Andaman and Nicobar Administration sets Guinness World Record by unfurling national flag underwater

Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands was also part of the diving team

New Delhi: The Andaman and Nicobar Islands on Saturday set a new Guinness World Record by unfurling the largest Indian flag, underwater.

The feat was achieved at Swaraj Dweep, which is a premier tourist destination in the union territory (UT) in the Bay of Bengal. The tricolour displayed underwater measured 60 metres in length and 40 metres in width.

According to the officials, around 200 divers, including expert swimmers from various government agencies such as the forest department, marine

police divers, and private individuals, participated in the successful attempt for the record, which was pulled off at around 10 am.

Admiral D K Joshi PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency was also part of the diving team.

The Union Territory administration attempted Guinness World Records to promote the islands as a premier global diving destination, said Director (Tourism), Shri

scuba diving and marine tourism, the other objectives of the initiatives are to highlight the region's unique

The event was aimed to showcase the region's unparalleled marine biodiversity, crystal-clear waters, and immense potential for adventure tourism, particularly scuba diving.

Former Air Chief Marshal RKS Bhaduria backs strategic value of Great Nicobar project

Former Air Chief Marshal RKS Bhaduria on April 30 dismissed Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's claims about the Great Nicobar project as "absolutely wrong", asserting that the "highly integrated" initiative is of immense strategic and economic importance to India.

Responding to the allegations, Bhaduria told PTI Videos that such concerns were "misplaced".

"This is a highly integrated project which is of immense importance to India,

both strategically and economically. It is essential to understand its strategic significance as well as its role in national and local development," he said.

According to Bhaduria, the project includes an international port with a container trans-shipment capacity of about 16.2 million units, a greenfield airport with a dedicated defence enclave for both civil and military use, a 450-megawatt power plant using a mix of gas and solar energy, and a planned township

capable of accommodating around 6.5 lakh residents.

He said the initiative would serve as a capacity-building initiative aimed at developing a smart city. "So, overall, if we look at this project, it is a highly integrated initiative that holds immense significance for India. It is crucial to understand this from a strategic perspective, specially in light of recent events, such as the ongoing conflict (in West Asia) and the developments in the Strait of Hormuz," he

said. "Strategically, it is crucial to understand that this will provide us with the capability to position ourselves just 150 kilometers away from the Strait of Malacca. Our overall domain awareness, both in the air and maritime spheres, will receive a significant boost," the former Air Chief Marshal said.

Furthermore, Bhaduria said, this will mark a pivotal development in India's capability to secure its trade routes and to dominate the maritime

environment whenever required "The Strait of Malacca is crucial because approximately 25-30 percent of the world's trade routes pass through it, and China's energy routes are about 75 percent dependent on it," he added.

Shri Bhaduria said the way this issue is being twisted, suggesting that tribal interests have been overlooked or that indiscriminate tree felling is taking place, is misleading. "All these notions and the

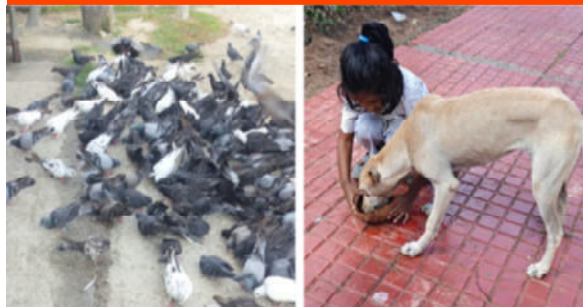

Illegal Hand-Sawn timber recovered in Kalighat joint operation

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 4
Acting on credible intelligence regarding the illegal transportation of hand-sawn timber in the 5 Plot area under Paschimsagar village, a police team from PS Kalighat, led by SI Shibendra Halder, SHO PS Kalighat, carried out a swift joint operation with staff of OP Kishorinagar and concerned Forest officials on April 29.



During the search of the area and nearby forest stretches, the team recovered 26 pieces of illegally hand-sawn timber of various sizes, including valuable Padauk and Thingam wood, with an estimated total volume

of approximately 0.382 CBM. The timber had been concealed in dense forest bushes. Despite extensive search efforts, no offenders could be apprehended. The recovered timber was seized and subsequently taken over by Forest officials for further legal action. Strict Compliance with Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 Urged in Andaman & Nicobar Islands

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 4
It is brought to the notice of all concerned that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (M o E F & C C), Government of India has notified the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 for ensuring safe and scientific management of hazardous and other wastes.

Under these Rules, it is the responsibility of every waste generator, handler, collector, receiver, processor, and transporter to ensure proper storage, reuse, recycling, recovery, pre-processing, utilisation (including co-processing), and disposal of hazardous waste.



All such entities are required to obtain authorization under the said Rules and, wherever applicable, obtain Consent to Establish (CTE) and Consent to Operate (CTO) under the relevant provisions of the Water and Air Acts. In this regard, all hazardous waste generating units, as well as units engaged in the aforesaid activities

within the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, are required to obtain necessary authorization from the Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) through the online OCMS portal (www.anocms.nic.in). Hazardous waste generators shall apply for consent in accordance with the industrial classification notified by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB). The revised categorisation of industries may be accessed at: <https://cpcb.nic.in/openpdf.php?id=TGF0ZXN0RmlzZS59fMTCzNZYxMzk2OV9tZWRRpYXB0b3RvMTEzODMucGRm>.

particularly for inter-State movement of waste, and shall be undertaken only after obtaining prior No Objection Certificate (NOC) from ANPCC.

Non-compliance with the above directions shall attract stringent action, including withdrawal or cancellation of consent/authorization, closure of operations, and imposition of environmental compensation and penalties under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and applicable Rules.

This notice is issued for the information and awareness of the general public, hazardous waste generators, and all other stakeholders in the Union Territory to ensure proper management of hazardous waste in accordance with the said Rules.

ANPCC urges all stakeholders to strictly adhere to the prescribed hazardous waste management practices, noting that improper handling can result in soil contamination, air pollution, and degradation of aquatic ecosystems. Collective compliance and community vigilance are essential for effective and sustainable hazardous waste management and for safeguarding the fragile and ecologically sensitive environment of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a press release from ANPCC said.
