PM Modi wins TIME Magazine's Person of the Year online readers' poll

New Delhi, Dec 5 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has won the online reader's poll for TIME magazine's Person of the Year 2016, beating out other world leaders like US President-elect Mr Donald Trump, incumbent US leader Mr Barack Obama and Russian President Mr Vladimir Putin. Shri Modi won with 18 per cent of the vote when the poll closed last night. He got significantly more votes than his closest contenders, including Obama, Trump and



Wikileaks Founder Julian Assange, who all received 7 per cent of the 'yes' vote. Time said, Shri Modi was also placed far ahead of other prominent figures of this year, like Facebook founder Mark Zuckerberg (2 per cent) and US Presidential nominee Hillary Clinton (4 per cent). Time's editors will decide

the final Person of the Year later this week, but the online poll results provide a look at how the world sees these figures and Shri Modi emerged as the most influential figure in 2016. Time said the reader poll is an "important window" into who they think most shaped 2016. It is for the second time that Shri Narendra Modi has won the online readers' poll for Time Person of the Year title, securing the honour in 2014, when he had got more than 16 per cent of the almost five million votes cast.

Admn. committed towards health needs of Islanders

Super Specialty Cardiology & Orthopaedic Departments to function from June 1, 2017: Lt. Governor

Port Blair, Dec. 5

The Lt. Governor has affirmed that Health sector in A&N Islands will be given due importance and the Administration will strive to solve the problems and cater to the needs of the Islanders pertaining to health care. To provide specialist services, super specialty departments in Cardiology and Orthopaedic will be started within 5 to 7 months from now, said the Lt Governor, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi while participating in 'Good Morning Port Blair', a programme of All India Radio, Port Blair Station this morning on the topic 'Health scenario of these Islands'.

The Lt Governor said to start the Cardiology Department, a Cath Lab, which will cost Rs 25 crore will be set up while all other equipments and required facilities will also be established. The services of a Cardiologist, Thoracic Surgeon will be made available besides Cardio Care Unit (CCU) will also be made ready. The Super Specialty Cardiology Department will be inaugurated by 1st June, 2017. The process for tendering, purchase of equipments and establishment of new CCU has been put on fast track mode so that all arrangements are complete within these 5-6 months to make the new Super Specialty Cardiology Department functional by 1st June.

The Lt Governor further informed that similar Super Specialty will be opened to deal with ortho cases. To start the Super Specialty Orthopaedic Department, all required equipments will be procured as the services of specialists and surgeon are already available at GB Pant Hospital. The Lt Governor stated that from June 1, 2017, hip- replacement surgery, knee replacement surgery and spine surgery will be carried out at GB Pant Hospital itself. All arrangements to establish both these super specialty departments are progressing well and from 1st June 2017 onwards, cases related to both these departments need not to be referred to mainland for treatment as the specialized

treatment will be carried out here itself. Soon after the establishment of these two Super Specialty departments, the Administration will take two more departments for super specialty treatment i.e Neurology and Nephrology; within the next 6 months time. The main aim to start the super specialty departments is to wipe out the health care related fear from the minds of the Islanders. "Our vision is to provide the best health care facility for the Islanders that



they get at the reputed hospitals on the mainland within the next two years; for which the Administration has prepared a road map and is moving forward in the right direction to achieve the goal", the Lt. Governor said.

The Lt. Governor, during his radio talk, appreciated the fact that people from all walks of life, residing in these Islands including the Administrative Officers, even the Lt

Sexual harassment of Women at Work Place Lt. Governor constitutes 'Local Complaints Committee' to deal with complaints

Port Blair, Dec. 5

The Lt. Governor (Administrator) of A&N Islands in terms of Chapter III of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Work Place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013 has constituted the 'Local Complaints Committee' for South Andaman District, Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Smt. Anuradha Lall, Founder/President, of a reputed NGO will be the Chairperson of the Committee while Smt. Arudra Prasad, AD (Admn), District Officer, SA will be the Member Secretary. Shri P. Kannan, Social Worker and Smt. Shaima Shamim, NGO Member will be the Members of the Committee.

This Committee will receive and address complaints of sexual harassment from establishments where the Internal Complaints Committee has not been constituted, which can be due to having less than ten workers or if the complaint is against the employer himself u/s 6 (1) of the Act.

The Assistant Director (Admn), District Office, South Andaman being the Member Secretary will coordinate and provide secretarial assistance to the committee.

The Complaint Committee shall take necessary steps to prevent or deter the commission of acts of sexual harassment in the workplace and to generate awareness in this regard.

The procedure to be followed will be as per relevant sections (Chapter IV, V, VIII) of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 & The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal), Rules, 2013, a communication from the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman said.

NITI Aayog to provide Rs 5 lakh per district to encourage digital payment system

New Delhi, Dec 5

NITI Aayog will be immediately transferring 5 lakh rupees for every district in the country as seed money to encourage digital payment system. A letter has been written to District Collectors, Commissioners Aad Magistrates in this regard by NITI Aayog CEO Shri Amitabh Kant, who is also member of the committee

to promote cashless payments. For availing the incentive, the District Collector, Commissioner or Magistrates would have to ensure that individuals transiting to digital payment mode should do at least two successful transactions by any of the five methods. These five modes are - Unified Payment Interface (UPI), Unstructured Supplementary Service Data (USSD), Aadhaar Enabled Payments, e-wallets and Rupay debit/credit/prepaid cards.

According to the letter, the top ten best performing districts of India will be awarded the Digital Payment Champions of India Award by NITI Aayog/Government of India. Similarly, the 50 Panchayats which go cashless will be awarded Digital Payment Award of Honour.

AYUSH Minister seeks suggestions to turn India into a global hub for Ayurveda practice & research

Kolkata, Dec 5

The Minister of State (IC) for AYUSH Shri Shripad Yesso Naik has sought suggestions and inputs from Ayurveda researchers and practitioners world over which may be incorporated in the AYUSH Ministry's works related to streamlining the study and practice of this traditional health science in the country. Laser walls at Indo-Pak border to check infiltration: Minister

Gurdaspur, Dec 5

The government will install laser walls and other technologically advanced systems at the India-Pakistan border to thwart any infiltration attempt from across the border. This was stated by the Minister of State for Home Shri Kiren Rijiju at Gurdaspur in Punjab yesterday. He said, the work in this regard will be completed in a year. The "laser walls" or fence are being monitored by Border Security Force which guards

the Indo-Pak International Border in Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Rajasthan and Gujarat. The decision to install these laser walls was taken by BSF two years ago as barbed wire fencing could not be installed in many infiltration prone areas due to treacherous terrain or marshy riverine topography. Use of scientific technology and heightened vigil on riverine frontiers while guarding the Indo-Pak border were among the suggestions given by the

Home Ministry-appointed committee. The committee, headed by former Union Home Secretary Shri Madhukar Gupta, was set up following the terror attack on Pathankot air base. Shri Rijiju paid tributes to Saheed Ram Parkash on his 25th martyrdom anniversary, organized at Qadian town in Gurdaspur district.

Severe weather warning for next 24 hrs in Andaman & Nicobar: IMD

New Delhi, Dec 5

India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued severe weather warning for next 24 hours. It has predicted heavy to very heavy rain at a few places with extremely heavy falls at isolated places over Nicobar Islands and heavy at isolated places over Andaman Islands. Fishermen have been asked

not to venture into the sea around Nicobar Islands. An official release said, sea condition is expected to be rough to very rough along and off shore. The Department has also predicted dense fog at isolated places over Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, north Chhattisgarh, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura.

Towards a cashless society

Cashless transactions to get further momentum in Isles: Principal Secretary

Port Blair, Dec 5

After demonetization, the Government of India has been stressing on implementing cashless transaction in the country and people have been urged to migrate from brick and mortar mode to a digital world. The Principal Secretary (Finance), A&N Administration, Shri Raajiv Yaduvanshi, in an interview with All India Radio, Port Blair recently, shared his view on the subject.

Speaking about cashless transaction, the Principal Secretary said it is a medium where cash is not used; instead, transactions are made through internet banking, mobile phones and POS machines by swiping debit/credit cards. In addition, there is a RUPAY Card, which is linked with many schemes of Govt. of India viz. Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana. The Rupay card belongs to our country and hence it will be good to use it, he added. About implementing cashless transaction here in Isles, the Principal Secretary said, the facilities for cashless transactions are being provided through banks. Common man can interface with the Administration by paying their utility bills such as electricity, water, tax etc. by making use of credit or debit card or through apps like SBI Buddy, Paytm etc.

People can deposit upto Rs. 5000 using such facility for various Departments viz. Electricity, Water, Shipping, Civil Aviation etc. He stated that to facilitate such transaction, the Administration has decided to open Current

Addressing several hundred Indian-Americans from in and around Washington DC, Maryland and Virginia, Shri Sarna said "the Open House would be held every fortnight wherein people with their grievances related to passports, visas and OCI cards can simply walk in and the senior embassy officials would address them."

ISRO schedules launch of Resourcesat-2A on December 7

New Delhi, Dec 5 The Indian Space Research Organization, ISRO has scheduled the launch of India's remote sensing satellite Resourcesat-2A on December 7. The public relations director of the national space agency, Dr. Deviprasad Karnik told AIR News, the satellite would be launched by PSLV-C36 at 10.24 am from its spaceport at Sriharikota. Resourcesat-2A is intended to provide data continuity to the users. The Resourcesat 2A is configured like its predecessor Resourcesat-2, that was launched in April 2011. The satellite will be injected into a sun-synchronous polar orbit by the launch vehicle. The satellite will be having

three-tier imaging capacity, with a unique combination of instruments consisting of three solid-state cameras to map the natural resources. India has a constellation of remote sensing satellites in orbit and Resourcesat-2A would augment its capacity in generating important data.

Veterinary health camp

KL Rahul has played 10 Test matches for India, scoring three hundreds with a total of 532

Though the prime reason behind Anil Kumble staying put with the veteran is injury to Wriddhiman Saha, but Parthiv's performance in Mohali gives his selection plenty of weight too. It does remain a tough choice for coach Kumble and captain Virat Kohli to make. Indian Team which is leading the five-match series 2-0, will look to retain their dominance in fourth test also. On the other hand, England will look forward to stop the India's winning streak and try to win the remaining matches to level the series.

India's Parikh stuns Gilchrist at World Billiards

Bengaluru, Dec 5
In the first upset of the tournament, India's Siddharth Parikh today shocked multiple-time World Champion Peter Gilchrist in a closely fought battle 500-483 at 2016 IBSF World Billiards Championship in 500 long-up format here.

the convenience of PDS beneficiaries. It was informed that the Department has already shared the details of FPS dealers to the concerned bank, however, the FPS dealers have been advised to approach the bank by 8th December 2016 for making formal request for swipe machine to facilitate the banker in procuring machines in due course of time. Department would facilitate the FPS owners in getting a swipe machine, opening of Bank Account (if required) and for installation of landline. The FPS Owners Association was requested to provide details in this regard by 9th December 2016, a communication said.

Account of 30 departments and the proposal has been sent to the Govt. of India. PoS Machines will also be installed in the CSCs, which will in turn play a great role in helping people pay their utility bills & taxes through cashless transaction, said the Principal Secretary.

Speaking about the availability of POS machines in Isles, the Principal Secretary remarked that at present there are 534 POS Machines. He urged the traders and establishments to use POS machines, enabling the growth of cashless transaction in Isles. Accordingly, the Andaman Chamber of Commerce as well as various traders of Isles have requested for an additional 423 POS machines and the Administration have placed an order for these POS machines with the suppliers. In addition to this, the Administration has also taken stock of POS machines to be installed in various Departments. For example, in Tourism sector, the Administration has decided to install POS machines in Govt. guest houses. Accordingly, the State Bank of India has placed an order for 1200 POS machines, which are expected to arrive within 10-12 days. Thus, instead of using cash, a person can make cashless transactions, he said.

The Principal Secretary said, the total population of Isles is approximately 4 lakh and the number of bank account is approximately 6.5 lakhs, this shows that there are more bank account as compared to the population. He further stated that people of these Islands are updated, educated and well disciplined and Aadhar coverage is about 96%, which is quite good. Hence, cashless transaction scheme will work well here, he added.

He also urged the youth to create awareness in their families and neighborhoods about cashless transactions and teach them how to do it. He further said that calibration of ATM machines to dispense new notes will be completed very soon. Once the ordered POS machines arrive and the process of thumb impression completes, these machines can function as micro ATMs and this will further boost to cashless transactions.

Speaking about Commercial Establishments, the Principal Secretary said, traders have been requested to use POS machines to promote cashless transactions. There are about one-lakh labourers working in Isles and the stakeholders of skilled/unskilled labourers, organized/unorganized sectors should encourage their workforce to open bank accounts so that their salaries can be directly credited to their respective accounts, he said. In our islands, there are about 47 factories, 530 workers, factory owners, establishments and their stakeholders and if all of them cooperate, cashless transactions can easily be achieved here in Isles too, he added. The Principal Secretary also assured the public that once micro ATMs are enabled in Isles, the cashless transaction scheme would gain further momentum and be successful in A&N Islands.
