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Aadhaar data base fully safe and secure, says UIDAI

New Delhi, Mar 5
Dismissing reports of misuse of biometrics data, the government today said Aadhaar authentication is "fully safe and secure".
Moreover, subsidy transfers linked to Aadhaar has led the exchequer to save Rs 49,000 crore during the last two-and-half years. According to Unique Identification Authority of

India (UIDAI), there has been no incident of misuse of Aadhaar biometrics leading to identity theft and financial loss when more than 400 crore Aadhaar authenticated transactions took place during the last five years, it said.
UIDAI also said that it has carefully gone through various reports and would like to emphasise that there has been no breach to UIDAI database of

Aadhaar in any manner whatsoever and personal data of individuals held by UIDAI is fully safe and secure. "Aadhaar-based authentication is robust and secure as compared to any other contemporary systems. Aadhaar system has the capability to inquire into any instance of misuse of biometrics and identity theft and initiate action," it said.
With reference to an

incident of misuse of biometrics reported in a newspaper, UIDAI said that it is an isolated case of an employee working with a bank's Business Correspondent's company making an attempt to misuse his own biometrics which was detected by UIDAI internal security system and subsequently actions under the Aadhaar Act were initiated.

Burning of waste in open is banned & awareness should be created among masses; says Environment Scientist

Burning garbage, leaves, plastic and crop residues is a practice that goes unnoticed for its environmental hazards, even while world over, burning such things has been banned by most governments.
Rating the pollution level in the Islands as very good, Environment Scientist, Dr. Dipankar Saha, Additional Director and Head, Air Laboratory central pollution control board, Gol who is currently on visit to the Islands said that greater awareness needs to be created



awareness among the masses about burning materials and its impact on the environment. Dr. Dipankar stated this while speaking to 'The Daily Telegrams' here today. He said, the Supreme Court has imposed complete ban

on burning of waste in open including garbage, leaves, plastic and crop residues and this has to a large extent helped in controlling air pollution in many parts of the country, particularly in the country's capital Delhi.

Dr. Dipankar mentioned that "composting leaves is the most eco-friendly alternative to burning. He opined that no burning of waste should be done and a comprehensive management plan is on the anvil to deal with this problem. Solid Waste Management can play a catalytic role in saving the environment from getting polluted, he said. He also said that regular health check up of ragpickers needs to be done as they are vulnerable to various diseases and at the same time they should be sensitized.

Ration Card cannot be used as document of identity or proof of residence; says Civil Supplies Deptt.

The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has implemented the End-to-End Computerization of Public Distribution System in the South Andaman District (Excluding Little Andaman) w.e.f. 1st October, 2016 with a view to streamline the distribution of PDS commodities. clearly mentioned under Sub-section (6) of Section 4 of the PDS Control (Order), 2015 that the 'Ration Card shall not be used as a document of identity or proof of residence'.
In view of this, the general public and the offices of this Administration who are considering/asking for ration cards as documentary proof have been informed that the Smart Ration Card are meant only for the purpose of drawing ration articles and cannot be used as a document of identity or proof of residence, a communication said.

2nd Test: Renshaw, Marsh put Australia in lead on Day 2

Bangalore, Feb 5
Despite India putting up a spirited show in a bid to wrest momentum back in the second India v Australia Test at Chinnaswamy Stadium, Bangalore, Australia managed to stay ahead mainly riding on Matt Renshaw and Shaun Marsh's supreme effort in the middle, battling a difficult pitch and a disciplined Indian bowling attack on day two. The visitors finished the day on 237 for six, with a lead of 48 runs. To finish on 40 for no loss, when the opposition has been bundled out for 189 on Day 1 of a Test match on a track that was assisting the bowlers was an admirable effort from Australian openers Renshaw and David Warner and while Warner failed to get going on day two, Renshaw put the gauntlet down displaying great concentration skills to keep India at bay in the first session. In the second, India managed a slight comeback scalping three wickets, but owing to the lack of



luck and disastrous reviewed decisions, India were pegged back further in their bid to keep up with Australia. Earlier, after the fall of Warner, captain Steve Smith and Renshaw went about surviving for most part of the first session. Australia crawled to 87 for 2 at lunch after Smith bat-padded one off Jadeja to depart for eight off 52 balls. Mere 47 runs were added in the session. In the third session, Shaun Marsh continued to live a charmed life as Ishant again trapped him in front only to overstep and the Australian made full use of the reprieves to compile his sixth Test fifty.

More importantly, he combined with Wade for a crucial 57-run stand for the sixth wicket in the final session when it seemed India could take the advantage after reducing Australia to 163 for five at tea. During the pivotal partnership Australia took the lead, but soon after Marsh was caught at short midwicket off Umesh for 66. Wade (25*) continued on in company of Mitchell Starc and extended Australia's to lead to 48.

Fit-again Saina ready to take on the best at All England

New Delhi, Mar 5
Back to full fitness and hungry for a good fight, ace Indian shuttler Saina Nehwal says she is ready to take on the world's best at the prestigious All England Championship starting next week. After putting in the hard yards following a complete recovery from injury, Saina is aiming to regain her position in world badminton. "My target is to be one of the best badminton players in the world and facing strong opposition from best players is the real enjoyment of playing badminton," Saina told PTI in an interview. "I was runners-up in 2015 All England Championship but facing Carolina (Marin) was a very big task. She overpowered

me and won the title. I am fine and well-trained now so I am ready to face my opponents," she added. Left heart-broken after a knee problem scuttled her Rio Olympic plans, Saina showed tremendous mental fortitude to recover well and resume competitive badminton in November, despite going through a surgery in August. The 26-year-old participated in three tournaments -- China, Hong Kong and Macau -- last year before competing at the Premier Badminton League for Awadhe Warriors in January. The Hyderabad, who was still in the process of strengthening her knee, then notched up a stunning title win at the Malaysia

Masters Grand Prix Gold to begin the season on a positive note. Saina then decided to skip the Syed Modi Grand Prix Gold in Lucknow, saying she needed more time to be fully fit ahead of the Super Series events which start with the All England at Birmingham on March 7.

Andy Murray claims 45th career title with Dubai triumph over Fernando Verdasco

Dubai, Feb 5
Andy Murray clinched his first title of 2017 and 45th of his career as he dominated Spain's Fernando Verdasco 6-3, 6-2 to win the Dubai Tennis Championships on Saturday. World number one Murray claimed the trophy in the emirate for the first time after losing the final five years ago to Roger Federer.



The Scot finished the job in just 73 minutes on the first of three match points, an untouchable service winner. "It's obviously nice to finally win here," said the top seed. "It feels great to take the trophy for the first time. "I played a good match today. I had a bit of a slow start, but we've had a lot of late nights this week. But once I got going, I was moving well and finished strong." Murray improved his record over 35th-ranked left-hander Verdasco to 13 wins and just one loss. He was playing in his second final of 2017 after losing to Novak Djokovic in nearby Doha during the opening week of the

season in January. The first three games of the contest featured breaks of serve before Murray steadied, breaking for 5-3 and taking the opening set. In the second, Murray earned a 2-1 lead as he eased to victory. Murray now makes the long flight halfway around the world to Los Angeles to prepare for the start of the Indian Wells Masters. His win on Saturday allowed Murray to become the first British champion in the 25-year history of the Dubai tournament. He was playing in his seventh final in his last eight tournaments and 14th final in his last 16 events.

Shami aims to be fit for third Test

New Delhi, Feb 8
At a time when nothing seems to be going India's way - Mohammed Shami's return to action will certainly come as a welcome news for the side. The India pacer, who was nursing a knee injury, looks all set to make a comeback in Bengal's final Vijay Hazare Trophy match against Gujarat at Chepauk on Monday (March 6).

If the pacer feels 100 percent fit, he is likely to lead India's attack in the third Test in Ranchi. The 26-year-old said he is happy with his rehabilitation process and sounded confident of playing in the third Test. "I am eagerly looking at making a comeback to the Test side. I wanted to test my fitness level and so I am here. It also gives me a chance to play for my state side for the first time this season," Shami, who landed in Chennai on Saturday (March 4), told reporters.
