PM Modi & Egyptian President hold delegation level talks; two countries sign maritime transport agreement



New Delhi, Sep 2 India and Egypt have signed an agreement in the area of Maritime Transport to step up co-operation on the seas. The agreement was signed after delegation level talks between Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and visiting President of Egypt Mr Abdel Fattah El-Sisi in

New Delhi. In his press statement, Shri Modi said, growing radicalisation, including violence and spread of terror are a real threat across regions. Pitching for greater information and operational exchanges to combat terrorism, the two countries also agreed to cooperate on emerging

challenges of cyber security. They will work together to fight drug trafficking, transitional crimes and money laundering. Saying trade and investment linkages are essential for eco prosperity of the societies, Shri Modi called for increased flow of goods,

services and capital between India and Egypt. Shri Modi appreciated Egypt's good work during its current term on UNSC. Shri Modi said the two sides agreed that UNSC needs to be reformed to reflect today's realities. He said, India and Egypt decided to facilitate greater people-to-people contacts

Rotational load shedding by Electricity Department

Port Blair, Sept. 2 Due to breakdown of a 5 MW DG set of M/s. SPCL Power Plant at Bambooflat, the Electricity Department is excising half an hour to one hour rotational load shedding from 5.30 pm to 10.30 pm in Port Blair and South Andaman area w.e.f. 27.7.2016. The load shedding during evening hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM will further continue till the damaged DG set at M/s. SPCL Power Plant is repaired. The

schedule is tentative and may change any time subject to actual available power generation. The schedule will be repeated after every 3rd day, till rectification of DG Set of 20 MW IPP, Bambooflat. In addition, rotational load shedding if required will be carried out during day hours also on as and when required basis. The electricity consumers have been requested to cooperate with the Department.

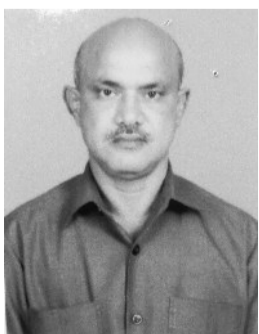

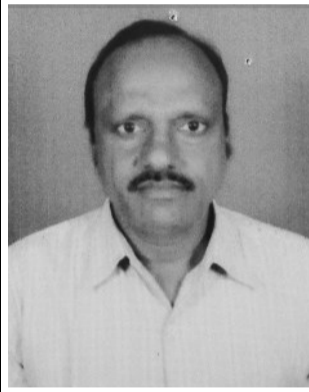

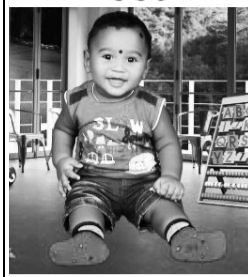

In the 2nd round of Men's Singles event, Briton Murray registered easy straight set victory over Spaniard Marcel Granollers 6-4, 6-1, 6-4. While Japanese Nishikori recorded win against Russian Karen Khachanov 6-4, 4-6, 6-4, 6-3. The Indo-German pair of Leander Paes and Andre Begemann are yet to play their first round match in men's



doubles event. While, Rohan Bopanna along with his partner moved to 2nd round. Sania Mirza along with her new partner Barbora Strycova have also made it to the second round of women's doubles.

Indian Para athletes leave for Paralympic Games

New Delhi, Sep 2
Indian para athletes left for the Brazilian city of Rio de Janeiro last night for the Summer Paralympic Games beginning next week. The Indian contingent, largest-ever from the country, comprises of 18 athletes. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in a tweet wished the very best to the athletes. He said, the people of country will be enthusiastically cheering for them. He expressed the hope that the athletes will give their



best and make everyone proud. The Paralympic Games begin on Wednesday and will conclude on 18th of this month.

Ryan Harris to coach Australian bowlers on tour of South Africa

Melbourne, Sept 2
Former paceman Ryan Harris has taken a major step towards achieving his ambition of becoming Australia's permanent bowling coach after the 36-year-old was handed the role for the team's limited-overs tour of South Africa. Harris, who retired from all forms of cricket last year, played 27 tests, 21 one-day internationals and three Twenty20s for Australia. He will join head coach Darren Lehmann and assistant coach David Saker on the tour starting on Sept. 27, where Australia will play a single one-dayer against Ireland and a five-match series against hosts South Africa.

Italian Grand Prix: Nico Rosberg leads Lewis Hamilton in first practice

Monza, Sept 2
Nico Rosberg led Mercedes team mate Lewis Hamilton in another show of strength by the dominant Formula One champions in first practice for the Italian Grand Prix on Friday. The German lapped the fastest track on the calendar with a best time of one minute 22.959 seconds, 0.203 quicker than championship leader Hamilton. Ferrari were best of the rest at their home track with Finland's Kimi Raikkonen third on the timesheets but more than a second off Rosberg's pace while team mate Sebastian Vettel was fourth. The Italian team have used the last of their season's engine 'tokens' for a power boost at the track outside Milan after ceding second place in the championship to Red Bull. Hamilton leads Rosberg by nine points going into the last European race of the season but can hope to extend that on Sunday. The Briton is chasing his third successive Italian Grand Prix win, a feat that has not been achieved since the late Argentine Juan Manuel Fangio



in the 1950s, and 50th career victory. Rosberg, winner in Belgium last weekend, set his best lap on the soft tyres as did Hamilton, who was one of several drivers to have off-track excursions as they probed the limits. McLaren's Fernando Alonso provided the only real incident of the session when he crawled back to the pits with a gearbox problem five minutes from the end. Mexican Sergio Perez was fifth fastest for Force India, ahead of Romain Grosjean's Ferrari-powered Haas and the Williams of Valtteri Bottas. Dutch teenager Max Verstappen, whose aggressive defending against Raikkonen at Spa last weekend is still the talk of the paddock, was eighth for Red Bull.

Novak Djokovic, Rafael Nadal face Russian obstacles at US Open

New York, Sept 2
Novak Djokovic, well rested after not playing since Monday, resumes his US Open title defence Friday against fiery Russian Mikhail Youzhny, a two-time semi-finalist in New York, for a last-16 place. World number one Djokovic claimed a laboured win over

Poland's Jerzy Janowicz in his opening match in which he required treatment on his right upper arm. Fortunately for the two-time champion, he was able to rest up for the rest of the week after scheduled second round opponent Jiri Vesely handed him a walkover into the third round.

Aussie pacers Mitchell Starc, Josh Hazlewood to miss South Africa ODI series

Sydney, Sept 2
Pace pair Mitchell Starc and Josh Hazlewood will be rested for this month's one-day international series in South Africa, Cricket Australia said on Friday. Starc and Hazlewood would be stood down to allow them time to refresh ahead of the Australian summer season, CA said. "Mitchell and Josh have had big tours of Sri Lanka and have a heavy workload ahead of them with ten Tests to be played this (domestic) summer," chief selector Rod Marsh said. "As such, it is important they are

managed appropriately and we believe missing the tour of South Africa is the right time for them to take a break." Marsh added that this would serve as a good opportunity for up-and-coming fast bowlers to push for selection. Marsh said that with a number of bowlers returning from injury, it was important for the national team to continue to build up a battery of quality fast-bowlers. Earlier this week Australian paceman Nathan Coulter-Nile was ruled out for an indefinite spell after returning home early from the Sri Lanka ODI series with a serious back injury.

High wave warning

Port Blair, Sept. 2
High waves in the range of 3.0 - 3.9 meters have been forecasted in Andaman till Sept. 4 along the west coast of Andaman Islands between Ten Degree Channel to Coco Channel. Current speeds vary between 39 - 50 cm/sec. Meanwhile, similar high waves have been forecasted in Nicobar till Sept. 4 along the west coast of Nicobar Islands between Ten Degree Channel to Great Channel. incorporated in the Visa Manual to provide for the grant of PRS to foreign investors. The PRS will be granted for a period of ten years with multiple entry. This can be reviewed for another 10 years if the PRS holder has not come to adverse notice. The scheme will be applicable only to foreign investors fulfilling the prescribed eligibility conditions, his/her spouse and dependents. In order to avail this scheme, the foreign investor will have to invest a minimum of 10 crores rupees to be brought within 18 months or 25 crores rupees to be brought within 36 months. Further, the foreign investment should result in generating employment to at least 20 resident Indians every financial year. PRS will serve as a multiple entry visa without any stay stipulation and PRS holders will be exempted from the registration requirements. PRS holders will be allowed to purchase one residential property for dwelling purpose.
