Consequent to the recommendation for setting up of Small Modular Reactors (SMRs) in A&N Islands, to cater for rapid upscaling of power requirements related to mega projects viz. International Container Transshipment Terminal, Green Field Airport, Deep Water Multipurpose ports, Power Plants, etc. a team of Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) Scientists under Department of Atomic Energy India during their visit to the Islands from 4th to 8th September, 2026 for suitable site inspection in all the three districts of A&N Islands called on Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency today at Lok Niwas. Andaman & Nicobar Islands: Strategic Blueprint Calls for Stronger Defence & Economic Resilience

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 4
The Andaman and Nicobar Islands are emerging as an increasingly important component of India's maritime strategy in the Indo-Pacific, with their geographical position offering significant advantages for surveillance, logistics, defence and regional connectivity.

A strategic blueprint examining the future of the islands argues that India needs to pursue a carefully calibrated

approach that combines national security requirements with economic development and environmental responsibility. The document places particular emphasis on the Rs 81,000-crore Great Nicobar Island Development Project, describing the broader transformation of the island chain as a potential shift in India's regional posture.

A Strategic Maritime Location

The southern

Andaman and Nicobar chain occupies a strategically significant position near the major maritime routes connecting the Indian Ocean with Southeast Asia. According to the blueprint, the location of Great Nicobar near the Six-Degree Channel and the approaches to the Strait of Malacca could provide India with an important platform for maritime surveillance and defence operations.

The document also

highlights the proposed 3,500-metre runway at Great Nicobar, which it envisages as supporting strategic airlift and maritime surveillance capabilities. Such infrastructure, the blueprint argues, could provide a persistent operational presence that mainland facilities cannot replicate in the same geographic position.

Another major element is the proposed International Container

Transshipment Terminal at Galathea Bay. The blueprint notes the area's deep-water characteristics and sees the facility as having the potential to strengthen India's maritime logistics and forward-basing capabilities.

Security Concerns in the Indo-Pacific

The strategic assessment identifies the expanding military and infrastructure footprint of major regional powers as an

Veterinary Infertility Camp conducted at Hashmatabad & Mamyo Villages

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 4
The Department of AH&VS conducted a Veterinary Infertility Camp on 31st August, 2026 at Hashmatabad and Mamyo villages under Wandoor Panchayat in collaboration with ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (ICAR-CIARI).
A total of 14 breedable animals were examined during the camp, of which six animals were identified with reproductive problems and provided treatment. The cases comprised three repeat breeders, one case of cervicitis and two cases of postpartum anoestrus. The animal affected with cervicitis was advised an appropriate course



of antibiotic therapy along with supportive anti-inflammatory and analgesic treatment. Albendazole for deworming and mineral mixture were also provided to the farmers. The livestock owners were advised on scientific feeding, reproductive management and the importance of timely treatment of infertile animals for better conception rates and productivity. The camp formed part of the Department's ongoing efforts to address infertility issues in bovines and support dairy farmers through timely diagnosis and treatment, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

important consideration for India's island policy.
It argues that developments across the wider Indo-Pacific, including infrastructure activity around the Indian Ocean, make it necessary for India to ensure that its strategically located island territories remain adequately connected, defended and developed.
The blueprint therefore advocates stronger defensive infrastructure, including hardened aviation facilities, naval support infrastructure and other security installations.
Development With Economic Returns
The document argues that a purely military approach would not be sufficient to create a resilient island ecosystem.
It proposes carefully managed economic activity, particularly low-impact tourism, small-scale industries, ship-repair services and container-transshipment-related businesses. Such activities could potentially create employment opportunities and strengthen the economic foundations of communities living in the region.
Building for Seismic Resilience
The islands' geological vulnerability is another important consideration identified by the blueprint.
Because the Andaman and Nicobar region is situated in a seismically active zone, the document recommends that major infrastructure around Galathea Bay incorporate flexible and deep-foundation engineering capable of dealing with severe seismic shocks and possible tsunami impacts.
The blueprint also proposes the use of distributed and mobile defence capabilities, arguing that a combination of surveillance systems and mobile assets could enhance the defensive envelope without immediately depending upon extensive land transformation.
A Three-Way Balance
The strategic assessment ultimately presents the development of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands as a balancing exercise involving national security, economic sustainability and ecological protection.
Its central proposition is that India's island strategy should strengthen maritime security while simultaneously creating a viable local economy and embedding environmental safeguards into the development process.
For India, the challenge is therefore not simply whether the islands should be developed, but how that development can create long-term strategic resilience without undermining the ecological systems that make the archipelago unique.
The Andaman and Nicobar Islands could consequently become more than a forward defence position. With careful planning, they have the potential to evolve into an integrated maritime-security, logistics and economic hub-provided that infrastructure expansion, local interests, disaster resilience and environmental stewardship advance together. 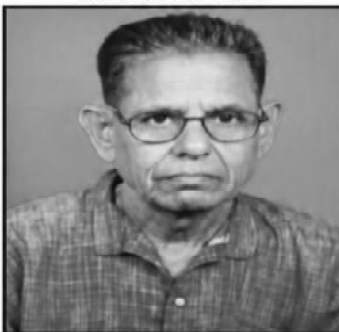

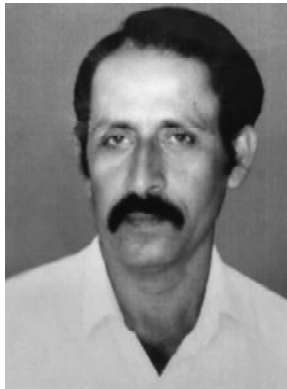
