The Minister also said the country is set to exceed the target of 175 GW in renewable energy and

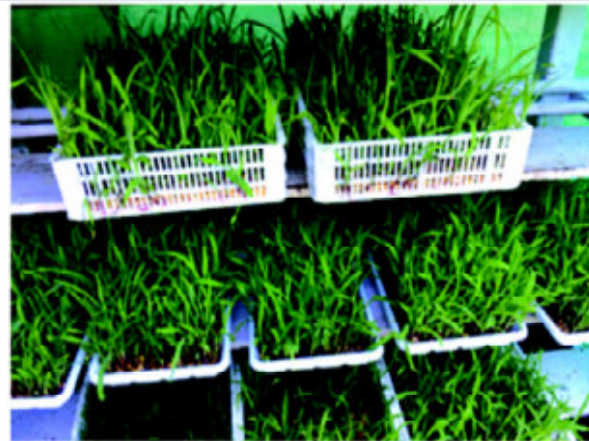

The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services is leaving no stone unturned to improve the dairy production in Isles. Giving information about the various steps initiated by the Department, the Secretary, AH&VS, Shri Ramesh Verma while speaking to the DT Reporter recently said, as per the record, the Islands have sufficient meat and eggs while the milk products are deficient. Although the expected quantity of milk production is 20000 MT but only 15000 MT of milk is produced as of now. This, he said, is due to various

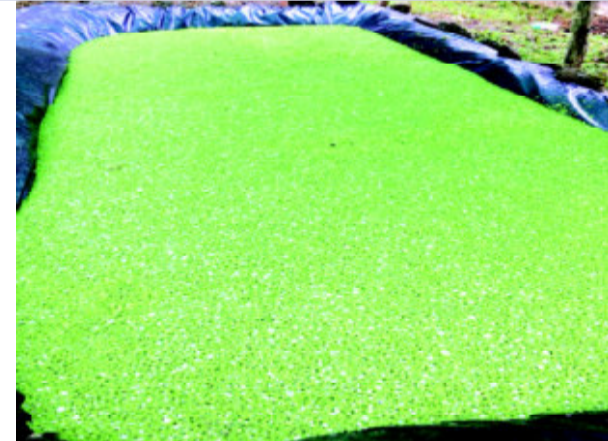

constraints such as availability of land for feed and fodder and good quality cattle.

The farmers of Isles have demanded for good breed cattle from mainland, however, there are several

challenges which need to be looked into viz. adaptability issue due to climate change, transportation and management aspect; besides it cannot be guaranteed that the cattle brought from mainland would perform

equally well under the climatic conditions. Another important aspect which needs to be considered is

that the A&N Islands are free from important cattle diseases, hence extra measures like quarantine

certification has to be taken while transporting cattle from mainland to the Islands, so as to ensure that no such diseases are brought to the Islands leading to loss of life of the local cattle, said the Secretary.

Various measures are being taken to deal with the issues. Accordingly, visits were made to the National Dairy Development Board, Anand, Gujarat to meet the stakeholders and discuss on how to increase milk production here in Isles. As

It's a record 4th time! India win U-19 World Cup against Aussies



Mount Maunganui, Feb 3
India won the U-19 World Cup final against Australia by 8 wickets on Saturday in Mount Maunganui, as the young guns got off to a big start. Earlier, it was a terrific start for Ishant Porel, who struck hard to send Australia's opening stand of Max Bryant and Jack Edwards back to the pavilion. Following which Kamlesh Nagarkoti removed captain Sangha for mere 13 runs. Both teams come into the all-important contest on the back of comprehensive wins in the last-4. Australia beat Afghanistan by six wickets but India went a step further against arch-rivals Pakistan to inflict a 203 run spanking. Prithvi Shaw-captained India had faced Australia at the start of the tournament and had emerged triumphant by 100 runs. The Indian side has put in some impressive performance to win all their five matches - one of which also

includes an emphatic 203-run win against arch-rivals Pakistan in the semifinal. Australia, on the other hand, have not had a smooth sailing all the way. They lost their tournament opener against India, before winning four games in a row to make it to the final. However, Jason Sangha-led Australian side's last two performances signal that they have upped their game when it mattered. Shubman Gill has been the most consistent batsman of the tournament. He scored a scintillating hundred in the semis and helped India in posting a winning total against Pakistan. India have lifted the Under-19 World Cup trophy thrice and Prithvi Shaw has joined the likes of Mohammad Kaif (2002), Virat Kohli (2008) and Unmukt Chand (2012) to become fourth Indian captain to lift the U-19 World Cup title. They have a calm head in Rahul Dravid as their head coach, and he will ensure that the team doesn't get complacent, keeping the focus on the job at hand.

a result of these discussions, some steps are being taken to improve the productivity of milk in the near future. The Department will also be introducing embryo transfer technology by which, it is proposed that around 500 frozen embryos of good quality cattle will be supplied by National Dairy Services (NDS), so that it can be inseminated into the local cattle here. This in turn will give rise to a good generation of cattle from mainland and the risk of important cattle disease can be prevented.

Meanwhile, for mitigating the problem of fodder, the Department will opt for alternative method of fodder production by encouraging Azolla cultivation which is a free-floating water fern. The azolla cultivation can be easily done and it has high protein. Plans are also being made to introduce hydroponic fodder cultivation, he said, and the Department is on the process of purchasing hydroponic machine for demonstration to the farmers.

The Secretary further informed that in order to facilitate farmers with marketing facility, the Department is trying to motivate the farmers to form a village level cooperative society so that they can be self-reliant and get their own feed and also sell their produce, either dairy or livestock. Also, some land are available with the Department which can be used for growing grass for feeding cattle, he said adding that the Department is also planning to hold discussion with the Panchayats in this regard during Farmers Meet.

Meanwhile, the Department will also be establishing Model Dairy Farms at Car Nicobar, Basantipur (N&M Andaman) and Neil Island. This, he said, will enable farmers to have better knowledge on the method of rearing cattle, feeding, milking etc. He also informed that the existing cattle holding farm at Dollygunj will be upgraded soon and hydroponic machine will also be installed there.

India to take on hosts SA in 2nd ODI at Centurion today

Centurion, Feb 3
After their first ever Cricket ODI win against South Africa at Durban on Thursday, a buoyant India will take on the hosts at Centurion on Sunday in the six match series. The second ODI will be a day-game and the only one in this series, on account of a Sunday, as is the norm in South Africa. The match starts at 1.30 p.m. Indian Standard Time. Thursday's defeat has ended the Portea's 17 match unbeaten

run on home soil. In the aftermath of the Durban defeat, South Africa have lost skipper du Plessis to a finger injury. He suffered a blow during the first ODI and later scans revealed that he had suffered a fracture, thus ruling him out for three to six weeks. He will miss the remainder of the ODI series as well as the entire T20I series against India. In view of this, Cricket South Africa today named 23-year-old batsman Aiden

Markram as skipper for the remaining five ODI matches against India. Markram has only featured in two ODIs so far, making his debut against Bangladesh in October last year. He has also played 6 Tests. He led South Africa to Under-19 World Cup triumph in 2014 and was widely regarded as a future captain. However, Du Plessis' unfortunate injury prompted selectors to fast-track Markram to the hot-seat.
