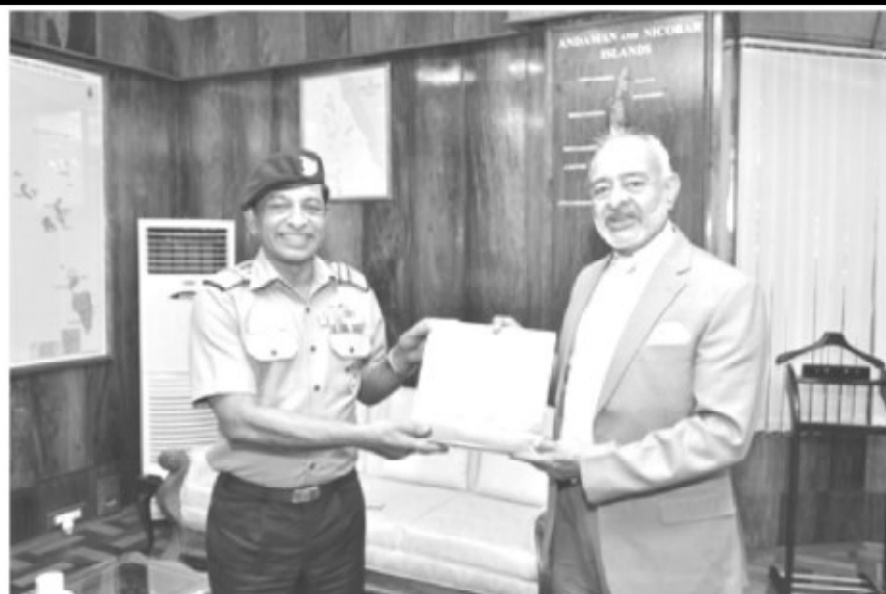

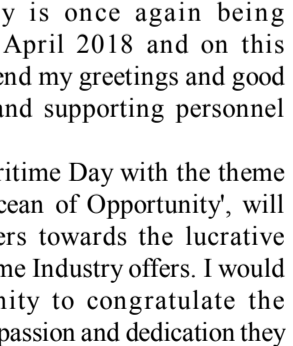

PV Sindhu leads India's contingent at CWG 2018 Parade of Nations

Gold Coast, Apr 4
India, led by its ace badminton player and flagbearer PV Sindhu, was the third nation among contingents from the Asian continent joining the Parade of Nations at the opening ceremony of the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, Australia. India finished with 64 medals, including 15 medals, to end up fifth on the medals tally at the last edition of the Games in Glasgow. The Sindhu-led badminton squad, along with the wrestling and shooting teams, will carry India's hopes of a gold rush in Gold Coast. Sindhu, the Rio Olympics silver medalist, carried the tri-colour at the head of the Indian contingent that also included her fellow badminton stars HS Pranoj and Kidambi Srikanth.



Star shooter Gagan Narang, woman discus thrower Seema Poonia and the men's and women's hockey squads were also present among the Indian contingent. A total of 71 nations will compete in 275 events across 19 disciplines at the Games which

will conclude on April 15. The Indians ditched tradition for comfort in the ceremony, marching out in blazers and trousers rather than the conventional sarees and bandhgalas. But the festivities inside could not completely overshadow the protests by

aboriginal groups, who raised slogans and blocked the Queen's Baton Relay for close to an hour at The Spit area of the city. They protested against the brutalities committed during Britain's occupation and insisted that the country should have nothing to do with the Commonwealth, given the land and a generation that was "stolen" by the colonial masters.

Virat Kohli, Cheteshwar Pujara remain steady in ICC Test rankings



Dubai, Apr 4
India skipper Virat Kohli and Test specialist Cheteshwar Pujara held on to their second and seventh position respectively in the latest ICC Test Player Rankings released on Wednesday. The 29-year-old Kohli had a total of 912 points, 17 points behind Australia's Steve Smith, who is comfortably placed at the top of the Test player ranking. Pujara, on the other hand, had 810 points. India Test spinner Ravichandran Ashwin slipped

one place in the bowlers ranking to take the fifth position with 803 points, while Ravindra Jadeja held on to his second spot in the all-rounders ranking. South Africa opener Aiden Markram, meanwhile, sustained his surge towards the top during an amazing first year in Test cricket, making his way to ninth position among the batsmen ranking, which also took into account performances in the drawn second Test between New Zealand and England in Christchurch.

South Africa's tour to Sri Lanka amended to include two Tests, five ODIs, 1 T20I

Johannesburg, Apr 4
Cricket South Africa (CSA) and Sri Lanka Cricket (SLC) on Wednesday issued a release that the originally planned three-Test tour of Sri Lanka in August 2018 has been reworked into a two-Test series which will be accompanied by a five-match ODI series and a one-off T20I. The revised tour will begin from July 12 with the first Test taking place in Galle. The second Test will begin from July 20 in Colombo. Speaking to reporters, CSA's acting CEO Thabang Moreo described the tour as an important one. "This will be a very important tour for us. We have a lot of exciting, young players coming into our side in all three formats and, with so



much of our international cricket being played on the subcontinent these days it is important they get used to those conditions as soon as possible," he said. As per the release, the ODI series will begin from July 29 in Dambulla with the T20I fixture to be played on August 14. Moreo said the limited-overs series is an important step to prepare for the upcoming ICC World Cup 2019. "The ODI series forms an important part of our team preparation for next



year's 2019 ICC World Cup in England. Sri Lanka have always provided very tough opposition under their home conditions and I am sure this tour will be no exception. We are all looking forward to some very competitive cricket," he said. South Africa are slated to reach Sri Lanka by July 4 and will play a two-day practice match at the P Sara Oval in Colombo from July 7. They will also play a one-day warm-up game on July 26.

GMAT exam time reduced by 30 minutes

New Delhi, Apr 4
The Graduate Management Admission Council (GMAC) today announced trimming of GMAT exam time by 30 minutes to 3.5 hours beginning April 16 worldwide. In a statement, GMAC said, the quality of the exam remains unchanged in terms of reliability, validity, security and integrity. The Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) scores before and after this change will be the same and comparable across time. The GMAT exam is required for admissions in business

schools and nine out of 10 new MBA enrollments globally are made using a GMAT score. The GMAC is a global non-profit association of 223 graduate business schools. Department has been obtained from the conceptual stage. Finally, after obtaining the views, suggestions, concurrence etc., from various stakeholders, the recommendation of STA in this regard was approved by the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands. This initiative will further strengthen the public transport system and provide an opportunity to tourists as well as locals to have an alternative mode of transport which will be less polluting and reduce traffic congestion. This initiative might become an important step towards traffic congestion and maintaining effective balance between tourism and environment. Under this daily pass scheme, any tourist or local commuter can purchase a daily bus pass at Rs.50/- per day per person which will enable the pass holder to travel in any STS bus (air conditioned as well as non air conditioned) plying in Havelock on the day for which the pass is issued for any number of trips to enjoy the scenic beauty of the Islands with minimum damage to the environment. Various options for purchase of the daily bus pass will be made available through the counters of Tourism Department as well as Sagarika counters, a communication said.
