56 new airports to be created in next three years

New Delhi, Apr 5
 Commerce and Industry Minister Shri Suresh Prabhu today said ten percent of the GDP needs to go to infrastructure. Giving the inaugural address at Global Logistics Summit in New Delhi, Shri Prabhu said 56 new airports will be created in the next three years. Saying that there was no single agency dealing with logistics so far, the Minister informed that a new division at the Ministry will deal with the subject. He also said there is an abundance of entrepreneurship in India and logistics is the key element which will allow entrepreneurship to grow further.

Direct tax collections grow in 2017-18

New Delhi, Apr 3
 The Direct Tax collections for the fiscal year 2017-18 stood at 9.95 lakh crore rupees, which is 17.1 per cent higher than net collection of 2016-17. The tax collections during the fiscal year 2017-18 has exceeded the budget estimates of 9.80 lakh crore rupees. Briefing reporters in New Delhi recently, Finance Secretary Shri Hasmukh Adhia said, the government has broadly met the direct and indirect tax revenue target this year.

Philippines to close popular tourist island Boracay

Manila, Apr 5
 The Philippine island of Boracay will be closed to tourists for six months following concerns of damage to its once pristine shores. A spokesperson for President Rodrigo Duterte said the closure would begin on 26 of this month. The island, known for its white-sand beaches, attracted nearly 2 million tourist last year.

RBI keeps repo rate unchanged

New Delhi, Apr 5
 In line with market expectations, RBI has kept all its key rates unchanged in the first bi-monthly policy review for the financial year 2018-19. It is for the fourth time in a row that the Central bank has not changed the rates. Accordingly, the policy repo rate under the liquidity adjustment facility has been kept unchanged at 6 percent. Consequently, the reverse repo rate remains at 5.75 percent, and the Marginal Standing Facility rate and the Bank Rate at 6.25 per cent.

RBI asks banks to stop services to those dealing in virtual currencies

New Delhi, Apr 5
 The Reserve Bank today directed all regulated entities including banks not to provide services to businesses dealing in virtual currencies like bitcoins, so as to protect consumer interest and check money laundering. In the first bi-monthly monetary policy review of 2018-19, RBI said virtual currencies (VCs) variously referred to as cryptocurrencies and crypto assets, raise

concerns of consumer protection, market integrity and money laundering. Speaking at a press conference after the release, Deputy Governor of RBI, Shri BP Kanungo said in the past, RBI has repeatedly cautioned users, holders and traders of VCs, including bitcoins, regarding various risks associated in dealing with such virtual currencies. He added that now the RBI has decided to ring-fence (Contd. on last page)

The PDOs will be companies, or even small merchants, interested in



providing Wi-Fi hotspots to public using either free or paid model.

Commonwealth Games 2018, Gold Coast

Record-breaking Mirabai Chanu claims India's first gold



Gold Coast, Apr 5 World champion weightlifter Mirabai Chanu (48kg) went on a record-smashing spree, claiming three of them in a power-packed performance, to secure India's first gold medal at the 21st Commonwealth Games here on Thursday. In a remarkable performance, Chanu smashed the Commonwealth and the

Games record in a snatch, pulling off clean lifts in all her three attempts (80kg, 84kg and 86kg). She then lifted more than double her body weight (103kg, 107kg and 110kg) in three successful attempts to claim the clean and jerk as well as the overall Games record. The showing helped her better the silver she had won in the 2014 Glasgow CWG. The Indian ended with a score of 196kg (86kg+110kg), earning a massive applause from the fans at the Carrara Sports and Leisure Centre. The 23-year-old's previous best was a total lift of 194kg (snatch 85kg and 109kg in clean and jerk) achieved in the World Championships a few months ago. Her nearest but still a very distant rival, Amanda Braddock of Canada failed to complete a single lift in the clean and jerk after managing a best of 76kg in the snatch.

India thrash Sri Lanka 5-0 in mixed-team badminton



Gold Coast, Apr 5 India got off to a flying start in badminton on Thursday after thrashing Sri Lanka in mixed-team event by 5-0. The strong Indian contingent, that was without the Rio Olympics silver medal-winning shuttler PV Sindhu, who picked up an ankle sprain a week before the Games, went on to establish absolute dominance as they won in all the five competitions. It was the 2012 London Olympics Bronze medal winning star Saina Nehwal, though, who emerged as the show stealer. The 28-year old went on to defeat Sri Lanka's Madhushika Dirukshi by 21-8, 21-4 to win the women's singles competition for India. The shuttler looked in absolute control as she delivered stunning smashes and drop shots on her way to the win. World No. 2 Kidambi Srikanth too had an easy task of getting past Niluka Karunaratne, as he picked up 21-16, 21-10 victory against the Sri Lankan. India had an early scare at the start with Sachin Dias and Thilini Pramodika Henahewa taking the mixed doubles match against Pranaav Chopra and Ruthvika Gadde down to the very last minute. The Indian duo dropped the second game and then continued to drop points in the final game before a late surge put them ahead of the Sri Lankan pair and they picked up 21-15, 19-21, 22-20 win for India.

Lifter Gururaja claims silver, opens India's medal account

Gold Coast, Apr 5 Weightlifter Gururaja bagged the first medal for India at the 21st edition of the Commonwealth Games 2018 with silver in the men's 56-kilogram category here on Thursday. Gururaja had a best attempt of 111 kg in the snatch and 138 kg in the clean and jerk for a total of 249 kg. Izhar Ahmed of Malaysia won gold with a new Commonwealth Games record of 261 kg. Izhar, who had emerged champion at the Commonwealth Championships last year, bettered the previous Games record by one kilogram.

He also set a new Games record in the snatch with a successful lift of 117 kg in his second attempt. He bettered the previous record of 116 kg set by his compatriot Ibrahim at the



New Delhi Games in 2010. He cleared 144 kg in the clean and jerk which his personal best. Chaturanga Lakmal of Sri Lanka claimed bronze with a total of 248 kg. He managed 114 kg in the snatch and 134 kg in clean and jerk. Manuelli Tulo of Fiji showed a lot of heart and loads of fighting spirit to take the fourth position with a total of 239 kilograms. The Fijian kept the top three lifters on their toes for much of the event and was in contention for the bronze before falling considerably off the pace with two failed attempts in the clean and jerk. Gururaja started on a promising note, taking the lead with his very first attempt in the snatch with a successful attempt of 107 kilograms. Tulo produced a lift of 108 kg in his second attempt. But his attempt was ruled out by the jury due to a technical fault. Lakmal claimed the top spot immediately after with a successful lift of 110 kg in his first attempt.

The central bank further asked entities, which are already into such services to stop providing this kind of services within three months. Further, the RBI has directed all payment system operators to store all data within India.

In a separate statement, RBI said, in order to have unfettered access to all payment data for supervisory purposes, it has been decided that all payment system operators will ensure that data related to payment systems operated by them are stored only inside the country within a period of 6 months.

Bermuda's Duffy wins first gold

Gold Coast, Apr 5 Two-time world champion Flora Duffy of Bermuda lived up to her favoured status to win the sprint triathlon by 43 seconds on Thursday and collect the first gold medal of the 21st Commonwealth Games. The top-ranked Duffy came out the opening 750-meter swim leg just behind Jessica Learmonth, both around 9 minutes, 35 seconds. But Duffy quickly caught the English competitor and the pair staged their own duel for much of the 20-kilometer bike leg four laps around the Broadwater Parklands trading places numerous times. Cycling is Duffy's strongest leg so strong that she is entered in



the mountain bike competition on April 12. Under sunny skies and a temperature of 27 Celsius (81 Fahrenheit), Duffy and Learmonth finished the cycle leg together in 39.23. Duffy took a five-second lead over Learmonth early in the 5-kilometer run and led by 18 seconds after the first lap, or 2.5 kilometers. Duffy finished the race in 56-50, with Learmonth 43 seconds behind to take silver and Canadian Joanna Brown earning bronze, finishing five seconds behind Learmonth after a tight tussle over the closing meters with England's Vicky Holland.

Manoj Kumar advances to pre-quarterfinals in 69kg boxing

After observing all codal formalities, the accused person was arrested on spot. A case under section 32 Reg. III of 1876 has been registered against the accused person. 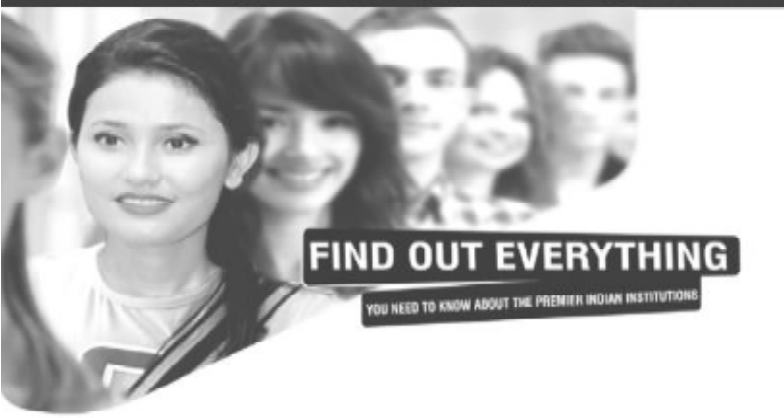
