There should be no glorification of terrorists as martyrs: Home Minister

New Delhi, Aug 4
Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh, in his address to the SAARC conference being held in Islamabad, hit out at Pakistan for glorifying terrorist Burhan Wani. He clearly said that there should be no eulogisation of a terrorist as a martyr. Shri Rajnath added that mere strong condemnation of terrorism is not enough and that strongest



possible action is needed against individuals, not only against institutions and nations. Shri Rajnath told the

conference that glorifying terror will not help in finding its solutions. He said that there can be no differentiation between good terror and bad terror. Home Minister also raised the issue of Pathankot and Dhaka terror attacks. Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh is attending the 7th meeting of SAARC Interior Ministers in Islamabad.

Govt aims to roll out GST from April 1 next year

New Delhi, Aug 4
The Government has set the target of 1st April next year for roll out of the Goods and Services Tax, GST. Addressing a press conference in New Delhi, Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley today unveiled the detailed road map for GST

implementation. He said that government is aiming for an optimal rate of taxation though the final decision will be taken by the GST Council. As regards the impact of GST roll out on inflation, he said the tax rates will come down over the years and hence the prices of many commodities

will also decline. The Finance Minister said, once GST is rolled out, doing business in India would be easier and it would help a large body of traders, business people and also the citizens. He said, State governments of all political parties were overwhelmingly in

support of the GST legislation. Asked if Tamil Nadu will come on board for GST implementation as The Bill, which was cleared by the Rajya Sabha last night, is likely to be approved by the Lok Sabha this week after incorporating changes made by the Upper House.

LG directs DSS to deploy ships in N & M Andaman with sufficient amount of diesel

Port Blair, Aug 04

The Lt Governor, Lt Gen A K Singh (Retd), has directed the Shipping department to immediately deploy ships to transport sufficient amount of diesel to ensure that uninterrupted generation of power supply is maintained in North & Middle Andaman. Accordingly, the Shipping department is dispatching two ships namely M. T. Angad and M. V. Badam carrying sufficient amount of diesel to Rangat and Diglipur in the evening today.

It may be recalled that due to landslide in Jirkatang area of the Andaman Trunk Road route recently, operation of normal IOC trucks in this route has got delayed. APWD has taken up the road repair work on an emergency basis.

Launching of IAF Dornier flight services by LG and CS

Port Blair, Aug 4

The Lt. Governor, A & N Islands, Lt. Gen. A.K. Singh (Retd) and the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar will flag-off the Dornier flight services by Indian Airforce between Port Blair-Car Nicobar & Campbell bay in a small function at the Inter-Island helicopter terminal, Port Blair at 8 am tomorrow (Aug 5). The Dornier 228 aircraft is a state-of-the-Art, twin engine turbo-prop aircraft, which can cruise at a speed of 200 kts. The aircraft is fitted with all modern avionics and being widely used for executive transport by the Indian Airforce. The A & N Administration is launching this service to augment the air-transport



capacity to Nicobar District. With the launching of this facility, the people of southern group of Islands will be largely benefitted. The services will be available twice a week on every Monday and Friday. As per the schedule, The IAF Dornier will depart from Port Blair at 0800 hrs and reach Car Nicobar at 0900 hrs. From Car Nicobar it will depart at 0945 hrs and will reach Campbell Bay at 1045 hrs. On its return flight the aircraft will depart

from Campbell Bay at 1130 hrs and reach Car Nicobar at 1230 hrs. Again from Car Nicobar it will depart at 1315 hrs and will reach Port Blair at 1415 hrs. The aircraft will carry 10 passengers and each passenger will be allowed to carry a maximum of 10 kgs registered baggage free of cost. Procedure for reservation of tickets will be as under:-

The objective of NDD is to de-worm all pre-school and school age children (enrolled, non-enrolled)

between ages of 1-19 years through the platform of Govt. School and Govt. aided schools and anganwadi centres to improve the overall health, nutritional status access to education and quality of life of children. The NDD is a day when all children between the ages of 1-19 years receive treatment for intestinal worms from teacher at Govt. schools, Govt. aided and private

schools and by anganwadi workers in anganwadi centres. In order to effective implementation of the NDD training programme will be organised for the key functionaries like teachers, ANMs, ASHAs to brief about implementation of NDD activities on Aug 10 and followed by Mop up Day(MUD) on Aug 17.

**Olympic Games to formally
kick off on August 6**

Brazil, Aug 4
Less than forty hours remain for the 31st Summer Olympic Games which are set to begin in the Brazilian city of Rio de Janeiro. Although the Group stage of Women's Football got underway last evening, the Games will formally kick off with an opening ceremony at 4:30 AM Indian Time on Saturday. Known as the world's biggest sporting event, the creation of Olympics was inspired from the ancient Olympic Games which were held in Olympia, Greece from 8th century BC to 4th century AD. The Games, then, were religious and athletic festivals held every four years at the



sanctuary of Zeus, an ancient Greek God. The evolution of the Olympic Movement during the 20th and 21st centuries resulted in several changes to the Games such as Winter Games for ice and winter sports, Paralympic Games for differently-abled, and Youth Games for teenage athletes. In the modern era, the first Games were held in 1896 at

Athens, two years after Pierre de Coubertin, a French educator and historian, founded the International Olympic Committee. The Games had 241 athletes from 14 nations in 43 events. Now, Rio will see the participation of nearly 11,000 athletes from 205 countries in 306 events. India will field its biggest contingent with almost 120 athletes.

**Olympic Games Rio 2016 boxing
preview: India's Shiva Thapa, Manoj
Kumar, Vikas Krishan aim for glory**

Mumbai, Aug 4
After a lapse of four years, sports lovers all over the world will be looking forward to the spectacular performances of the athletes at the 2016 Olympics. This year, the International Olympic Committee (IOC) has included some sports which are conventionally not included in the list of events women hockey and golf. In addition, the IOC has also allowed the participation of professional boxers in the Olympic boxing event to make it more attractive. Although India's performance at the Olympics has never

been of top quality, boxers have put up a good show in the recent past. Vijender Singh was the first Indian boxer to earn an Olympic medal at the 2008 Beijing Games, followed by MC Mary Kom at London in 2012. Both earned a bronze medal each. At Rio 2016, only three boxers will be representing India - namely Shiva Thapa in 56 kg, Manoj Kumar in 64 kg and Vikas Krishan in 75 kg categories. Comparatively, the number of Indian boxers were much higher at Beijing 2008 (five) and London 2012 (eight.) A higher number of participants

does enhance medal hopes, therefore the chances of reaching the podium will be slim for Indian boxers in Rio. The current state of affairs in the Indian boxing federation is directly responsible for this low representation. As of now, the federation is under suspension and there is no sign of revival.

There has been no National Championships for years, which would ultimately affect the country's boxers. If the situation continues, a longer suspension may jeopardise the boxing sport in the country.
