## Chief Secretary visits Diglipur & holds meeting with PRI Members & HoDs

### Several issues of public importance deliberated, directions issued for prompt resolution

Diglipur, Mar. 5  
The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar visited Diglipur today and chaired a meeting with the members of Panchayati Raj Institution (PRI) and Heads of Offices from line Departments, attended by the Deputy Commissioner, N&M Andaman, Superintendent of Police, N&MA, Chief Engineer, APWD and Assistant Commissioner, Diglipur. Several issues of public importance were deliberated, with

clear instructions issued to achieve prompt resolution. The meeting placed strong emphasis on expediting land conversion for eligible cases, recognizing the long-standing delays that have hindered residential, commercial, and community development projects across the islands. Recent resumption of this process, facilitated through digital platforms like the Dweep Bhoomi portal, underscores the Administration's commitment to

streamlining approvals and empowering land owners. Deliberations also advanced the development of a Master Plan for the Diglipur area, with the Chief Secretary stressing continuous stakeholder participation to craft a scientific, practical, and implementable framework. This roadmap aims to guide sustainable growth over the next three decades, addressing local needs while fostering long-term progress. A key focus was

identifying Government buildings suitable for solar roofing to promote renewable energy adoption and reduce dependency on conventional sources. Special attention was devoted to water scarcity, exploring preservation and harvesting methods from diverse sources, including ring wells constructed by Panchayats. The Chief Secretary directed the Andaman Public Works Department (APWD) to comprehensively map these ring wells, assessing water availability and quality for strategic use during

## First phase of Houselisting and Housing Census (HLO) to start from April, 2026 in A&N Islands

The first phase of census namely, Houselisting and Housing Census (HLO), will start from April, 2026 in UT of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. In the Gazette notification issued on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2026, the period from 1-15 April, 2026 has been prescribed for self enumeration. Thereafter, Houselisting Operations shall be conducted from 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2026 to 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

During this period, the enumerators



appointed for HLO of census 2027 shall visit each house in the UT to collect information on thirty-three questions. For ensuring quality data, it is essential that the enumerators are properly trained for carrying out this gigantic exercise. The

Census Office is following training cascade, where National trainers train Master trainers of UT. The Master trainers would train Field trainers, and the Field trainers would ultimately impart training to the

enumerators and supervisors.

In the series of training, Master trainer's training has already completed in the UT. Now, the Field trainer's training has begun in A&N Islands. 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2026, was the first day of three days training of Field trainers at South Andaman. Similar training shall be imparted to Field trainers of North and Middle Andaman District and Nicobars District in the next week, a press release from Directorate of Census said.

## Success Story

### From challenges to prosperity: Waheed's inspiring dairy-poultry farming journey

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 5

Waheed, a resident of Azad Nagar in Gram Panchayat Wimberlygunj, South Andaman, stands as a shining example of determination and innovation in dairy and poultry farming. Rearing dairy animals since childhood, he has transformed his lifelong passion into a thriving, scientifically managed enterprise, overcoming significant hurdles with the support of the Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services (AH&VS), A&N Administration.

In the early days, Waheed faced numerous challenges, including inadequate



infrastructure, limited feed availability, parasitic diseases, and low milk yields that threatened the viability of his farm. Recognizing the need for scientific knowledge to turn the tide, he actively participated in several workshops and training programmes organised by the AH&VS Department. These sessions equipped him

with essential skills in animal nutrition and disease management, building his confidence and enabling him to scale his operations effectively.

Today, he maintains a robust herd of 7 crossbreed cattle (5 adult cows and 2 calves), producing an average of 15 litres of milk per day from 3 milch cows. This generates a monthly

revenue of approximately Rs. 40,000, with a net profit of Rs. 20,000. He prepares balanced cattle feed in-house by mixing raw chana, soya chunks, urad daal, til cake, wheat, and rice in optimal proportions, cooking it for better digestibility, and supplementing with pelleted feed to ensure superior nutrition. Additionally, he avails comprehensive veterinary services from the Department, including Artificial Insemination (AI), vaccinations, and routine care. Stem cuttings provided by the Department have helped him cultivate

That Subodh Kumar Gain was brought from East Pakistan (Presently Bangladesh) under the colonization Scheme by the Andaman and Nicobar Administration along with his Mother Paresh Chandra Gain with their Mother. That in terms of the colonization scheme as a head of the Family the Land bearing Survey No. 320,321,322,324,328 measuring an area of 1.1200 hectares, 0.6000 hectares, 0.0700 hectares, 0.3000 hectares, 0.5200 hectares respectively and house site bearing Survey No. 323 measuring an area of 0.0100 hectares all situated at Chouldari Village, Ferrargunj Tehsil, South Andaman District was allotted in the name of Subodh Chandra Gain. That Subodh Chandra Gian during his lifetime has engaged Sukh Chand Baidya as his caretaker. That in the year 1966, Subodh Chandra Gain went to Calcutta and while he was in Calcutta on 29.11.1966 he succumbed to death. 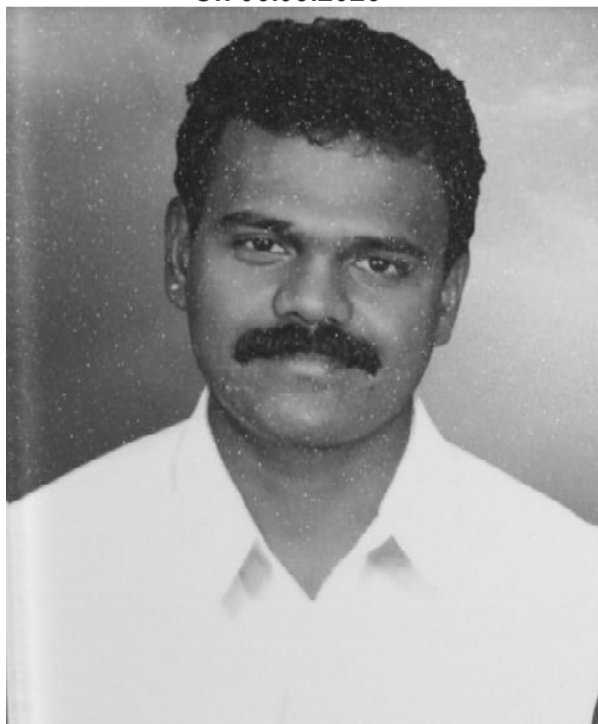

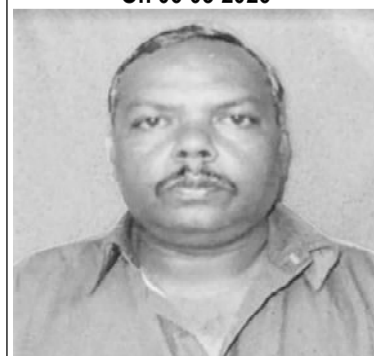
