274 fugitive criminals brought back to India from 36 countries between 2019 & 2026: MHA

New Delhi, Aug. 4

India has brought back 274 fugitive criminals from 36 countries between 2019 and 2026. The Ministry of Home Affairs said that to strengthen action against fugitives, the Government enacted the Fugitive Economic Offenders Act in 2018. It added that India has developed an integrated, intelligence-led and technology-

driven model to combat fugitive criminals.

The Ministry said that before 2014, India had extradition treaties with only 37 countries and there was also no dedicated law to deal with economic fugitives or to confiscate their assets. It informed that between 2004 and 2013, India secured the extradition of only four fugitives per year on average, while 110

extradition requests remained pending.

Hon'ble Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah emphasised a three-pronged strategy against fugitives, such as global outreach, strong coordination, and smart diplomacy. Shri Shah described the issue of fugitive offenders as one that is intrinsically linked to the country's sovereignty, economic stability, law and order,

and national security.

Further, the Ministry noted that there has been a significant increase in the issuance of INTERPOL Red Corner Notices, in the last three years, and notices have also been issued against 401 fugitive criminals.

The Government launched B H A R A T P O L , connecting more than one thousand-four

hundred agencies with INTERPOL, reducing the time required for information sharing to 3 to 10 days. The Ministry highlighted that the Government used satellite technology and digital footprints to geo-locate fugitive criminals hiding abroad after changing their names and identities through Operation Trishul. Parliament passes Registration of Births & Deaths Bill to make delayed registration more stringent

New Delhi, Aug. 4

The Parliament has passed the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Bill, 2026, with Rajya Sabha approving it today. Lok Sabha has already passed the Bill. Minister of State for Home, Shri Nityanand Rai moved the bill, which aims to amend the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969.

The new bill has been brought to make provisions for delayed registration more stringent and to encourage timely reporting of events of birth and death. The Bill provides that if a birth or death is reported to the Registrar more



than one year but within two years after its occurrence, it may be registered only with the approval of the District Magistrate, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, or an Executive Magistrate authorised by the District Magistrate, following verification of the authenticity of the birth or death.

Replying to debate

over the Bill, Shri Rai said, the bill has been brought in view of the possible misuse of delayed registration. He said, if a birth or death is reported to the Registrar more than two years, it will be registered only on the order of a Judicial Magistrate of the First Class. The Minister said, the system remains

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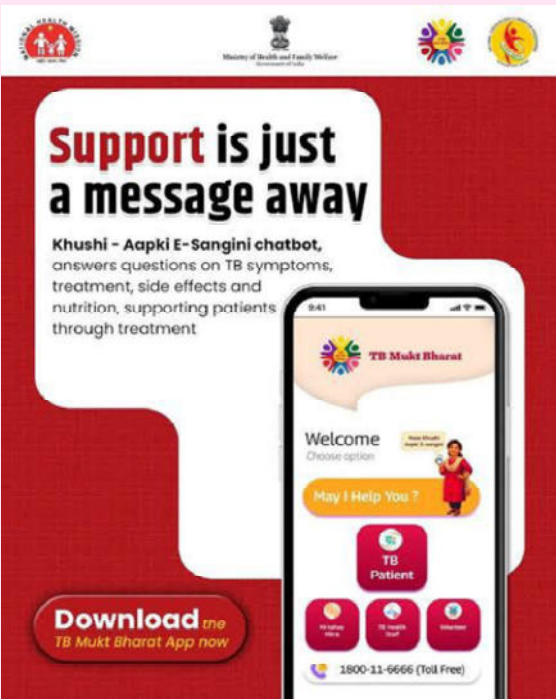
TB MukT Bharat App provides easy access to TB-related information & services; General public urged to download App

The Central TB Division, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, has launched the TB MukT Bharat App, a digital initiative under the National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP) aimed at strengthening Tuberculosis (TB) care, enhancing public awareness, and promoting community participation in TB elimination efforts.

The TB MukT Bharat App is a user-friendly digital platform designed to provide easy access to TB-related information and services. The application supports TB patients in their treatment journey by offering treatment guidance, adherence support, and follow-up assistance. It is also integrated with existing systems such as Nikshay to ensure seamless delivery of patient-centric services.

In addition to patient support, the app serves as a powerful tool



for disseminating accurate information on TB, including its symptoms, prevention, and treatment, thereby helping to reduce stigma and encourage early diagnosis.

A key feature of the application is the

facilitation of community engagement through the Nikshay Mitra initiative. Members of the general public, institutions, corporates, and organizations are encouraged to register as "Nikshay Mitras" through the app and extend support to TB patients by providing nutritional, social, or financial assistance during their treatment period.

The app also features "Khushi - Aap Ke e-Sangini", an interactive chatbot designed to provide instant, reliable, and user-friendly information on TB. The chatbot assists users by answering queries related to symptoms, diagnosis, treatment, and available Government support services. The general public have been urged to download and actively use the TB MukT Bharat App, not only to stay informed but also to contribute meaningfully by enrolling as Nikshay Mitras and supporting TB patients in need, a press release from State Health Society said.

scheme, financial assistance in the form of grant/ seed capital would be provided to individuals/ SHGs/ Co-operatives/ Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs). The ODOP identified for the South Andaman District is Marine based Fish products and for

The Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PM-VBRY) supports this vision by encouraging first-time employment and incentivising employers to create new formal jobs. Through an EPFO-linked, technology-driven framework, the scheme promotes workforce formalisation, expands social security coverage and strengthens financial security for workers. By combining employment generation, financial inclusion, transparent implementation, PM-VBRY is building a skilled, secure, future-ready workforce to support India's long-term economic growth.

The Promise of India's Demographic Dividend

India's young and dynamic workforce is one of its greatest strengths. It offers a unique opportunity to drive economic growth and deliver the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047. Millions of young people enter the labour market each year. Expanding formal employment with social security is essential to transform this demographic advantage into sustained and inclusive development.

The Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PM-VBRY) reinforces the national priority by encouraging first-time employment and supporting job creation. Through a transparent, Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO)-administrated framework, it strengthens workforce formalisation while creating opportunities for both employees and employers.

Turning Opportunity into Employment

Announced in August 2025, PM-VBRY is being implemented over a two-year period from 1 August 2025 to 31st July, 2027, with an outlay of Rs. 99,446 crore. ➤ They receive a one-time incentive equivalent to one month's EPF wage, capped at Rs. 15,000.
➤ The incentive is paid in two instalments. The first is paid after six months of service and the second after twelve months of



continuous service, following completion of a financial literacy programme.

➤ A portion of the incentive is invested in a designated savings instrument, encouraging financial security and savings. It can be withdrawn by the employee at a later date.

Part B: Support to Employers

➤ Employers are eligible for incentives for employees with salaries of up to Rs. 1,00,000 per month.

➤ Employers receive up to Rs. 3,000 per month for two years for every eligible additional employee retained for at least six months.

➤ The support lowers hiring costs and encourages sustained employment generation.

➤ For the manufacturing sector, incentives are extended to the third and fourth years as well, owing to high employment generation potential.

Within its first year, PM-VBRY has strengthened workforce formalisation by encouraging first-time hiring and expanding social security coverage. The scheme is helping bring more workers into the organised sector while encouraging employers to create new jobs across industries.

➤ The scheme is implemented through a fully digital, EPFO-linked platform, ensuring seamless verification and efficient benefit delivery.

➤ It uses Aadhaar-based authentication, Universal Account Numbers (UANs), and regular Electronic Challan-cum-Return (ECR) filings. Incentives are available only after the UAN is authenticated through Face Authentication Technology on the UMANG App. This ensures compliance while expanding social security coverage.

➤ Incentives are transferred directly to Aadhaar-linked bank accounts through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT), enhancing transparency and accountability.

➤ A PM-VBRY portal facilitates end-to-end scheme implementation and provides real-time monitoring of beneficiaries and sector-wise progress.

Awareness about the scheme and its provisions is promoted through extensive outreach efforts across the country. N&MA Police conducts anti-narcotics drive; one apprehended

N&MA District Police has seized approx. 64 grams of suspected ganja and apprehended one person under the provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985. Based on specific information that a suspect, a resident of Swarajgram, was proceeding to sell illicit ganja, a police team led by Sub-Inspector Mohd. Rafique, I/c PS Diglipur, immediately swung into action. The team intercepted and searched the suspect at Bahadur Tikrey Junction, recovering approximately 64 grams of suspected ganja from his possession. The contraband was seized, the accused was apprehended following due legal procedure, and a case was registered under the NDPS Act, 1985. Further investigation is underway to trace the source of the contraband and identify other persons involved in the illegal narcotics network.

The Police urge community members to support this ongoing mission. Report any illegal activities to the nearest police station or through the 100 and 112 helplines. The identities of all informants will be kept strictly confidential, and suitable rewards will be provided for actionable information, a press release from SP, N&MA said.

largely unchanged, except for the provision of delayed registration beyond two years.

Shri Rai said that the intent behind this amendment is clear as the Government wants to ensure that every child born in the country is duly registered. The Minister added that it also aims to prevent discrepancies such as cases where births are registered improperly or manipulated for vested interests. He said, similarly, every death must also be properly recorded in a timely manner, ensuring that there is no scope for misuse or irregularities in records.

The Minister noted that nearly 3.5 lakh registration units are functioning across the country. Shri Rai stated that birth registration in the country, which was around 86.6 per cent in 2014, has increased to over 99 per cent in 2024. Similarly, death registration, which was around 72.5 per cent, has now risen to 99.4 per cent. He said India is progressing with confidence towards achieving universal and accurate birth and death registration. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

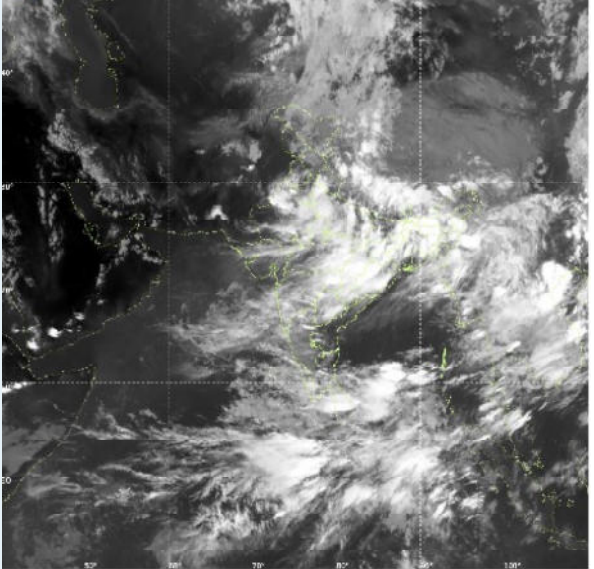
