Intolerant non-state actors controlling large territories, unleashing barbaric violence: PM

New Delhi, Sept 3
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said intolerant non-state actors are now controlling large territories where they are unleashing barbaric violence on innocent people. Addressing 'Samvad', a global conference being attended by Buddhist spiritual leaders in New Delhi, Shri Modi said, he firmly believes that the solution to all problems lies in dialogue. The Prime Minister said, without embracing the path and ideals shown by Gautam Buddha, this century cannot

be an Asian century. He said, the life of Gautama Buddha illustrates the power of service compassion and, most importantly renunciation. Terming climate change as a global challenge, he said there is a need for collective human action to tackle it. Shri Modi said, the poor and downtrodden are the most adversely affected people due to climate change. He said, the present generation have the responsibility to act as a trustee of the rich natural wealth for the future generations. The Prime

Minister said, he believes that the discourse must shift focus from climate change to climate justice. Shri Modi said, his Government is doing everything possible to give an impetus to the Buddhist heritage across the country and India is taking the lead in boosting the Buddhist heritage across Asia. India to launch Indonesian satellite

Sriharikota, Sept 3
India will launch a second multi-spectral remote sensing Indonesian satellite that will help the country to monitor land-use, natural resource and in disaster mitigation. The satellite will be shipped to India tomorrow to be launched at the Satish Dhawan Space Center in Sriharikota. LAPAN A2/Orari will function as a tool to monitor land usage, ship movements, sea resources and fishing explorations. The satellite will orbit the Earth along the equator with an altitude of 650 kilometers, and travel at 7.5 kilometers per second - enabling it to circle the Earth 14 times a day.

SAARC countries' conference on disaster begins in Delhi

New Delhi, Sept 3
A conference of SAARC countries to chalk out and undertake joint efforts on various issues related to disaster mapping and mitigation in the member nations began here today. The conference, including the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and National Disaster Response Force, is being held keeping in mind the prevalent geo-climatic conditions as well as increased frequency of natural calamities in the SAARC region, especially in the wake of the recent earthquake in Nepal in April. "This calls for enhanced levels of preparedness and risk resilience as well as collaborative action amongst member countries to individually and jointly deal with such disaster situations and ensure minimal loss of lives and assets," an official statement said. Director Panchayat & Municipal Elections takes stock of printing of ballot papers

Port Blair, Sept. 3
According utmost priority to the security arrangements for the day of voting, the Director, Panchayat & Municipal Elections chalked out a detailed programme of deployment of Police Personnel with Nodal Officer of Police Department today. It has been decided that at least one armed guard and one lady constable at each polling station shall be deployed and two lady constables at polling buildings having more than five polling stations. The police teams deployed at polling buildings having two polling stations will be headed by Head Constable. The polling buildings having three, four and more than four polling stations will be headed by Assistant Sub-Inspectors and Sub-Inspectors respectively. In Municipal area, an additional unarmed guard shall be provided at each polling station apart from the above



arrangements. A Police team shall accompany each Sector Officer who will patrol in their respective areas on the day. For this, Sector Officers have already been conferred the power of Executive Magistrate. Striking reserve shall also be maintained with SPs, DIG & DGP and additional force shall be deployed in sensitive areas. The Director, Panchayat & Municipal Elections took stock of the ongoing work of Printing ballot papers at various places and directed all Nodal Officers to ensure safe & timely completion of the same. It has been decided to use JNRM College apart from Girls Sr. Sec School to ensure smooth and fast distribution of polling material and counting of votes. Govt extends time for non-loanee farmers to insure kharif crops till Sep 15

New Delhi, Sept 3
The Government has extended deadline for those farmers who have not taken loan to insure Kharif crops under the National Agricultural Insurance Scheme, NAIS, till 15th of September. According to the Agriculture Ministry, under NAIS the deadline to insure 2015 Kharif crop for loan availed farmers is till 30th of September, while for those who have not taken loan it was till 31st of July, now being extended to 15th September. In a statement, the Ministry said the extension will benefit farmers in states which had low rainfall or late rain and delayed planting. The cut-off date to insure this year's kharif crops has been extended following request from Bihar, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha and Gujarat governments. Agriculture Minister Shri Radha Mohan Singh said the decision has been taken in the interest of farmers in states where delayed and low rainfall has been reported.

- Attachment of Bank Account** of the establishment u/s 8F of the Act.
- Complaint u/s 406/409 IPC** in case of non-payment of employees' share of Provident Fund contribution deducted from the salary of the employees is **cognizable and non-bailable offence** which will lead to **imprisonment** for a term which may extend to 3 years/10 years and fine.
- Prosecution** of the Establishment and its responsible persons/Board of Trustees of Exempted Establishment u/s 14 of the EPF & MP Act, 1952 which will lead to imprisonment for a term not less than one year, which extend to 5 years with Fine of twenty five thousand rupees.
- Liability to pay Damages** u/s 14B of the Employees' Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 @ 37% per annum (maximum) and **interest** u/s 7Q of the said act @ 12% per annum which implies that late/delayed payment of Provident Fund & allied dues cost more.

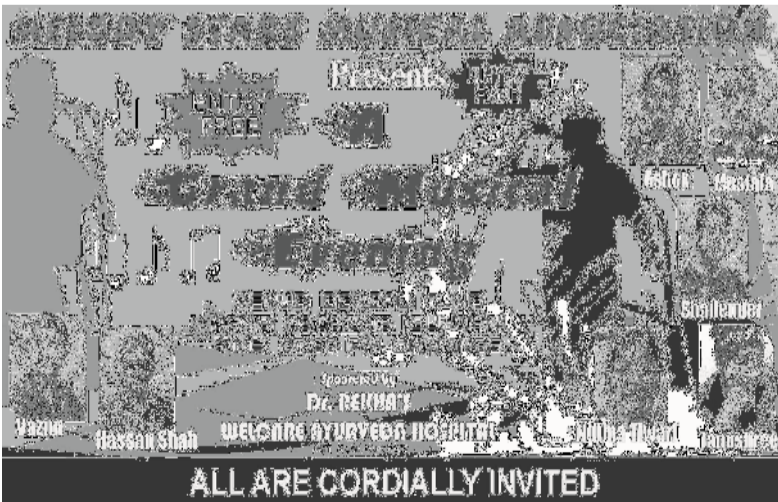

Whereas rule 68 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayats) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995, and rule 55 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Municipal) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995 empower the Presiding Officer to employ at the polling station such persons as he thinks fit to help in the identification of electors/ or to assist him otherwise in taking the poll.

Whereas the said rule 68 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Panchayats) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995, rule 55 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Municipal) (Preparation of Electoral Rolls and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 1995 also provide that where the polling station is situated in a ward electors of which have supplied with identity cards under the provisions of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, the elector shall produce his identity card before the Presiding Officer or the polling officer authorized by him in this behalf.

Whereas according to the information received from Andaman & Nicobar Administration about 95% of the voters have been issued Electoral Photo Identity Cards (EPICs) in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Now, therefore, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal factual position, the Election Commission for the superintendence, direction and control of the preparation of electoral rolls for, and the conduct of, elections to the Panchayats and Municipal Council in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby directs that the following alternative documents to Electoral Photo Identity Cards (EPICs) may be used for establishing the identity of those voters who have not been provided with EPICs :-

- (i) Indian Passport
- (ii) Motor Vehicle Driving License
- (iii) PAN Card issued by Income Tax Department
- (iv) Serving Identity Card issued to their employees by the Central Government, Public Sector Undertaking, Local bodies or Public Limited companies
- (v) Service Identity Card issued to its employees by the Andaman & Nicobar Administration
- (vi) Bank/Kisan/Post Office Pass Book having photo affixed on it
- (vii) Valid student Identity Card issued by Recognized educational Institutions
- (viii) SC/ST/OBC Certificates issued by the competent authority
- (ix) Pension documents, such as, ex-servicemen's Pension Book/Pension Payment Order, ex-servicemen's Widow/Dependent Certificates, Old Age Pension Order, Widow Pension Order
- (x) Freedom Fighter Identity Card
- (xi) Arms License
- (xii) Certificate of Physically Handicapped issued by the competent authority
- (xiii) Aadhar card
- (xiv) Islander Identity Card

The above alternative documents for Identification will also apply in respect of such all electors, who have been supplied with EPICs but are not able to produce them for reason beyond their control. Colombo, Sept 3
Former Sri Lankan captain Marvan Atapattu on Thursday resigned from the post of chief coach of the national cricket team following their recent 1-2 Test series defeat against India. Atapattu's resignation comes after the island nation lost back to back Test series against continental neighbours Pakistan and India in last three months.

It has been learnt that Atapattu's resignation has been accepted by the Sri Lanka Cricket's interim chief Sidath Wettimuny. Atapattu, one of Sri Lanka's batting mainstay during his playing days, had held the position of chief coach from September 2014 after Paul Farbrace took over as England's assistant coach.

Nadal advances to US Open 3rd round

New York, Sept 3
Spanish tennis icon Rafael Nadal advanced to the third round of the US Open on Wednesday after defeating Argentina's Diego Schwartzman 7-6(5), 6-3 and 7-5. Nadal will now face off Italy's Fabio Fognini, who beat Uruguayan Pablo Cuevas 6-3, 6-4 and 6-4 in the second round on Wednesday.

Meanwhile, Spanish veteran David Ferrer moved through to the third round with a hard-fought 7-5, 7-5, 7-6 (7-4) victory on Wednesday over Serbia's Filip Krajinovic, while home-crowd favourite Mardy Fish wrapped up his career with a narrow loss to Spain's Feliciano Lopez.

Argentina retains No.1 spot in FIFA rankings

Zurich, Sept 3
The Argentine soccer team maintained its No.1 rankings in the latest FIFA World rankings announced on Thursday. There was no change in the top four positions as Argentina was followed by Belgium, Germany and Colombia. England was placed 10 as its August ranking was 8.

India gain a place to 155th in FIFA rankings

New Delhi, Sep 3
The Indian football team has climbed up a place to occupy 155th spot in the latest FIFA rankings released today. Earlier in July, India had dropped 15 positions to 156th place after two successive defeats in the 2018 FIFA World Cup qualifiers. India were recently held to a goalless draw by Nepal in an international friendly match in

Pune. They will now take on Iran in a World Cup qualifier in Bengaluru on September 8. Meanwhile, Copa America runners-up Argentina continued to be at the top ahead of Belgium, in second position, and third-placed World Champions Germany. Colombia and five-time world champions Brazil are in the fourth and fifth spots, respectively.

Coimbatore, Sep 3
Top Indian players such as Ramkumar Ramanathan, V M Ranjeet, Vijay Sundar Prashanth and Vishnu Vardhan will be seen in action at the LMW ITF Futures tennis tournament beginning here from September 5. The five-day event has also attracted participants from China, Philippines, Russia, Kazakhstan and Spain. The qualifying rounds will be played on September 5 and 6. With 24 players in the main draw, the doubles finals will be

played on September 11 and singles finals the next day. This is the third time Coimbatore will be hosting the event. The total prize money will be USD 10,000, with the singles winner getting USD 1,300, runner up USD 900. Doubles winners will be awarded 630 USD and runners up USD 330, Jayakumar Ramadas, president, Coimbatore District Tennis Association, said. The winners and runner up will be awarded 18 and 10 ATP Points respectively.

Boost ahead of Rio Olympics: Finally a job for ace shot putter Inderjeet Singh

New Delhi, Sept 3 In what could be a major boost to his preparations for next year's Rio Olympics, ace Indian shot-putter Inderjeet Singh has finally got a job. According to a report in TOI, the athlete has joined Indian Oil at its Northern Regional Office in the Capital in the officer cadre. Inderjeet, who won a bronze medal in the 2014 Incheon Asiad, had been appealing for financial support and is delighted to have found a job.

"It was a major worry for the last three years. Today I am very happy and thank Indian Oil for giving me the job. I am happy that my effort on the field has finally got noticed," Inderjeet told TOI on Wednesday. "The burden is off my shoulder. Now I can earn my living while concentrating fully on my game." Inderjeet also highlighted the plight of other athletes who were still struggling to find sponsors.

Serena Williams, Novak Djokovic, Rafael Nadal reach US Open third round

New York, Sept 3
World number one Serena Williams shook off a woeful start Wednesday to advance her quest for tennis history while Rafael Nadal joined her in the third round of the US Open. Williams, trying to complete the first calendar Grand Slam singles sweep since Steffi Graf in 1988,

defeated 110th-ranked Dutch qualifier Kiki Bertens 7-6 (7/5), 6-3 at Arthur Ashe Stadium despite 34 unforced errors and 10 double faults. "I just kept fighting for each point, not for a lot but just one at a time," Williams said. "I had been pretty relaxed. Today I was a little tight. I think it showed. Hopefully I can get back to where I was before."
