A&N Islands creates second Guinness World Record by forming 'Tallest Human Stack Underwater' at Light House Dive Site, Swaraj Dweep

Hon'ble Lt. Governor lauds divers, officials & all Stakeholders for their teamwork & dedication in achieving twin GWR records for A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 3, 2026
 Further strengthening the spirit of excellence, the Andaman & Nicobar Islands today achieved another milestone, by creating a second Guinness World Record titled 'Tallest Human Stack Underwater' at the Lighthouse dive site, Swaraj Dweep. The height of 'Tallest Human Stack Underwater' was measured as 22.3 metres with 3 minutes duration.

Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency participated in the event at Swaraj Dweep with 14 scuba divers forming the 'Tallest Human Stack Underwater'.

Upon completion of the event, a function was held in the conference hall of the Dolphin Resort at Swaraj Dweep in the evening wherein Mr. Rishi Nath, Adjudicator from Guinness World Records, officially announced the creation of the new world record and presented the certificate to A&N Administration.

The Hon'ble Lt. Governor commended the divers, officials, and all stakeholders for their exceptional teamwork, dedication, and commitment in achieving the twin Guinness World Records (GWR) viz. 'Largest National Flag Unfurled Underwater' (60 m x 40 m; 2,400 sq.m.) and 'Tallest Human Stack Underwater' (22.3 metres height).

The twin GWR attempts were planned by the A&N Administration to spotlight the islands' exceptional underwater wealth and to position A&N Islands as a premier international diving



destination. The success in both the event has further reinforced the Islands' reputation as a world-class destination for underwater exploration and diving.

Development, not destruction Union Ministry of Environment on Great Nicobar project

New Delhi, May 3
 A day after Rahul Gandhi criticised the Great Nicobar project, the government defended the initiative as a strategically significant national project aimed at the holistic development.

The government on Friday strongly rejected Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's allegation and said that it is a project of "strategic national importance" aimed at strengthening India's maritime, economic and security footprint in the Indo-Pacific region.

In a detailed clarification issued after Gandhi's remarks on Wednesday, the Union Ministry of Environment said the project, planned at Campbell Bay in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, has been designed to balance development with ecological safeguards and protection of indigenous communities.

The Ministry said the

Great Nicobar Project aims to transform the island into a key maritime and economic hub, leveraging its proximity of about 40 nautical miles to the East-West international shipping route.

"The Great Nicobar Project is a strategic project which aims to strengthen India's presence in the Andaman Sea and Southeast Asia. The project seeks to balance port-led growth with environmental safeguards and protection of indigenous communities," the clarification said.

It added, "By combining strategic, economic and ecological priorities, the project seeks to ensure that development in Great Nicobar is sustainable, inclusive and aligned with national interests."

The ambitious project includes multiple large-scale infrastructure

developments. They include an International Container Transshipment Terminal (ICTT) with a capacity of 14.2 million TEUs; a greenfield international airport capable of handling 4,000 peak-hour passengers; a 450 MVA gas and solar-based power plant and planned

township spanning over 16,610 hectares.

The ministry said these components are designed to support port-led economic growth and position Great Nicobar as a critical logistics and connectivity hub in the region.

"Tribal welfare remains central, with no

displacement proposed for Shompen and Nicobarese communities and a net increase in notified tribal reserve area through re-notification measures," it added.

Addressing concerns over deforestation, the government said the

Deptt. of CS & CA conducts surprise inspection; seizes massive stockpile of LPG cylinders at Bimblitan village

Dedicated 24x7 Control Room established to address LPG-related complaints & reports of malpractice

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 3

In a major crackdown on the illegal hoarding and unsafe storage of essential commodities, the Enforcement Team of the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs conducted a surprise inspection on April 25, 2026 at residential premises in Bimblitan village, under Sippighat Panchayat, South Andaman.

The joint operation, carried out in close coordination with officials from Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) and the Andaman and Nicobar Police Department, led to the discovery of a massive stockpile of LPG cylinders. A total of 140 cylinders (both filled and empty) were found stored in an unauthorized and hazardous manner within the residential area.

This act constitutes a direct violation of the



Essential Commodities Act, 1955, and posed a severe threat to public safety and the surrounding neighborhood. The seized cylinders have been successfully shifted to an authorized LPG storage facility for safe custody. Following the seizure, appropriate legal proceedings have been initiated against the individuals involved under the relevant provisions of the law.

The Administration reiterates its zero-tolerance policy toward the illegal storage and misuse of LPG. Such activities not only disrupt

the supply chain but also risk lives due to the volatile nature of the commodity.

The public have been requested to ensure that LPG cylinders are handled and stored strictly according to prescribed safety norms, refrain from engaging in or supporting unauthorized hoarding and report any suspicious or illegal activities to the authorities immediately.

A dedicated 24x7 Control Room has been established at the Directorate of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs to address LPG- (Contd. on last page)

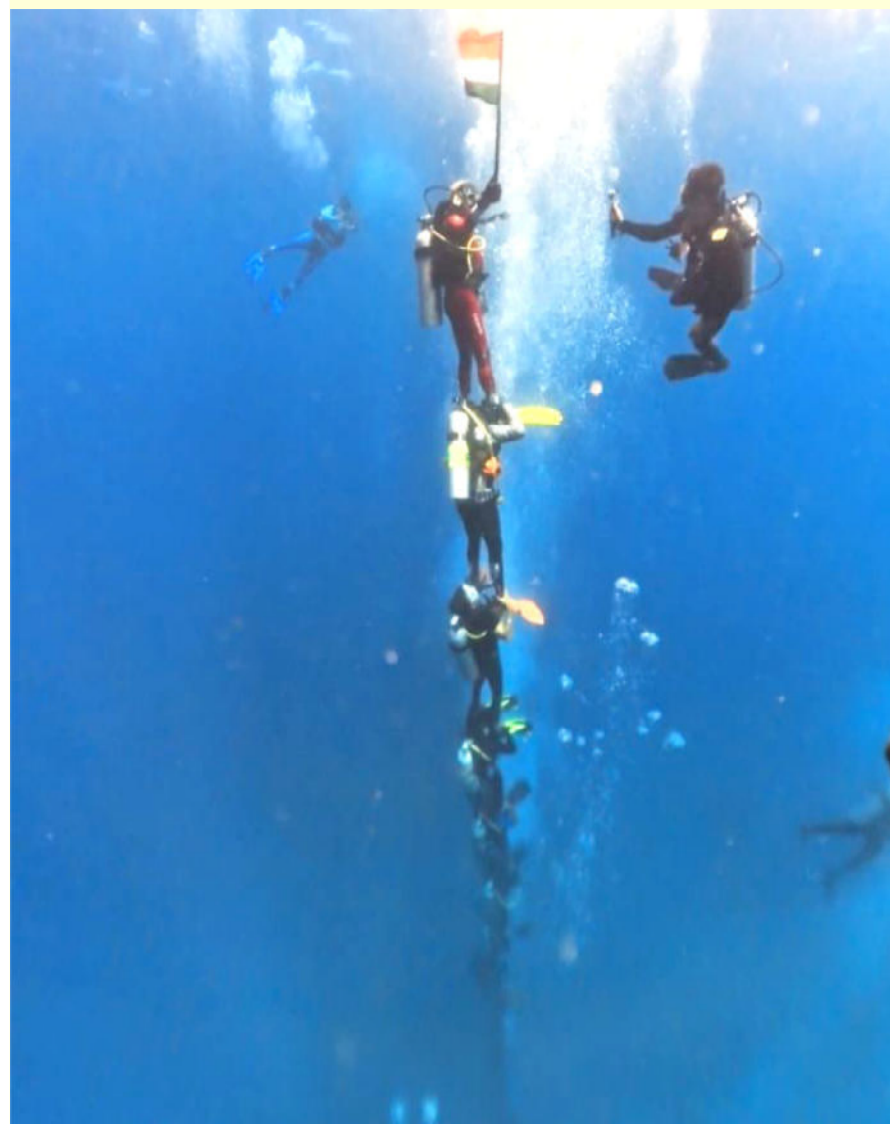

project would involve diversion of only 1.82 per cent of the total forest cover of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. While an estimated 18.65 lakh trees fall within the project area, the number expected to be felled is capped at around 7.11 lakh trees across 49.86 sq km, to be done in phases.

The clarification also pointed out that the project has received environmental clearance under the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006, with 42 specific compliance conditions covering pollution control, biodiversity conservation, waste management and disaster preparedness.

Great Nicobar is home to approximately 237 Shompen, a Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group and around 1,094 Nicobarese people. According to the government, no tribal habitations will be displaced and consultations have been held with multiple agencies, including the Ministry of Tribal Affairs and tribal welfare bodies.

While 73.07 sq km of tribal reserve land will be de-notified for project purposes, 76.98 sq km will be re-notified as tribal reserve, resulting in a net increase of 3.912 sq km, according to the government.

Given the island's vulnerability to earthquakes, cyclones and tsunamis, the project also includes a comprehensive disaster management and risk assessment framework. (Source: India Today)
