## RBI to soon issue new notes of Rs 20 & 50; old notes will remain valid

Mumbai, Dec 4  
 The Reserve Bank of India, RBI will soon issue new notes of Twenty and Fifty rupees denomination in the Mahatma Gandhi Series-2005 and all old notes issued by the Bank will continue to be legal tender. In a statement, the RBI has said that the 50 rupees bank notes will be without inset letter in both the number panels and bear signature of RBI Governor



Dr. Urjit R Patel. While, the 20 rupees note will be with inset letter 'L' in both the number panels and bear signature of Dr Patel. The year 2016 will be printed on the reverse of both the notes.

## Taxmen find Rs 1.64 cr undisclosed income in Jan Dhan accounts: CBDT

New Delhi, Dec 4  
 Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has urged Jan Dhan account holders not to consent to any kind of misuse of their accounts. An official statement said, tax investigations into the sudden surge in cash deposits in Jan Dhan

accounts have revealed various inconsistencies. Undisclosed money of approximately 1.64 crore rupees deposited by persons who have never filed returns of income being below the taxable limits, into their Jan Dhan accounts have already been detected at Kolkata, Midnapore, Ara, Kochi and Varanasi. 40 lakh rupees have been seized from one such account in Bihar. Undisclosed income so detected will be brought to tax as per the provisions of the Income Tax Act, apart from other actions depending upon the outcome of investigations.

## Over 25 cr accounts opened nation-wide under PMJDY: FM

New Delhi, Dec 4  
 As per the latest information, 25 crore 67 lakh accounts have been opened nation-wide under the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana or PMJDY. It facilitates the beneficiaries a universal access to financial services. Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley stated in the Lok Sabha recently that the beneficiaries under the scheme get a RuPay Debit Card having an inbuilt accident insurance cover of one lakh rupees. He said the account holders under



PMJDY are eligible for an overdraft facility of upto five thousand rupees after six months of satisfactory performance of credit history. Altogether 20 lakh and 75 thousand account holders had availed overdraft facility until October this year. The total disbursement was nearly 316 crore rupees. Shri Jaitley denied any proposal to increase the overdraft limit under the scheme.

## RuPay card usage jumps 118.6% in 1st week of demonetisation

New Delhi, Dec 4  
 RuPay card usage jumped by over 118.6 per cent in the week following demonetisation that took effect from November 8 mid-night while the overall

debit and credit card transactions recorded an increase of 70.5 per cent. According to RBI data, the usage of RuPay card at POS terminals soared by as much as 200.6 per cent to 46.6 lakh transactions during November 9-15. This compares with 15.5 lakh swipes during November 1-8. RBI said a total of 65.6 lakh transactions were recorded through RuPay cards during November 9-15. This includes 19 lakh spendings through e-commerce platforms. Taking all RuPay, Mastercard and Visa together, the total transactions were up at 3,39,60,329 during November 9-15, from 1,99,19,176 on November 1-8, an increase of 70.49 per cent.

## Electronic mode of transaction in Public Distribution System

Port Blair, Dec. 4  
 The Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs is planning to switch over from the cash mode transaction to electronic mode of transaction in Public Distribution System. Initially, e-payment services will be adopted in the transaction being carried out between FPS owner and the Department while issuing monthly quota of foodgrains to the

Fair Price Shops. The FPS owners will have the option to remit the payment through debit/credit card at all the Supply Units of this Department. Besides, they will also have the option to make payment through net banking/mobile banking. Similarly, in the second phase, the Department is targeting to introduce e-payment services at all the Fair Price Shops for the convenience of the PDS beneficiaries. All FPS dealers have been requested to open a Saving/Current Bank Account in any Bank for obtaining a debit/credit card, if not already done. Similarly, they may also apply to the State Bank of India for procuring the swipe machines for enabling cashless transaction with the beneficiaries immediately, a communication from the Deputy Director(CS&CA) said.

## Yoga now on UNESCO's list of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity

New Delhi, Dec 4  
 The Inter-governmental Committee for the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage has inscribed Yoga in UNESCO's Representative List as the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. The declaration describing Yoga as a Human Treasure got unanimous support of the 24 members of the Committee. External Affairs Ministry Spokesperson told media that the inscription gives immense recognition to Yoga and emphasizes its role as a social practice, an oral tradition and a system of ancient and scientific knowledge facilitating an enhanced harmony and peace across caste, creed, gender, age and nationality. The inscription also enables a bottom-up empowerment, as it directs the spotlight towards the numerous institutions and communities in India disseminating this ancient tradition. It can potentially foment a dialogue on the ideas of peace and tolerance to meet the sustainable development.

## Petrol pumps to instal e-wallet facility

New Delhi, Dec 4  
 The retail outlets of Oil Marketing Companies across the country will train the general public on the use of various digital/cashless modes of payment. This was stated by Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Minister of State (with Independent Charge) for Petroleum and Natural Gas in New Delhi yesterday while launching the digital awareness campaign to educate the people about cashless transaction. He said, trainers from the Common Services Centers of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology will deploy trainers at these Retail Outlets to create awareness among the general public on cashless transaction. Shri Pradhan said that in the first phase, all Retail Outlets numbering more than 53 thousand in the country will be covered in the campaign, which will be further expanded to cover Gas distributors, LPG Stations and Bottling Plants. He said, Petrol Pumps have been asked to make arrangements not only for Cashless transaction but also for dispensing cash through Point of Sale machines. This initiative launched by the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas is being viewed as a step towards promoting the vision of the Prime Minister for a Cashless Economy.

## 'Chowra Mission' to mitigate water crisis Short term water supply arrangements at Chowra Island planned

Port Blair, Dec 4  
 The A&N Administration is making all efforts to tide over the water scarcity in Chowra Island. Shri Anindo Majumder, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, soon after assuming charge, had visited Chowra Island and called a meeting on his return to Port Blair. During the meeting, the Chief Secretary had urged to form an action plan for mitigation of water supply crisis in Chowra Island and it was named as 'Chowra Mission'. Accordingly, the APWD took appropriate action and informed the Central Ground Water Board (CGWB) and engaged the services of Shri. Amlanjyoti Kar, Superintendent, Hydro-geologist, of Central Ground Water Board (CGWB), Ministry of Water Resources, an expert in Island hydrology, & Member, Task Force (Water Supply), A&N Administration for 'Chowra Mission', besides other urgent water supply investigation in A&N Islands. During his tour to Port Blair in May, 2016, Shri Kar visited Chowra Island. Seeing the prevailing hydro-geological condition of Chowra

Island, three type of solutions were advocated by CGWB i.e carrying of spring water from Ponda Spring in Teresa Island through barges to Chowra as a short term measure, involving large scale rain water harvesting as medium term solution and introduction of desalination plant, if needed as long term solution. However, to tide over the extreme water scarcity faced by the people of Chowra in the ensuing summer, an urgent study of Ponda Spring in Teresa Island has been undertaken by Shri Amlanjyoti Kar, Superintendent Hydrogeologist of CGWB. The study revealed that the spring is located in Pillow Lava are of highly perennial in nature. The yield of the spring is 50 Litres per second (LPS) and from the experience of spring yield in similar geological formations in the Island, it may be opined that even in peak summer season, the discharge may come down to 30-35 LPS. It may form a very high and sustainable supply to water scarce Chowra. All the plans of execution of the scheme are prepared in liaison with APWD and the water can be directly transported to Chowra Island in the peak scarcity period. CGWB is (Contd. on last page)

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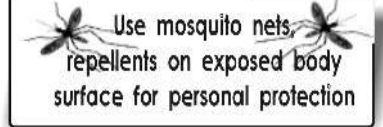

India beat Pakistan again to win back-to-back Women's Twenty20 Asia Cup titles



New Delhi, Dec 4  
Indian women's cricket team defeated arch-rivals Pakistan by 17 runs to defend their Twenty20 Asia Cup title at Bangkok on Sunday. In a repeat of the last edition's final, India posted 121/5 after batting first at the Asian Institute of Technology Ground. Veteran Mithali Raj scored a brilliant unbeaten 73 off 65 balls. Other than the 34-year-old, none of the Indian batswomen managed to contribute with the bat. Jhulan Goswami was the only other batswoman to reach

double figures, 17 off 15. But India defended the tricky target with as many as five bowlers taking wickets. Skipper Harmanpreet Kaur managed her resources pretty well to keep the pressure on their rivals. For Pakistan, skipper Bismah Maroof top scored with 25 off 26 balls. Raj returned as the top scorer with 220 runs from four innings, which included two not outs. She posted the two top scores, 73\* today and 62 against Sri Lanka on Thursday. Left arm spinner Ekta Bisht took

nine wickets to become tournament's top wicket-taker. Her compatriot Anuja Patil was second with nine scalps. India remained unbeaten in the tournament, beating Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Nepal and Pakistan in the league round. India had defeated Pakistan in the 2012 final too, by 18 runs at Guangong International Cricket Stadium, Guangzhou. India are the undisputed champions in Asia, having won all the six tournaments. The first four tournaments were competed in ODI format.

It added because of government's push to accelerate infrastructure spending and measures to create a better investment climate, growth will be strengthened by a recovery in private investment.
