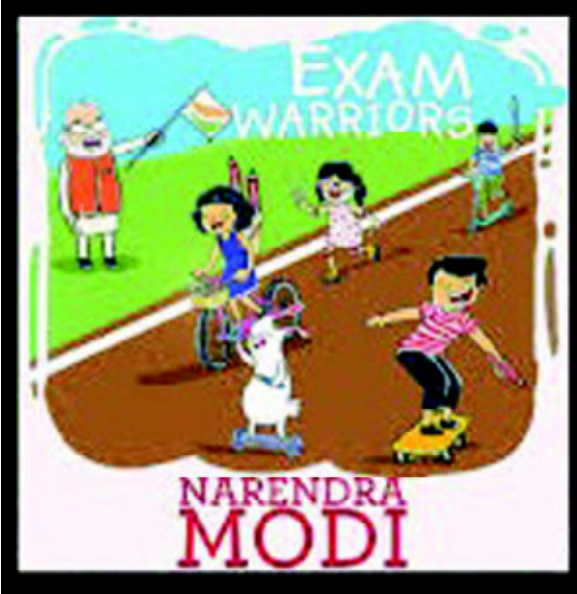

Finance Minister launches India's first sentiment index, CriSidEx

New Delhi, Feb. 4
Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley inaugurated India's first sentiment index, CriSidEx, for micro and small enterprises, developed jointly by SIDBI and CRISIL, in New Delhi yesterday.

CriSidEx is a composite index based on a diffusion index of eight parameters and measures MSE business sentiment on a negative to positive scale. The current parametric feedback was captured through a survey of one thousand one hundred MSEs in November and December last year.

Speaking on the occasion, Shri Jaitley said, this index will give the detail breakup of the sentiments and analysis as the sector sees it for the current quarter and for the next quarter.

Addressing a function in Guwahati yesterday, he said the government has set a target of making six crore villagers digitally literate.

Shri Prasad said the 'Common Service Centres (CSCs), performing various duties digitally in rural areas, have an important role in this regard. He said, currently 2,892 CSCs are functioning in Assam, imparting services in Aadhaar Card, PAN Card etc involving digital expertise. Out of these, 2,311 CSCs are working in gram panchayats. Across India, 10 lakh youths are working in such centres. These centres will also start selling fertilisers in coming days, he said.

PBMC urges consumers to install float valves in water-connections

Inspection drive to begin soon

Port Blair, Feb.4
Water is the most precious gift of the nature but its availability especially in these islands is limited. It has been observed that many of the water connections do not have float valve which results into overflow and wastage of water.

The section-41 of the PBMC Water Bye-Laws-2015 provide that every connection must have float valve at the end point of discharge mouth for control on over flow/waste of water, it is mandatory or else the connection will be disconnected. Further,

the section-35 of the Bye-Laws provides for fine of Rs. 50/- and in case of further continuing breach with further fine of Rs. 5/- for every subsequent day during which the breach continues.

India hammer South Africa by 9 wickets to take 2-0 lead

Prithvi Shaw, Manjot Kalra, Shubman Gill among five Indians in ICC's U-19 World Cup team



Centurion, Feb 4
Shikhar Dhawan and Virat Kohli guided India to a comprehensive nine-wicket victory over South Africa in the second One-Day International at SuperSport Park in Centurion on Sunday. India chased down the meagre 119-run target with 29.3 overs (177 balls) to spare as the visitors took 2-0 lead in the six-match series.

After Kohli won the toss and opted to bowl first, Indian wrist spinners Yuzvendra Chahal and Kuldeep Yadav again proved too hot to handle for South African batsmen, as the duo helped the visitors bundle out the hosts for 118 in 32.2 overs. It was the lowest total ever scored on this ground. Chasing the small target, Dhawan and Kohli added an unbeaten 93 runs for the second wicket after India lost opener Rohit Sharma (15) in

the fourth over. Dhawan hit nine fours in his 56-ball 51 knock, his 24th ODI fifty, while Kohli's 46 off 50 balls included a six and four boundaries. Fast bowler Kagiso Rabada (1/24) was the only bowler for the hosts to land a wicket. The one-sided contest witnessed a side drama too when the play was stopped for lunch with India needing just two runs to win and that too with nine wickets and 31 overs in

hand. India were 93/1 after 15 overs at the scheduled break. In terms of the playing conditions, the umpires extended play by four overs or 15 minutes. To the astonishment of players, spectators and commentators, the umpires then stuck to the letter of the regulations and ordered a 40-minute lunch break after the end of the extension as India reached 117/1 in 19 overs. Leg-spinner Chahal picked up his maiden five-wicket haul to finish with figures of five for 22 and left-arm Yadav took three for 20. South Africa was led by new captain Aiden Markram, playing his third ODI, as they were without their regular skipper Faf du Plessis and former captain AB de Villiers, after both were ruled out due to injury. Sentin to bat, Hashim Amla and the out-of-form Quinton de Kock put on 39 for the first wicket before Amla was caught behind for 23 off an inside edge from Bhuvneshwar Kumar.

Dubai, Feb 4

The Indians expectedly dominated the Under-19 World Cup team announced by the ICC on Sunday, with five players from the triumphant side making it to the world eleven.

India on Saturday lifted a record fourth U-19 World Cup trophy after an eight-wicket rout of Australia in the final at Mount Maunganui in New Zealand, underlining their dominant run in the tournament.

The world team has the top three of the Indian batting line-up - captain Prithvi Shaw (261 runs), player of the final Manjot Kalra (252 runs) and player of the tournament Shubman Gill (372 runs).

Left-arm spinner Anukul Roy (14 wickets) and fast bowler Kamlesh Nagarkoti (9 wickets) are the other Indians named in the world team.

The team of the ICC U-19 Cricket World Cup was picked by a five-person selection panel that comprised former Windies fast bowler Ian Bishop, former India women's captain Anjum Chopra, former New



Zealand captain Jeff Crowe, journalist Shashank Kishore and former Australia all-rounder Tom Moody. South Africa captain Raynard van Tonder was named to lead side which has representation from six countries. Van Tonder, who aggregated 348 runs in six matches including a highest score of 143 against Kenya, was selected to lead ahead of other captains for his better cricket acumen, the ICC said in a statement. South Africa went out of reckoning for the title with a three-wicket loss to Pakistan in the quarter-finals but finished

fifth beating Bangladesh by eight wickets in a play-off, which saw Tonder knocking an unbeaten 82. New Zealand batsman Finn Allen was rewarded for a consistent run which saw him get 338 runs while Pakistan's left-arm fast bowler Shaheen Afridi (12 wickets) and Afghanistan leg-spinner Qais Ahmad (14 wickets) are the ones in the playing eleven. West Indies batsman Alick Athanaze was named the 12th highest run-getter in the tournament with 418 runs,

which included centuries against Sri Lanka and Kenya. Shubhankar Sharma captures Malaysia title after stunning final round

Malaysia, Feb 4
Shubhankar Sharma roared back from a four-stroke deficit to claim a remarkable two-shot win at the Maybank Championship in Malaysia for his second European Tour title on Sunday. The 21-year-old shot 10 birdies in a sizzling closing round of 10-under-par 62 to aggregate 21-under for the tournament, finishing ahead of joint overnight leader Jorge Campillo who carded a 68. Spain's Campillo, who missed the opportunity to capture his maiden title on the European Tour in his 196th event, was a



shot ahead of New Zealand's Ryan Fox who was tied third alongside Pablo Larrazabal at the Saujana Golf and Country Club. "I played pretty solid and it wasn't easy because it was windy," Sharma, who jumped

to the top of the Race to Dubai Rankings, said after the win. The relentless Indian, who captured his maiden title at the Joburg Open in December, shot five birdies on the back nine to edge ahead of Campillo and hung on for the victory.

Her dreams realised, Mary Kom gives wings to others through academy

Imphal, Feb 4
Eager to ensure that aspiring boxers get what she did not have growing up, five-time world champion MC Mary Kom is continuing to expand her regional academy in Imphal. Nestled at the foot of Langol hills in Manipur's Imphal West district, Mary Kom's Boxing Academy, spread across 3.3 acres, is around 10 km from the center of state capital Imphal. It currently houses 45 young boxers, including 20 girls, at the three-storey building. "Mary wanted to give back to the sport which has made her famous and this was her dream come true," the iconic boxer's husband Onler Karong, who is the Managing Director of the academy, said on Sunday. A five-time world and Asian champion, Mary Kom is also



the country's only woman boxer with an Olympic medal (a bronze won in London 2012 Games). The 35-year-old was christened 'Magnificent Mary' by the International Boxing Association (AIBA) a few years ago for her stellar career, which also includes an Asian Games gold medal. The most recent chapter of her extraordinary life journey was becoming a Rajya Sabha MP

in 2016 and winning her fifth Asian Championships gold medal a year later. "We want more academies to come up in Manipur and other parts of the country. With modern equipment and facilities, I believe this is the first of its kind in India. This is the first full-fledged boxing academy with all the modern facilities for the training of boxers," he added.

Khelo India Games: Haryana rule in wrestling, clinch 24 medals

New Delhi, Feb 4
Wrestling powerhouse Haryana won the men's and women's freestyle championships in the inaugural Khelo India School Games at the Indira Gandhi Indoor Sports Complex on Sunday. However, in the medal rush, girls toppled boys by winning 14 medals, eight of them gold. The team also won two silver and four bronze. The boys' team, however, won only 10

medals, including three gold. They also won four silver and three bronze. With Haryana having a formidable line-up in the medal round, including cadet world championship medallists, rival teams were reduced to grappling for lower positions. Anshu, who won gold in the cadet world championship held in Greece last year, gave a flying start to her team by winning the 60kg gold. She defeated Leena

Anthony of Karnataka 12-0. In 65kg, Sonam, also a world cadet champion, outplayed Haryana teammate Mansi 2-0. In 70kg, Ravita Kumari beat Pathan Sanfer of Gujarat. Haryana also won gold in the 38kg, 48kg, 46kg, 49kg and 56kg categories. If girls were outright winners, the boys' team faced stiff challenge from Delhi. Haryana and Delhi were neck and neck in the race for gold, finishing with three victories each.
