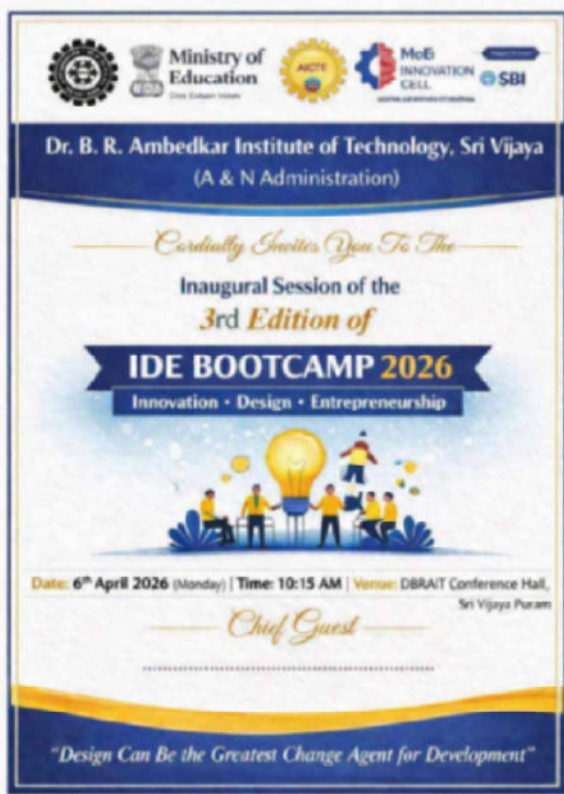

## IMU, Chennai to conduct Common Entrance Test on May 6

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 5

The A&N Administration, on behalf of the Indian Maritime University, Chennai, will conduct a Common Entrance Test (CET) for admission to 7 seats reserved for local candidates in undergraduate programmes at IMU. The examination is scheduled to be held on May 6 from 10 am to 12 pm at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Institute of Technology.

Candidates must have passed 10+2 with a minimum of 60% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics, or hold a

B.Sc. degree (Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry / Electronics with Physics as a subject) with at least 60% overall marks. Additionally, candidates must have secured a minimum of 50% marks in English in any of the qualifying examinations. The age limit is 17 to 25 years, and candidates must meet the prescribed physical standards, including 6/6 unaided vision in both eyes and no colour blindness. Applicants must also fulfill the residency requirement, i.e., domicile in the A&N

Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services (AH&VS), she received 200 Vanaraja chicks from the Central Hatchery, Dollygunj. The Department also provided continuous technical guidance, timely advice and cleared all her doubts, enabling her to manage the birds scientifically under a backyard system.

Smti Mondal allows her birds to range freely near her house in batches, which has significantly reduced feed costs while maintaining good health. Demonstrating remarkable innovation and resourcefulness, she constructed her poultry shed using fishing nets on the side walls - a low-cost solution that ensures excellent ventilation and drastically cuts down construction expenses.

Her success story stands as a powerful motivation for rural women, showing how small-scale backyard poultry farming, when supported with proper training and inputs, can generate steady income and improve socio-economic status. The AH&VS Department continues to encourage and support women, unemployed youth and farmers by supplying quality chicks, technical guidance and training programmes to promote self-employment and nutritional security across the islands. undertook cleaning, minor repairs, maintenance, and repainting of the boats using marine-grade coatings. Officials also sensitised participants on the importance of proper vessel upkeep and colour coding, which plays a crucial role in identification, safety, and regulatory compliance in the fisheries sector.

The initiative not only improved the operational condition of the boats but also directly contributed to enhancing the earning capacity of the beneficiary fishermen. Local fishers actively engaged with the students during the process, sharing insights into traditional fishing practices and challenges faced in sustaining their livelihoods.

The program commenced with encouragement from Guptapara Pradhan, Shri Durlabh Das, who appreciated the Department's efforts in bridging the gap between communities and young learners while addressing grassroots needs in the fisheries sector.

Fishermen expressed heartfelt gratitude, noting that the restored boats would immediately support their daily fishing activities. **Follow-up action in NDPS case: Co-accused financier arrested after financial trail investigation by Anti-Narcotics Police**

Continuing its relentless crackdown on narcotics, the Anti-Narcotics Police Station (ANPS), Andaman & Nicobar Police, by effectively striking backward and forward linkages, has apprehended a key co-accused, thereby strengthening efforts to dismantle the drug network.

Earlier, in FIR No. 07/2025 dated 17.06.2025 under relevant provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985, acting on specific intelligence inputs, a team of Anti-Narcotics Police Station had successfully intercepted a narcotic consignment near Andaman Sea & Airways, Air Cargo & Container Services, Shivram Complex, Mohanpura, Sri Vijaya Puram, resulting in the seizure of 1.560 Kgs of

ganja and arrest of Kavoor Hemant Rao, S/o Shri K. Dhanteshwar Rao (34) yrs, R/o Anarkali near Play Ground, Sri Vijaya Puram, who was subsequently charge-sheeted after completion of investigation.

During the course of further investigation, sustained efforts were undertaken to trace the financial trail and backward linkages associated with the narcotics network. During technical investigation, including analysis of financial transactions and digital records, the involvement of A. Naganathan, S/o Late S. Armugam (41 yrs), Pvt Worker, R/o Hanuman Junction, Haddo, Ward No. 01, Sri Vijaya Puram, came to light, who acted as the financier of the narcotics

operation and played a key role in facilitating the supply chain.

Acting on credible leads, a team of Anti-Narcotics Police Station successfully apprehended the co-accused A. Naganathan, S/o Late S. Armugam (41 yrs), Pvt Worker, R/o Hanuman Junction, Haddo, Ward No. 01, Sri Vijaya Puram on 31.03.2026. The arrest has led to the uncovering of crucial financial linkages and operational networks, further strengthening the case.

The investigation of the case is being carried out by ASI Surya Narayan, Anti-Narcotics Police Station, under the close supervision of Inspector K. Binoj, SHO, Anti-Narcotics Police Station, a press release from DIGP (CID) said.

During the operation, the police team conducted a lawful search of the premises,

which led to the recovery of contraband cannabis, including live and uprooted cannabis plants, as well as a packet containing cannabis flower tops. All the recovered items were seized following due legal procedures.

In this connection, a case under the relevant sections of the NDPS Act, 1985 has been registered, and the accused has been arrested. Further investigation is in progress.

The operation highlights the continued vigilance and zero-tolerance policy of

North & Middle Andaman District Police against drug-related offences in the area.


