# Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurates Grand International Exposition "The Light and the Lotus: Relics of the Awakened One"

## After a wait of 125 years, India's heritage has returned and the nation's treasured legacy has come back home: Hon'ble PM

New Delhi, Jan. 4

The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, today inaugurated the Grand International Exposition "The Light and the Lotus: Relics of the Awakened One" at the Rai Pithora Cultural Complex, New Delhi. Organised by the Ministry of Culture, this landmark exposition brings together for the first time in over a century the most comprehensive assemblage of the sacred Piprahwa Relics, relic gems and reliquaries of Lord Buddha, including those recently repatriated to India.

Speaking on the occasion, the Hon'ble Prime Minister said: "After a wait of 125 years, India's heritage has returned and the nation's treasured legacy has come back home. From today, the people of India will be able to have darshan of



these sacred relics of Lord Buddha and receive His blessings."


Speaking on the occasion, Union Minister for Culture and Tourism, Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, said that the presence of the Prime Minister, who has the rare ability to translate the spirit of India into the actions of governance, is always a moment of inspiration and significance. He added that welcoming the Prime Minister on this historic occasion was a matter of immense pride for all.

The inauguration marks a historic moment in India's cultural and spiritual journey, commemorating the reunification of the Piprahwa relics after 127 years. The collection includes relics from the 1898 excavation at Kapilavastu, findings from the 1972-75 excavations, treasures preserved at the Indian

Museum, Kolkata, and the Peppé family collection, repatriated to India in July 2025 following the decisive intervention of the Government of India that halted their auction abroad.

During his visit, the Hon'ble Prime Minister undertook a walkthrough of the exhibition and offered khataak and rose petals at the sculpture of the Seated Buddha. He consecrated an ancient seal excavated from the Piprahwa site, planted a Bodhi tree sapling, signed the Visitors' Book, released the Exhibition Catalogue, and offered Chivar Daan to the venerable Buddhist monks present.

Curated under the theme "The Light and the Lotus: Relics of the Awakened One," the exposition showcases over 80 exceptional objects, dating from the 6<sup>th</sup> century BCE to the



present day. These include sculptures, manuscripts, thangkas, ritual objects, reliquaries and jewelled treasures. At its core is the monolithic stone coffer in which the sacred relics were originally discovered.

The Piprahwa relics, unearthed in 1898 by William Claxton Peppé at the ancient stupa site identified with Kapilavastu, are among the most significant archaeological discoveries related to the life of the Buddha. Their reunification today stands as a powerful testament to India's unwavering commitment to reclaiming, preserving and honouring its cultural patrimony.

Under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, India's global engagement has increasingly drawn upon its civilisational and spiritual heritage. To date, 642 antiquities have been repatriated to India, with

the return of the Piprahwa relics representing a landmark achievement in cultural diplomacy and heritage preservation.

The inauguration was attended by Union Ministers, members of the diplomatic corps, ambassadors, venerable Buddhist monks, senior government officials, scholars, heritage experts, members of the art fraternity, students, and followers of Buddhism from India and abroad.

The exposition reaffirms the Ministry of Culture's commitment to heritage preservation and cultural leadership, while celebrating India's unique position as the birthplace of the Buddha Dharma and its enduring dedication to sharing its civilisational legacy with the world.

## Insurance coverage to farmers against crop losses due to natural calamities and unforeseen events under PMFBY

### PMFBY notified for Rabi 2025-26 season

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 4 The Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY), a flagship scheme of the Government of India, is being implemented in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands since 2016 to provide insurance coverage to farmers against crop losses due to natural calamities and unforeseen events.

PMFBY has been notified for

implementation across the Andaman & Nicobar Islands for the Rabi 2025-26 season. Pulses and Vegetable crops have been notified for insurance coverage. One cluster comprising South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman, and Nicobar (Campbell Bay area only) has been formed for implementation, with an indemnity level of 80% for all notified

crops. For the Rabi 2025-26 season, the scale of finance under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) has been fixed at Rs.59,433 per hectare for Pulses, including Green Gram and Black Gram. For Vegetable crops, the scale of finance has been notified as Rs. 1,88,468 per hectare for Tomato, Rs.1,66,404 per hectare for Bhindi, Rs.1,24,419

per hectare for Lobia, Rs.1,72,742 per hectare for Brinjal, Rs.2,46,047 per hectare for Cauliflower, and Rs.1,47,825 per hectare for Watermelon. The sum insured for each crop shall be calculated by multiplying the applicable scale of finance with the area insured under the scheme.

In a major relief to farmers, 100% premium subsidy will be

provided during Rabi 2025-26, making PMFBY completely free for both loanee and non-loanee farmers. The scheme covers losses from prevented sowing, sowing to harvest risks, post-harvest losses, localized calamities, and mid-season adversity.

All farmers, including sharecroppers and tenant farmers, growing notified crops in notified

## Govt. of India notifies 'A&N Islands Shops and Establishments (Amendment) Regulations, 2025' to boost 'Ease of Doing Business' in A&N Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 4

In a major step towards fostering a business-friendly ecosystem and enhancing opportunities and protections for the workforce, the Government of India has notified The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Shops and Establishments (Amendment) Regulations, 2025. Aligned with the Government's 'Ease of Doing Business' initiative, these amendments aim to simplify compliance requirements, promote

transparency, and ensure the welfare of employees across the Union Territory. The amended regulations have come into effect from 21.11.2025.

Key Highlights of the Amendments

**Simplified Registration Requirement:**

Registration is now mandatory only for Shops and Establishments employing 20 or more persons, significantly reducing compliance obligations for micro and small enterprises.

**Removal of Renewal**

**Process:**

Renewal of registration certificates has been eliminated. Once issued, the certificate will remain valid for the entire duration of the establishment's operation, except in cases where there is any structural or operational change that necessitates an update.

**Enabling Women's Participation in Night Shifts:**

Women employees are now permitted to work between 7 PM and

## Mandatory Registration of Factories/ Establishments and Coverage of Eligible Employees under EPFO & ESIC

### All eligible uncovered employers & employees appealed to avail benefits under EES-2025 and SPREE

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 4 As per the provisions of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 and the Employees' Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952,

employers are mandatorily required to register their factories/ establishments and cover all eligible employees drawing wages within the prescribed threshold

limits under the EPFO and ESIC.

However, it has been observed that some employers and employees may have remained outside the coverage of the EPF and

ESI Schemes. With a view to encouraging voluntary compliance and extending social security benefits to such uncovered establishments and

Rah-Veer: Save a Life Without Fear -  
Good Samaritan Protections Ensure You  
Don't Need to Worry About Anything

New Delhi, Jan. 4 (PIB)

During a road accident, every second matters, especially in the critical 'Golden Hour,' when timely help can save a life. To support and protect those who step forward in such moments, the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways notified the Good Samaritan Rules in 2020 under Section 134A of the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act, 2019. These rules are built on a simple belief -- no one who helps an accident victim should ever be afraid to do so. The people who act with courage by lifting an injured stranger and rushing them to the nearest hospital, often without even knowing their name are called Rah-Veers.

A Good Samaritan (Rah-veer) who helps an accident victim cannot be forced into legal hassles, compelled to reveal personal details, or detained unnecessarily. Their willingness to help is respected and their dignity and privacy safeguarded.

Saving Lives in the Golden Hour

The law defines the Golden Hour as the first hour after a serious injury, which is the most critical time for medical intervention. Quick help during this period can prevent lifelong disabilities, trauma and countless deaths.

Most importantly, to be a Rah-Veer you don't need medical training. You don't need special equipment. Sometimes, your willingness to act is the greatest help of all.

Being a Good Samaritan: What You Should Know - Do's & Don'ts

**Do's: Your Rights and Responsibilities**

◆ Do help without fear: You are legally protected from civil or criminal liability when acting in good faith.



◆ Do know you can stay anonymous: You are not required to share personal details unless you choose to be a witness.

◆ Do allow only one police statement: If you volunteer as a witness, you may be examined once at a time and place convenient to you.

◆ Do request a hospital acknowledgement: You are entitled to a simple confirmation that you brought the victim for treatment.

Don'ts: Myths You Shouldn't Believe

◆ Don't hesitate because of legal concerns: The system is designed to protect Rah-Veers.

◆ Don't feel obligated to remain at the hospital: Once the patient is admitted, you are free to leave.

◆ Don't pay for treatment: Hospitals cannot demand payment from you for emergency care.

◆ Don't feel forced to file an FIR or give evidence: Becoming a witness is your personal choice.

◆ Don't reveal personal details if you prefer anonymity: It is your right.

◆ Don't allow detention by authorities: It is not permitted.

**We need more Rah-Veers**

Even with better roads and expanding infrastructure, India continues to witness a worrying rise in road crash injuries and fatalities. Moreover, India is one of the countries with the

highest number of road accidents in the world. In fact, Hon'ble Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways, Shri Nitin Gadkari, noted that the economic impact of these accidents is enormous, costing the nation nearly 3% of its GDP, as highlighted in a report by IIT Delhi.

Roads are meant to connect people and create opportunities, yet far too often, they become the sites of tragic, preventable loss. Many of these deaths occur not because help wasn't possible, but because help didn't arrive in time. Bystanders frequently hesitate to assist accident victims due to fear of police questioning, hospital procedures, or legal complications. This hesitation costs precious minutes during the "Golden Hour", when timely medical care can save lives.

Recognition and Financial Support for Rah-Veers

The 'Rah-Veer' (Good Samaritan) Scheme also offers financial recognition and celebrates these individuals as real-life heroes who chose compassion over hesitation.

Under the scheme, anyone who helps an accident victim receive medical attention within the Golden Hour is eligible for a 225,000 reward and a Certificate of Appreciation, with recognition available up to five times a year for repeat acts of bravery. More importantly, the scheme inspires confidence, reassurance, and a culture where helping others on the road becomes a shared responsibility and a source of pride for the nation.

Rah-Veer is more than a scheme or a policy. It is a movement of courage, empathy, and collective responsibility.

The next time you witness an accident, remember: You may be the only hope standing between tragedy and survival. And you don't need to be a doctor to save a life, you just need to be human.

Submission of Form 5A made  
mandatory for renewal of Transport  
Category Driving Licences

Sri Vijaya Puram, Jan. 4

The general public have been informed that as per instructions received from the National Informatics Centre and in accordance with Rule 18(1)(e) of the CMVR'1989, the submission of Form 5A has now been made mandatory for the renewal of Transport Category Driving Licences. This requirement also applies to the re-validation of expired transport licences and

Additional Endorsement of Driving Licences (AEDL).

Any renewal/revalidation/AEDL application submitted without Form 5A with effect from Nov. 20, 2025 will be treated as incomplete, and the processing of such applications will be kept on hold until the document is uploaded/ submitted. Applicants who have already submitted their applications and crossed the document

upload stage may have their applications reverted to enable them to upload Form 5A.

All transport drivers and other stakeholders have been requested to take note of this change and ensure that Form 5A is submitted alongwith their renewal application to avoid delays. For any clarification, applicants may contact the Transport Department or visit the nearest STS Units, a press release from Transport Department said.

areas are eligible. The cut-off date for enrollment is 15.01.2026. Farmers may enroll through banks or self-register on the National Crop Insurance Portal ([pmfby.gov.in](http://pmfby.gov.in)).

Crop loss must be intimated within 72 hours to the implementing agency Kshema General Insurance Limited, the concerned bank, or the Agriculture Department. For assistance, farmers may contact the Kisan Call Centre: 243434 / 18003451145, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

employees, the Ministry has introduced two special one-time schemes, namely:

1. Employees' Enrollment Scheme (EES)-2025 and
2. Scheme to Promote Registration of Employers/ Employees (SPREE).

These schemes provide an opportunity for employers to register their factories/ establishments and enroll uncovered employees without any retrospective coverage or penal action.

Under SPREE, employers and employees registered during the scheme period shall be deemed to be covered from the date declared by them, and no records for the prior period shall be sought. The SPREE scheme shall remain open for a period of six months, from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2025 to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2025.

The Employees' Enrollment Scheme (EES)-2025 enables employers to voluntarily enroll eligible employees who were left out of EPF coverage during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2017 to 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2025. The special enrollment window under this scheme shall be open from 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2025 to 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.

In view of the above, all eligible but uncovered employers and employees have been appealed to avail themselves of the benefits under EES-2025 and SPREE, as announced by the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, and ensure social security coverage for the workforce, a press release from Labour Department said.




