CBSE board exams begin

New Delhi, Mar 5
The CBSE board exams for class 10th and 12th have commenced. A total of 16.38 lakh candidates have registered for class 10th examination this year, while 11.86 lakh candidates have registered for class 12th. The class 10th exam will be conducted at over four thousand centres across India and 78 centres outside India. Similarly, for class 12th, the exam will be held at over four thousand centres in India and 71 centres abroad. From this year, CBSE is also allowing candidates with special needs to write their exams using laptops but their device will have to undergo an inspection at the exam centre and no Internet access will be allowed.

ISSF Shooting World Cup

Manu Bhaker's Gold and Ravi Kumar's Bronze take India at the top of the medals tally

Guadalajara, Mar 5
In the ISSF Shooting World Cup, India jumped to the top of the medals tally last night after teen sensation Manu Bhaker bagged a Gold medal, while Ravi Kumar took home the Bronze at the Mexican city of Guadalajara. In the Women's 10-metre Air Pistol event, Bhaker, an 11th standard student, defeated the host nation's Alejandra Zavala, a two-time World Cup Finals winner, with a score of 237.5 points to clinch the coveted yellow metal. Zavala ended at 237.1 to settle for a Silver, while Celine Goberville of France won the bronze with a score of 217. In the Men's 10-metre Air Rifle



event, Ravi Kumar won a Bronze, which was his first World Cup medal. He shot 226.4 and beat compatriot Deepak Kumar in a shoot-off for third and fourth

spots. Hungarian Istvan Peni, the world number one, won the Gold, while Austria's Alexander Schmiril claimed the Silver. At the end of the competitions on day

two, India's medal count stood at five - 2 Gold and 3 Bronze.

Shubhankar falters at final hurdle; finishes ninth at WGC

Mexico, Mar 5
Overnight leader Shubhankar Sharma could not pull off a dream win owing to a late slump but the Indian golfer certainly rose in stature with a creditable tied ninth finish at the \$10 million WGC - Mexico Championship. The 21-year-old Sharma was tied with two-time Masters champion, Bubba Watson (67) and Canadian Adam Hadwin (66). Phil Mickelson won on the first play-off hole against a rampant Justin Thomas (64), while Rafa Cabrera-Bello (67), shared third with Tyrrell Hatton (67), who bogeyed the last to miss getting into the play-off.

In Chess, Viswanathan Anand has lifted the Tal Memorial rapid trophy in Moscow. The win came after an easy final round draw against Boris Gelfand of Israel. Anand finished with six points out of a possible nine, scoring four wins and four draws. Anand's most crucial victory was against Russia's Alexander Grischuk in the penultimate round that sealed the title for him. The trophy adds to Anand's world rapid title won in Riyadh over two months ago.



Indian women hockey team beat South Korea 1-0 in Tour opener

New Delhi, Mar 5
Indian women's hockey team defeated South Korea by a solitary goal in the opening match of the five-game series to make a positive start to their tour. India scored an early goal through Lalremisiami (5th minute) at the Jinchun National Athletic Center and then defended stoutly to hold on to the lead for a morale-boosting win. India looked positive from the word go and were rewarded for their intent in the fifth minute when Lalremisiami found the back of the South Korean net past goalkeeper Mijin Han. The Indian team looked in good shape as they made forays into



the opposition half regularly and also defended well as a unit. In the second quarter, India were rewarded with a penalty corner in the 18th minute, but Mijin Han came to her side's rescue this time. Three minutes later the Korean goalkeeper made another fine save from a penalty corner to

keep the hosts in the hunt. In the 23rd minute India conceded a penalty corner but debutant goalkeeper Swati made a fine save to keep her team's lead intact. It was a crucial phase in the match as world no. 9 South Korea were constantly looking for an opening to equalise but the Indian defense stood tall to deny the hosts.

India's young turks ready for Tri-Nation test under Rohit Sharma

Colombo, Mar 5
The aim would be to stay on the selectors' radar for next year's World Cup when India's second-string team, led by Rohit Sharma, begins yet another Sri Lankan sojourn by taking on the islanders in the opening match of the Tri-Nation Nidahas Twenty20 Cup on Tuesday. Having faced Sri Lanka in 18 international matches this season (6 Tests, 8 ODIs and 4 T20 Internationals) on home and away basis, another face-off can only add to the players as well as viewers' fatigue due to lack of context. Bangladesh is the third team in this series and though the sprightly bunch is known to add excitement, the series itself is not exactly an anticipated event after a rather exhausting trip to South Africa. For all those who are likely to

get a game, there will be just one target -- to make most of their chances as some of them might not get too many with just about 16 months left for the ICC World Cup.
