Maintaining, improving quality of forests major challenge for country: Minister

New Delhi, Sept 2
 The Minister of State (Independent Charge) of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Prakash Javadekar, today emphasised that forest and wildlife officers must focus on the 4 'I's - Image, Innovation, Initiative and Interaction. Addressing the inaugural session of the two-day Conference of all Principal Chief Conservators of Forests and Wildlife Wardens here today, Shri Javadekar said that

maintaining and improving the quality of forests is a major challenge. He said, "We must ensure that degraded forest must be converted into moderately dense forest in 10 years and moderately dense forest must be converted into dense forests in 5 years. To that end, water harvesting and changing some species is a must. Forest research institutes must draw up a distinct plan of improving the quality of each forest, taking the existing flora and climate

into consideration". He laid emphasis on ensuring people's participation in changing the quality of forests. He also urged the officers to provide solutions to various challenges. The Minister said that a lot of good work is being done and such success stories and initiatives must be highlighted prominently. The two-day Conference will discuss various issues related to forest and wildlife, such as Forest Conservation Act, Eco Sensitive Zones (ESZs) and

minimising human-wildlife conflict. Seventy-five PCCFs and higher officials representing all the 32 States are participating in the Conference.

Shri Javadekar released a report - "Management effectiveness evaluation of National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries in India, 2006-2014". The agreement to establish the world's first centre of World Natural Heritage & Training at the Wildlife Institute of India was

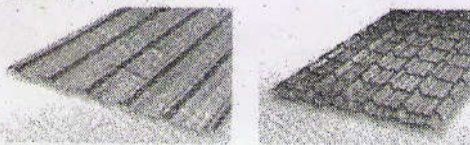

Durban to host 2022 Commonwealth Games

Durban, Sept 2
Durban in South Africa will host the 2022 Commonwealth Games, becoming the first African city to be awarded the four-yearly multi-sports event. The 71 nations and territories of the Commonwealth Games Federation made the decision unanimously on Wednesday after receiving Durban's final candidate city briefing at the general assembly in Auckland. Durban was the only candidate left when Edmonton, Canada withdrew its bid in February, citing costs. The general assembly also voted to increase the number of compulsory sports at the games from 10 to 16. Scotland's Louise Martin was elected the first female president of the federation, deposing incumbent Prince Tunku Imran of Malaysia who held the role for four years. Durban's final pitch to Federation members included contributions from South Africa's minister for sport Fikile Mbalula and Durban mayor James Nxumalo. The announcement was broadcast



live in South Africa. Members of the South African delegation said while Durban was the lone candidate, it was not a certainty to be awarded the Games. It still had to demonstrate it had the ability and the infrastructure to host games which would be financially viable. South Africa's record in hosting the football World Cup in 2010 and the Rugby World Cup in 1995 demonstrated its organisational ability but it has not yet hosted a multi-sports event of the scale of the Commonwealth Games. The games are scheduled to

open 18th July 2022, marking the birthday of South Africa's first black president, Nelson Mandela, who died in 2013. Principals of the Durban bid committee have said existing infrastructure will be used to minimise costs and the Games, scheduled to take place over 12 days, will make a profit. An athletics track will be installed at the existing Moses Mabhida Stadium and venues are already in place to host cycling, swimming and indoor events. An athlete's village will be constructed.

Cricket Tournament for people with physical disabilities

Dhaka, Sept 2
The first ever International Cricket Tournament for People with Physical Disabilities begins in Dhaka today. Organised by the International Committee of the Red Cross, the T-20 event has five nations including India, England, Pakistan, Afghanistan and Bangladesh participating.

Two Asian teenagers advance to second round of the US Open

US, Sept 2
Two Asian teenagers, both 19, have advanced to the second round of the US Open, set to make warnings of a rising young generation of stars come true on tennis' biggest stage. Japanese qualifier Yoshihito Nishioka outlasted France's Paul-Henri Mathieu 6-4, 2-6, 6-7, 6-1, 6-2 after three hours and 22 minutes in sweltering heat while South Korea's Chung Hyeon ripped Australian James Duckworth 6-3, 6-1, 6-2 in 96 minutes.

Dhoni, Sehwag to be part of charity match in London

London, Sept 2
India ODI captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni will join compatriot Virender Sehwag and a host of other international cricketers for a charity match at the Kia Oval here on September 17. Dhoni and Sehwag will be sharing the dressing room with Pakistan's Shahid Afridi and South African ace Herschelle Gibbs of the team named Help for Heroes XI captained by England Director of Cricket Andrew Strauss and managed by the great Ian Botham. They will take on a Rest of the World XI containing Brendon McCullum, Matthew Hayden, Mahela Jayawardene and Graeme Smith as well as players such as Kiwis Scott Styris and Daniel Vettori and charismatic Afghan Shapoor Zadran.

Ishant, Pujara enter top-20 in ICC Test rankings

Dubai, Sept 2
"Cheteshwar Pujara has broken into the top 20 of the ICC Player Rankings for Test Batsmen for the first time in his career following the conclusion of the Colombo Test, which India won by 117 runs to clinch the series 2-1," the ICC said in a statement in Dubai on Wednesday. The 27-year-old batsman carried his bat in the first innings and returned unbeaten on 145 not out, his seventh career century, which was the cornerstone of India's first innings score of 312. For this performance, Pujara has been rewarded with a jump of four places, which puts him in 20th position. Pujara is now the second India batsman to feature in the top 20, but following Virat Kohli's drop to 11th (down by one place), the fifth-ranked side has no batsman inside the top 10.

Apart from Pujara, there were few other middle-order batsmen who made significant contributions to India's cause at the Singhaile Sports Club, which, in turn, have helped them to head in the right direction. Rohit Sharma has moved up two places to 48th, Ravichandran Ashwin has gained five places and is now in 50th spot, while Amit Mishra, who scored 59 in the first innings and featured in a 104 runs eighth wicket partnership with Pujara, has vaulted 56 places to 91st. It was a disappointing Test for Sri Lanka batsmen. However, Angelo Mathews has retained his fifth ranking following his seventh career century (110 in the second innings). He is now 11 points adrift of fourth-ranked South Africa captain Hashim Amla.

Devendro in semifinals, qualifies for worlds

Bangkok, Sept 2
Devendro Singh (49kg) assured himself of a medal and a place in the upcoming World Championships by storming into the Asian Championships semifinals here on Tuesday. Devendro, a silver-medallist from the previous edition of the event, out-punched Cornelis Kwangu Langu of Indonesia 3-0 in his quarterfinal bout. He will square off against top-seeded Uzbek Hasanboy Dusmatov in the semifinals. This win assured Devendro of a place in the October World Championships — the first qualifying event for next year's

Rio Olympics. "He boxed extremely well today. It was a very dominant performance and even though he faces a very tough opponent in the next round, he might just surprise everybody given the form that he is in," national coach Gurbax Singh Sandhu said. The pint-sized dynamo was his usual aggressive self, using his right uppercuts and hooks with precision in all three rounds. What stood out was the Manipuri's control. Known to be a tempo boxer, Devendro's aggression wasn't completely no holds barred.

Federer, Murray, Wawrinka advance at US Open

New York, Sept 2
Scot tennis star Andy Murray, Swiss second seed Roger Federer, his compatriot Stan Wawrinka and Czech Tomas Berdych advanced to the second round of the US Open here. Murray defeated controversial Australian Nick Kyrgios 7-5, 6-3, 4-6, 6-1 in the last match of the second day on Tuesday.

Murray, the tournament's winner in 2012, made no concessions for Kyrgios, mixing up his game well even though his serve remained inconsistent, reports Efe. The third seed Scot managed to win decisive points in his first set success, as he carried forward the momentum into the second set, and eventually secured his victory.
