DCSA sanctions ex-gratia relief for families of deceased persons due to drowning by crocodile attack

Port Blair, Sept. 5
An unfortunate incident was reported on Sept. 4 wherein one person namely, Jasinta Tirkey expired due to drowning by crocodile attack at Tushnabad village under Ferrargunj Tehsil.

Considering the incident to be an unfortunate one, the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has sanctioned and released an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- towards immediate relief/ financial assistance to the bereaved family of the victim Smt. Jasinta Tirkey, 65 years. Accordingly, Shri Silvanus Tirkey (Husband), Bulkan Kumar Tirkey, Sandeep Tirkey and Vinod Tirkey (three sons), will receive an amount of Rs.37,500/- each (total Rs.1,50,000).

The financial assistance has been sanctioned under "A & N Islands Scheme for Providing Financial Assistance to Victims of Accidents" (who are not covered under the prevailing NDRF/SDRF norms approved by the GoI, a communication from the Assistant Commissioner/ SDM, South Andaman said here today.

Avoid crocodile attack; people urged not to venture into nallahs & creeks

Port Blair, Sept. 5
A lady Smt. Jasinta Tirkey was attacked by a crocodile in a nallah near Ranchi Basthi, Tushnabad when she was washing clothes, on Sept 4 and died due to drowning by the crocodile. Following the incident, the PCCF convened a meeting with public at Range Office Tushnabad in presence of APCCF, DC(SA), SP(SA), CF(WL), DCF(WL) and DFO(SA) and decided to constitute and deploy a Joint Patrolling Team (JPT) at Tushnabad, Collinpur, Mitakhari and Chouldari consisting of personnel from Forest, Police and representative of PRIs with DRMs engaged from the said locality with crocodile proof

net, search/torch lights to each member of the team and one engine dinghy/haulis dinghy for their movement in the creeks, to monitor the movement of crocodiles in the nallahs and creeks, sanitize the creeks, and drive them away from the nallahs, if any found, close to human habitation. The JPT will maintain a log book with details viz. the area covered, sighting of crocodile movement if any, alerts given to the residents, etc. signature of local residents may also be obtained including comments and observation of PRIs in the log book. The team shall complete the sanitization of the creeks/nallahs in the area of above

mentioned Panchayats within a period of two months. A crocodile trap is kept in Range office, Tushnabad to capture the problematic crocodiles in the said areas. A Quick Response Team comprising the executive staff and employees having expertise in capturing of problem crocodiles is

Virat Kohli remains steady at number two in ODI rankings

Dubai, Sept 5
India's batting maestro Virat Kohli held on to the number two position in the latest ICC ODI rankings for batsmen released on Monday, while Rohit Sharma dropped a place to seventh.
Opener Shikhar Dhawan maintained his eighth position. England batsman Joe Root has surged into the top five of rankings for the first time after a stellar performance against Pakistan, which earned him the player of the series award. The 25-year-old scored 274 runs in the series, which helped him leapfrog New Zealand's duo of Kane Williamson and Martin Guptill as well as India batsman Rohit Sharma into fourth position in the latest player rankings.

During the series, the Yorkshireman also achieved a career-best rating of 776 points, which he had attained after the third ODI at Trent Bridge in which he scored 85.
Root is one of the four England batsmen to make upward movement following a 4-1 series win over Pakistan. Alex Hales has risen four places to reach 20th spot after aggregating 223 runs in the series, including a belligerent 171 in the third ODI, captain Eoin Morgan has gained four places and is now in 24th spot, while Jason Roy's series contribution of 181 runs have helped him rise 10 places to share 35th spot with Dinesh Chandimal, who himself has moved up 15 places following a good series with the bat

against Australia. The good news for Pakistan was the movement of its captain Azhar Ali and wicketkeeper Sarfraz Ahmed. Azhar's 208 runs in the series has seen him move up 15 places to 33rd rank, while Sarfraz, who was the highest run-getter in the series from either side with 300 runs, has moved up 21 places to 39th position. Sarfraz had a productive series with the bat when he scored 55, 105, 38, 12 and 90 in the series. Azhar and Sarfraz are the only two Pakistan batsmen, who featured in the recent series against England, to figure inside the top 50. The next highest Pakistan batsman is Shoaib Malik in 67th spot.

US Open 2016: Lucas Pouille stuns Rafael Nadal to reach quarter-finals

New York, Sept 5
Lucas Pouille outlasted 14-time Grand Slam champion Rafael Nadal in a five-set classic on Sunday to lead a trio of French men into the quarter-finals of the US Open.
Pouille, 22 and ranked 25th in the world, lived up to the promise of his quarter-final run at Wimbledon, emerging from a roller-coaster ride with a 6-1, 2-6, 6-4, 3-6, 7-6 (8/6) triumph over the Spanish superstar. The defeat leaves Nadal -- forced out of the French Open third round with a wrist injury that also saw him miss Wimbledon -- without at least one Grand Slam quarter-final appearance for the first time since he was a teenaged tour newcomer in 2004. Pouille came out firing, pushing Nadal back with an array of deep groundstrokes and angled shots. Fifty-two winners from Nadal -- whose attacking response



saw him come out a winner on 35 of 48 forays to the net -- weren't enough. The taut battle came down to the fifth-set tiebreaker and Nadal, trailing 3-6, showed his mettle by saving three match points -- the third on Pouille's serve. Then he smacked a forehand into the net to give Pouille one more chance and the French player pounced on it with a blazing forehand that kissed the

sideline. "It was a very close match, anything could have happened," said Nadal, who opened the fifth set with a break but couldn't hold onto it, dropping his own serve in the eighth to make it 4-4 and set the stage for the tiebreaker. "I fought until the end," Nadal said. "There's things I could do better, but I had the right attitude. I needed something more -- it was not there today."

Three uncapped pacers make Australia squad for South Africa ODIs

Melbourne, Sept 5
Three uncapped pacemen have been named in Australia's One-Day International squad for the tour of South Africa starting later this month. With spearheads Mitchell Starc and Josh Hazlewood being rested from the tour, emerging quicks Chris Tremain, Joe Mennie and Daniel Worrall are set to make their ODI debuts in a new-look Australian bowling attack. Mennie and Worrall were driving forces in South Australia's run to the final in last year's Matoro One-Day Cup, while Tremain claimed 36 wickets in the Sheffield Shield for Victoria. Rod Marsh, Australian chief selector, said the trio were deserving of their opportunities.

Angelique Kerber beats Petra Kvitova to reach US Open quarters, closes in on No.1 slot

New York, Sept 5
Angelique Kerber won a battle of grand slam champions when the second seed powered her way into the quarter-finals of the U.S. Open on Sunday with a 6-3 7-5 win over Petra Kvitova.
By reaching the last eight Kerber has put herself in position to end Serena Williams' long reign as world number one. Williams, bidding for a record seventh U.S. Open title, will now need to reach the final to have a chance of retaining top spot. "When I was a kid, of course I was dreaming to winning slams and being one day number one," admitted Kerber. "Now it can happen. "I'm trying to not put pressure



on myself because I know I have to win few more matches to reach the number one. "When it's happen it will be amazing feeling because that was also one of my dreams. "But let's see what happens here in the next few days." The fourth-round match had a grand slam pedigree to it with Kerber, the Australian Open champion, going against twice Wimbledon winner Kvitova, but it failed to deliver any major excitement. To be fair, Kerber and 14th-seeded Kvitova were handed a tough act to follow with the capacity Arthur Ashe Stadium crowd left buzzing about Frenchman Lucas Pouille's upset win over Rafa Nadal in a five-set thriller that had closed out the day session an hour earlier.

NRAI felicitates Abhinav Bindra

New Delhi, Sept 5
The president of the National Rifle Association of India (NRAI), Raninder Singh, showered praise on Abhinav Bindra at a function here on Sunday to felicitate the former World and Olympic 10m air rifle champion, who had signed off on his brilliant career with a superb run at the Rio Olympics. "When any kid asks me how to become a good shooter, I say 'watch Abhinav train. The focus, the dedication, the professionalism that he brings to the sport is truly one to emulate'," said Raninder Singh.

SIT asks RBI to establish institutional mechanism to share data with other law enforcement agencies

New Delhi, Sept 5
The Special Investigation Team (SIT) on Black Money has asked Reserve Bank of India to establish an institutional mechanism to track illicit financial flows and share data with other law

enforcement agencies. In a letter to RBI Governor last month, the SIT headed by Justice M B Shah underlined the need for creating a data warehouse from where various agencies can gather relevant

information for taking early appropriate action. Earlier, the SIT had asked RBI to provide data on advance remittances and export outstanding of more than one year. At present, RBI holds the information with respect to all types of foreign exchange transactions. It feels that for controlling and tracking illicit financial flows out of the country, use of RBI data by various law enforcement agencies like Enforcement Directorate, Directorate of Revenue Intelligence and CBDT, is of critical importance.

New RBI Governor



New Delhi, Sept 5
Dr. Urjit Patel has assumed charge as the 24th Governor of Reserve Bank, succeeding Raghuram Rajan whose three-year tenure ended yesterday. Dr. Patel assumed charge effective September 4 after serving as deputy governor since January 2013. He was reappointed as deputy governor on January 11, 2016, after the completion of his first three-year term in office.

to promote qualitative and quantitative education to the students of the Islands and also to encourage the teachers, principals and students of other schools to put up concerted efforts for better performance in future. He further informed that out of over 4752 students, who appeared in class XII examinations, about 3400 students have passed the examination and the pass percentage stood at 71.51%. The function concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by the Secretary-cum-Director (Education), Smti Tanvi Garg. positioned in readiness at Deputy Conservator of Forests (WL), Port Blair and Divisional Forest Officer, South Andaman at Wimberlygunj. The Forest Department and the Administration has successfully contained the situation in tourist places by taking series of initiatives to avoid damage/loss due to crocodile attack & minimize such incidences. These include installation of warning signages at all beaches, deployment of lifeguards through Director of Tourism, erection of watch towers, directives to hotels, restaurants and resorts to avoid dumping animal & poultry wastes in and around their premises and sea, while all fishermen were advised to stop dumping of animal wastes in and around the jetty and close to beaches. Advisories were also issued to the villagers through PRIs not to use the creek and nallah for bath, washing clothes and cleaning of utensils. However, the incidence of crocodile attack in remote creeks and nallahs could not be completely averted as villagers are still using the nallahs and creeks for washing clothes, utensils and bathing. The crocodiles move away from salt water areas to upstream areas where fresh water source is available near habitations during breeding season which coincides with the monsoon in the Islands, providing fresh water to streams. This movement of crocodile to upstream areas poses problem to the people residing close to the creeks and nallahs. Though, the Department has deployed staff and personnel to monitor the nallahs and creeks to avoid loss to cattle and humans, incidences of crocodile attacks are not fully averted. Meanwhile, the Forest Department is making all out efforts to monitor the movement of crocodiles and sanitize the creeks and nallahs which are vulnerable for crocodile movement. The general public have been requested not to venture into nallahs and creeks for washing of clothes and utensils and bathing during the rainy season to avoid crocodile attack, a communication received from Deputy Conservator of Forests /Wildlife Division said.
