New Delhi, Dec 3
Chief Election Commissioner Shri Nasim Zaidi today said the time has come for a comprehensive review of Representation of People's Act. Giving inaugural address of National Interactive Conference on Electoral Laws in New Delhi, Shri Zaidi called for suggestions from legal fraternity present in the

Conference for their inputs on the Act. The Representation of People's Act provides for the actual conduct of elections in India, qualification of voters, preparation of electoral rolls, and allocation of seats in Parliament and state legislatures. The Chief Election Commissioner also said various steps have been taken recently to

strengthen legal system in Election Commission including Chief Electoral Offices. He said election is a fundamental condition for democratic legitimacy and therefore election related disputes are also inherent. He said these disputes should not be seen as a reflection of weakness in the system but as proof of

RBI extends deadline for deployment of Aadhar-enabled devices

Mumbai, Dec 3
RBI has extended the deadline for deployment of Aadhar-enabled devices that process card transactions using Aadhaar-based biometric authentication. In a notification issued from Mumbai yesterday, RBI said that the deadline is being extended to 30th

June 2017 as the rate of deployment of acceptance infrastructure has slowed down owing to the mismatch between demand and supply of such Aadhaar-enabled devices. However, RBI has added that banks may continue to make necessary arrangements, including changes as host-end,

network level and device readiness. In September this year, RBI had asked banks to ensure that all new card acceptance infrastructure deployed with effect from 1st January, 2017 is enabled to process payment transactions using Aadhaar-based biometric authentication.

payments, by involving the Common Service Centres. More use of Rupay Cards, BCs and micro ATMs will be motivated.

To cater to the needs of the employees working in the unorganized sector in the Islands, the Administration has asked the employers under unorganized sectors, such as factory owners, contractors, shops and other such establishments to persuade people working for them, to open bank accounts immediately. They have also been asked to pay wages to these employees through electronic / digital mode and not through cash.

The Administration also appeals to the youth of the Islands, students of schools & colleges to disseminate information about, and motivate the use of mobile / net banking/ app based banking such as SBI buddy, PAYTM, use of POS machines, CSCs, RuPay Cards, e-wallet etc. among the members of their families, other elderly persons and ladies in their neighbourhood. They have also been asked to also familiarize the targeted people about the security measures to be adopted during such digital / cashless transactions. The Principal Secretary informed that the Deputy Commissioners of all the three Districts of A&N Island have been asked to promote cashless/digital transactions by creating mass awareness in their respective areas. Meanwhile, the State Bank of India will be procuring 1200 new PoS (Point of Sale) machines, in addition to the already existing 534 such machines for the Islands. These machines will be installed throughout the Islands immediately. While it has already been observed that the queues in front of the ATMs have weakened, these PoS, once installed, will further act as micro ATMs and benefit the people of the Islands. The banks will also be organising training camps to educate the public about digital transactions, the Principal Secretary added.
