Govt removes MEP of onion
New Delhi, Feb 5
The Government has removed the Minimum Export Price (MEP) of onion to boost exports of the kitchen staple. The Directorate General of Foreign Trade said in a notification in New Delhi yesterday that requirement of MEP on export of onions stands removed till further orders and all varieties of onions can now be exported without any MEP. MEP is imposed time and again to check rising prices.

UP Govt comes up with mass marriage policy
Lucknow, Feb 5
Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Shri Yogi Adityanath said that government has come up with a mass marriage policy for poor girls to discourage the practice of dowry. He said that under the scheme, financial assistance of Rs 35,000 will be given at each wedding.

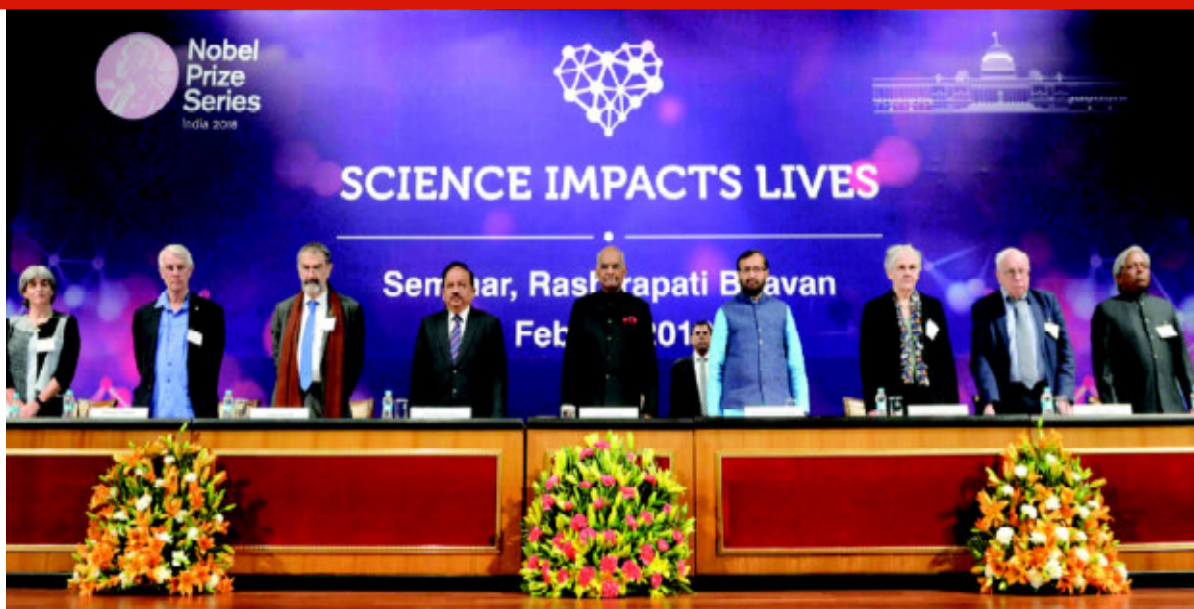
Taiwan hit by 6.4-magnitude quake

The epicenter was monitored at 24.2 degrees north latitude and 121.72 degrees east longitude, with a depth of 10 km, the center said in a renewed statement.

Record snowfall in Moscow

According to local meteorological authorities, accumulated snowfall reached 62 centimeters deep over the weekend - nearly equal to the total amount of snowfall for the entire month of February in previous years.

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao - towards a brighter tomorrow

Empowering women and girl children through awareness & advocacy

Staff Reporter, Port Blair, Feb 5
The Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme launched by the Prime Minister in January 2015 is being implemented in these Islands too in letter and spirit. Ever since the launch of BBBP campaign, the message has resonated far and wide across the country and people are now awakened about the need to protect girl children and give them the right to grow in a secured society without any discrimination, said the Director, Social Welfare Department, Smt. Geetika while speaking to the DT Reporter recently. The Director said that BBBP addresses the declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR) and related issues of women empowerment over a life-cycle continuum. It is

a tri-ministerial effort of Ministries of Women and Child Development, Health & Family Welfare and Human Resource Development. The key elements of the scheme include Enforcement of PC & PNDT Act, nation-wide awareness and advocacy campaign and multi-sectoral action in selected 100 districts (low on CSR) in the first phase. There is a strong emphasis on mindset change through training, sensitization, awareness raising and community mobilization on ground.

The Director further informed that as part of the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao campaign, along with several other states, Nicobar District has also been selected by the Govt. of India, adding that,



though gender disparity is not practiced among the Nicobari community, yet Nicobar has been selected for implementation of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme due to the fact that the Govt. of India wants to further improve the child sex ratio in Nicobar

District. As per the Child Sex Ratio (CSR) census of 2011, the national average was 919 while in the UT of A&N Islands it was 968 and for Nicobar it was 945. Comparatively, the CSR of Nicobar District was higher than the national average, yet the SRB data of 2016-

17 for Nicobar shows 818 girls for 1000 boys. The decline in SRB has to be studied so that suitable steps can be initiated to improve it. Meanwhile, efforts are on by the Department of Social Welfare to increase (Contd. on last page)

Another criteria for making it to the list was not belonging to the category of well-established names, next-generation entrepreneurs and having access to an influential lineage.

Fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah, who made his Test debut against South Africa this January, had a spectacular 2017 to get included in the list of Forbes India 30 Under 30. the SRB point in Nicobar District through awareness and advocacy and the District Action Plan has been prepared for Nicobar District. IOC says no Olympics for Russians who had life bans lifted

Pyeongchang, Feb 5

The International Olympic Committee (IOC) has said 15 Russian athletes and staff whose life bans for doping were lifted last week, will not be invited to the Pyeongchang Winter Olympics. In a statement, IOC said in Pyeongchang, South Korea that a special panel, Olympic Athlete from Russia Implementation Group, unanimously recommended not to extend an invitation to the 15 individuals.

They were among a group of 28 Russians who had been banned for life from the Olympics for doping, but whose suspensions were overturned at the Court of Arbitration for Sport on Thursday. The IOC has barred Russia from the Pyeongchang Olympics, which opens on Friday, over a widespread doping conspiracy. But 169 Russians who have passed strict anti-doping protocols will compete under a neutral flag.
