakur. The BCCI has already initiated the process of preparing a comprehensive Code of Ethics in addition to already asked for "Conflict of Interest"

Declarations. "BCCI is concerned and determined to safeguard its integrity. The Code of Ethics when formed would define important core values for behaviour and conduct within the BCCI. It would be a good way of ensuring that administrators and officials refrain from anything that could be harmful to BCCI's aims and objectives," Dalmiya said. "The code would describe the minimum requirements for conduct and behavioural expectations. To ensure transparency, BCCI would get the draft ethics code vetted and finalised by an eminent senior lawyer with impeccable credibility and reputation," asserted Thakur. Further details regarding the Code of Ethics and Agent Agreement will be discussed in



the next working committee meeting of the BCCI. The BCCI had earlier notified all the Board members to sign an undertaking declaring that they do not have 'conflict of interest' while holding honorary posts in their respective cricket associations. The 'no conflict of interest' clause would include no direct business links with any cricketing affairs in BCCI including interest or stake in IPL teams, sponsorships or looking after specific players' interests.

India women's recurve team claims silver in World Archery Championship

Copenhagen, Aug 2
The Indian women's recurve archery team of Deepika Kumari, Laxmirani Majhi and Rimil Buriuli had to settle for the silver as they lost the World Championship final 4-5 to Russia in an edge-of-the-seat encounter at the Christiansborg Palace here on Sunday. The Russian team comprising Inna Stepanova, Ksenia Perova and Tuyana Dashidorzheva clinched the contest in a nerve-wrecking tie-breaker which ended 28-27 in their favour. The Indian trio were quick to get off the blocks to claiming the first set 56-54. They were again steady in the second set to clinch it 54-53 and thus a 4-0 lead. The Russian team took their own sweet time and slowly

got into their groove to pocket two 10 pointers in the third set when they needed it the most to edge past the Indians. They claimed the third 56-52 to come back into the contest at 2-4. The Indians failed to respond and crumbled under pressure in the fourth set as they hit scores of six, seven and eight. The total they amassed was 50 which was easily surpassed by their rivals to then levelled at 4-4, taking the match into the tie-breaker. The decider turned out to be a thrilling contest as India's 10 was matched with another 10 points from Russia. But an eight-pointer cost India the match as the Russian trio hit two back-to-back nines to clinch the contest and the gold medal.

John Isner faces Marcos Baghdatis for third straight Atlanta title

Luxembourg, Aug 2
Top-seeded John Isner kept his bid for a third straight Atlanta title on track Saturday, rallying for a three-set semi-final victory over qualifier and friend Denis Kudla. Isner unleashed 25 aces and converted three of nine break chances to defeat his fellow American 4-6, 6-2, 7-5. In Sunday's final he faces fifth-seeded Cypriot Marcos Baghdatis, a 6-7 (4/7), 6-3, 7-6 (7/4) winner over seventh-seeded Gilles Muller of Luxembourg. Kudla, ranked 94th in the world and still seeking a first ATP title, broke Isner for a 4-3 lead in the opening frame and went on to pocket the set in 36 minutes. Stung, Isner raised his game, blasting nine aces and breaking

Kudla twice. "I got stronger and stronger as that match went on," said Isner, who dropped just six points in as many service games in the third set. "I was feeling not so great in the first set, winded." The 22-year-old Kudla, a friend and sometime practice partner of Isner, noted the difference, particularly in the power of Isner's serve. "He started flattening out his serve," Kudla said. "In the beginning, he was trying to pick his spots and I could get a racket on it. When he gets up toward 140 (miles per hour), that's when it gets tough." Baghdatis, playing his third ATP semi-final of the year, broke through to reach his first final since Kuala Lumpur in 2011.

WADA alarmed by extent of allegations from leaked blood tests data

Kuala Lumpur, Aug 2
The World Anti-Doping Agency on Sunday said it was alarmed by the size and extent of "wild" doping allegations after IAAF test data leaked to news organisations showed hundreds of suspect samples from athletes, including Olympic and world championship medalists. Britain's Sunday Times newspaper and German broadcaster ARD/WDR say they had been given access to the results of 12,359 blood tests given by more than 5,000 athletes over 11 years in a case that could plunge athletics into a new doping crisis.

"These are wild allegations, wide allegations and we will check them out and have that done with the commission as quickly as possible," WADA chief Craig Reddie told reporters in Kuala Lumpur. An independent commission is already investigating previous allegations of mass doping. "I am very surprised by the numbers from the leak from the IAAF I am sure they will want to look at it closely to determine the source," Reddie said. "It was the spread of the allegations that came from previous programmes (that surprised me).

New Delhi, Aug 2

The Government provides regular plan support for implementation of various schemes. The regular plan support earmarked for all ZCCs for implementation of their Action Plan in the current financial year 2015-2016 is Rs 59.91 crores. The Government will continue to preserve and promote the folk and tribal arts and culture of all the States/ Union Territories by carrying out various activities and organizing



programmes at national, zonal and local levels through ZCCs. This information was given by The Minister of State for Tourism (Independent

Charge), Culture (Independent Charge) and Civil Aviation, Dr. Mahesh Sharma in reply to an unstarred question in the Rajya Sabha.

World's widest suspension bridge being built over Bosphorus

Istanbul, Aug 2

In Turkey, a new bridge, the widest in the world, being constructed over the Bosphorus Strait, will provide another transportation route connecting Europe and Asia. Thousands of employees and engineers are working 24 hours a day on construction

of the Yavuz Sultan Selim Bridge in Istanbul. The suspension bridge is almost 60 meters wide with eight traffic lanes and two rail lines. It will stretch over 2 kilometers with about 1.5 kilometers over water, and will be the longest suspension bridge in the world carrying a rail system.

India to produce at least a dozen billionaires by 2020: ASSOCHAM

New Delhi, Aug 2

India is likely to produce at least a dozen more billionaires by 2020 as the country's start-ups scene heats up, an ASSOCHAM study has projected. The study said India will be among the top Asian start-up giants, along with China and South-East Asian countries. It also said that even as

structural problems in China are likely to create roadblock for the start-ups there, no such issue confronts Indian start-ups. The study said the maximum value creation is expected in areas like e-commerce, music-entertainment, payment gate-ways, and city transport aggregators like radio taxis.
