LG expresses views on 'shipping sector' over AIR

Shipping sector to make discernable progress by 2019

Online booking of ship tickets to be introduced by Oct/Nov 2017

Port Blair, Mar 6

Shipping service is the lifeline of the Islands and in next couple of years, the Shipping sectors is poised to make discernable progress. Strengthening the fleet of ships for the Islands will be a game changer for the Islands, stated the Lt. Governor, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi expressing his views on 'Shipping Sector' while participating in 'Good Morning Port Blair' programme broadcast by All India Radio today. The Lt. Governor said the A&N Islands Shipping services has a fleet of 79 vessels, out of which, presently 45 vessels is continuously giving its service.

To augment the shipping sector, the A&N Administration has struck a deal for purchasing 25 new vessels. Out of this, two 1200 pax capacity passenger vessels will be for plying between mainland and Islands. The construction of the vessels are being done in Cochin Shipyard Ltd. and it is expected to be delivered by March 2019 and September 2019 respectively. In addition to this, another two 500 pax capacity vessel for plying between

inter island are also being constructed in Cochin Shipyard Ltd. The vessels are expected to be handed over by July 2019 and December 2019.

Further, an order for purchasing four 150 passenger capacity vessel and six 250 pax capacity harbor crafts have been placed at Goa Shipyard. The 150 pax capacity harborcrafts will be delivered from May 2017 onwards. With this, the shipping service between Port Blair and other Islands will improve to a large extent, the Lt. Governor mentioned.

The Lt. Governor also stated that considering the need for more number of vessels for inter island service, the A&N Administration has procured a 450 pax cum 100 ton cargo capacity vessel 'MV Coral Queen' on lease and will be in operation by

the end of March 2017.

In addition to this, 388 pax cum 100 ton cargo vessel 'MV. Bharat Seema' has been taken over from Lakshdweep Administration and has been inducted into the existing fleet of shipping services. Presently, the vessel is plying between Port Blair and Hut Bay from Oct 7, 2016 and has also started its service to Car

Nicobar as well.

A 75 pax capacity cum 50 ton capacity vessel M.V. Kamorta has been stationed at Campbell Bay for providing service to Nicobar group of Islands. In addition to this, on the demand of the people of Diglipur, the frequency of shipping service has been increased from the present two days in a week to three days now. To facilitate

passengers during festivals and local events, additional shipping services are being provided at Neil and Havelock Islands, the Lt. Governor said.

On people's demand, another 50 pax capacity vessel has been provided for plying between Long Island and Rangat.

The Lt. Governor disclosed that the A&N Administration in association with Central Railway Information System has made an agreement for online booking of ship tickets and is expected to materialize by Oct/Nov 2017. With this, the people of the Islands will be facilitated with web based ticketing facility.

Trucks weighing more than 10 MT will not be permitted to board vehicle ferries

Port Blair, Mar 6

The vehicle ferry services provided by the Directorate of Shipping Services in the creeks of ATR not only plays an integral part in smooth movement of passengers and their vehicles but also in the transshipment of vehicles carrying essential cargo and other materials to North and Middle

Andaman Islands from Port Blair. The cargo to these areas is generally being transhipped through trucks. These trucks are sometimes found to be overloaded. Transportation of these overloaded trucks is not only dangerous but also, often results in breakdowns of machinery and ramps of vehicle

ferries thereby resulting in disruption of essential services.

In view of above cited reasons and to avoid any undue disruption in vehicle ferry services, it has been decided to impose restriction of loads on transshipment of trucks.

Safety of passengers & vehicles in vehicle ferries restricted

The passenger and vehicle ferries of Directorate of Shipping Services operating in the Harbour sectors have a fixed and notified passenger/vehicle carrying capacity. Carrying passengers/vehicles, over and above the defined capacity of these vessels is unsafe both for the vessel and passengers,

Centre asks SBI to reconsider penalty on non-maintenance of minimum balance in accounts

New Delhi, Mar 6

The Centre has asked the State Bank of India to reconsider its decision to impose a penalty on non-maintenance of minimum balance in accounts from 1st April onwards. According to sources, the Government has also urged various banks, including private banks to reconsider the charges on cash transactions and ATM withdrawals above a certain limit. After a gap of

five years, State Bank of India had decided to reintroduce penalty on non-maintenance of minimum balance in accounts from 1st of next month. The Bank also revised charges on other services, including ATMs. Country's largest bank will permit savings bank account holders to deposit cash three times a month free of charges and levy 50 rupees plus service tax on every transaction beyond that. As per revised charges of SBI, failure to maintain Monthly Average Balance (MAB) in accounts will attract penalty of up to 100 rupees plus service tax.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Port Blair Municipal Council has decided to licence the hoarding sites through transparent and competitive bidding process. Against this decision, few of the Advertising Agencies filed cases in High Court which were dismissed. These agencies also filed appeals before the Division Bench of the High Court which were also dismissed paving way to complete the competitive bidding process.

Accordingly, the PBMC invited sealed bids for 92 hoarding sites (bundled in 23 baskets each containing 4 sites) and got bids for 84 hoarding sites (bundled in 21 baskets each containing 4 sites). The response for the competitive bidding process was highly encouraging and the PBMC will be getting Rs. 126 Lakhs against the present revenue of Rs. 52.92 Lakhs annually. New licences have already been issued to the highest bidders.

Recently, it has been observed that some of the agencies/individuals whose license period has already expired are still continuing with display of advertisements on the hoarding sites unauthorisedly. All such agencies are hereby warned that strict action will be taken against them in case such activities are not stopped forthwith and the General Public is hereby requested not to pay any monthly rental to such advertising agencies who are not possessing valid licence from the PBMC.

It has also been observed that many un-authorized board /panels/frames are fixed on the electric pole/telephone pole. Display of such advertisements is not only in violation of the PBMC Advertisement Byelaws, 1999 but also a serious public safety hazard as it may lead to accident due to distractions/obstructions. This amounts to breach of PBMC Advertisement Byelaws and liable for fine to the extent of Rs. 500/- and when the breach continues further fine of Rs. 50/- for every subsequent day will also be imposed.

In view of above, all concerned are hereby advised not to do/display /carryout any form of advertisement through hoardings /banners /cutouts /plastic/ vinyl boards without permission from the PBMC. In case of violation, apart from imposition of fine /penalty, other appropriate action will be taken as per law.

The PBMC is also contemplating to file cases under the Negotiable Instrumental Act against those Advertisement Agencies who cheques got dishonored and to initiate legal action against the Advertising Agencies who have defaulters in paying their dues.

2nd Test: Defiant Rahane, Pujara lead India fightback

Bangalore, Mar 6
After India restricted Australia's lead to 87, courtesy Ravindra Jadeja's six for 63, in the first session, it was imperative for India to start well to get back on even terms in the second India v Australia Test at Chinnaswamy Stadium, Bangalore and KL Rahul provided the start with a watchful 51, but heading in to tea India had handed Australia the advantage after losing four wickets in the post-lunch session. But Cheteshwar Pujara (79*) and Ajinkya Rahane (40*) rescued the hosts with a valiant 93-run unbeaten stand for the fifth wicket - the best partnership in the series for either team - helping India (213/4) to a lead of 126 runs on day three. India were effectively 35 for four going in to the final session and for them to have any glimmer of hope in the Test match, they needed to win the battle of attrition and who better than Rahane and Pujara to consume



time and frustrate Australia. The intensity of the bowlers was right up there in the first two sessions but it waned in the final and both Indian batsmen took advantage of that. Nathan Lyon continued to find turn and bounce from a good length area but this time around Rahane and Pujara were better prepared and luck also went their way. A lot of balls that spun sharply and bounced in excess could very well have been bat-padded to the close in fielders, but that did not happen. A lot of deliveries from pacers Mitchell Starc, Josh Hazlewood and Mitchell Marsh kept dangerously low but both

Rahane and Pujara managed an edge. In reply, India walked out to bat and both Rahul and Abhinav Mukund looking much more assured in the middle than they had been in the first innings. However, Mukund failed to add to his pre-lunch score of 16 and was castled by Hazlewood in the first over of the second session but Rahul, at the other end, applied himself well on the tough track. Veteran tennis star Leander Paes was today retained in the Indian Davis Cup team for next month's Asia/Oceania Zone tie against Uzbekistan. The tie, which will be India's first with Mahesh Bhupathi as the non-playing captain, will also see the return of Rohan Bopanna. Bopanna had been ignored for last month's tie against New Zealand, which

India had won. He did extremely well at the just-concluded Dubai ATP 500 event, where he ended runner-up with partner Marcin Matkowski. En route the summit clash, he also got the better of Paes and his partner Gracia Gulliermo-Lopez in the semifinals. India will go in with two specialist singles players in Yuki Bhambri and Ramkumar Ramesh.

Asia Men's Rugby Sevens Trophy: Ind defeat Pak to secure 7th rank

Doha, Mar 6
The Indian men's Rugby team defeated Pakistan 14-12 to secure the 7th rank at the Asia Men's Rugby Sevens Trophy. The two-day championship was held on Friday and Saturday, at Aspire Rugby Field in Doha, Qatar. India who were led by skipper Gautam Dagar, were beaten twice by UAE in the first round on day one. UAE won with scores of 19-12 and 45-0. On Day Two in the cup quarter finals, India lost to Singapore by 7-19, and in the 5th & 6th placing matches, India lost to Iran by 5-17. Philippines won

from across Asia vied for top honours in the championship. The teams were from: India, Singapore, Pakistan, Jordan, Philippines, Nepal, UAE, Thailand, Iran, Bangladesh and host Qatar.

personally with the farmers of Neil Island for making assessment of sensitization & motivation towards organic farming and to study the gap to be addressed for accomplishing the Mission objective. The villages visited were Bharatpur, Ram Nagar, Sitapur, Laxmanpur and Neil Kendra. The views of the progressive farmers were recorded. The team also contacted Shri. Ram Krishna Biswas, Pradhan, to take his views on problems & constraints for accomplishment of the organic mission. The team found that most of the farmers cultivating vegetables are on lease basis. The land owners are mostly engaged in tourism business. It is observed that considerable quantities of vegetables from Port Blair are being sold at Neil Island at cheaper rate. The farmers demanded for creating separate market for organic produce to fetch higher return for their organic produce. The farmers were in apprehension that they may face shortage of organic inputs, especially organic fertilizers in the event of converting the entire Island as organic; hence they requested to Agriculture Department should make assured supply of sufficient organic inputs. They also expressed the need of extensive training on each & every activity of organic farming.

Based on the assessment of the views of farmers, the team came to the conclusion that the farmers of Neil Islands are mentally prepared to adopt organic farming but they are extensively depended on Administration's support for providing necessary infrastructure for market, timely supply of essential inputs and their capacity building.

On the basis of the team's assessment, it has been decided that extensive training would be imparted in planned manner. The team constituted for this purpose will visit Neil Island every week. Efforts will be made to create separate market for the organic produce and cater the requirement of essential organic input, thus within 1 or 2 months all the farmers at Neil Island will start organic practice.

Similarly, the Administration is proposing to launch Organic Farming in Little Andaman to convert the entire Island as organic. The same team will visit Little Andaman Island on alternate week for initiating the sensitization & awareness to the farmers. The team will visit Little Andaman on 10th March 2017 for the purpose.

Henceforth, trucks / larger vehicles weighing more than 10MT (inclusive of their cargo) will not be permitted to board the departmental vehicle ferries operating in the creeks.

All transporters are therefore requested to cooperate and not load excess cargo in their trucks/vehicles whilst transshipping through the vehicle ferries.

The Masters of the vehicle ferries are being directed to strictly deny embarkation of any truck / vehicle seeming weighing more than 10 ton. The Police authorities are also being requested to stop such heavily loaded vehicles from approaching the jetty/ embarkation areas, a communication received here said.

Saina, Sindhu to lead Indian challenge at All England

Birmingham, Mar 6
Olympic medalists Saina Nehwal and P V Sindhu will look to become only the third Indian to lay hands on the prestigious All England trophy when they lead the home challenge at the Super Series Premier tournament, starting with the qualifiers here tomorrow. Ever since Pullela Gopichand emulated Prakash Padukone's 1980 feat in 2001, no Indian has ever laid claim to the crown with Saina being the country's only shuttler to come close to achieving that rare feat when she reached the finals at 2015 before losing to Olympic champion Carolina Marin.

Both Saina and Sindhu have

made a resounding start to the new season with titles at Malaysia Masters and Syed Modi Grand Prix Gold tournaments in January and they would now look to make a positive start to the Super Series circuit, which also includes events at India, Malaysia and Singapore. Eighth seeded Saina, who fought back from a career-threatening knee injury in August to not only recover but start competitive badminton in November, will face defending champion Japan's Nozomi Okuhara, who is nursing a shoulder injury. She last played in November where she withdrew half-way through her first round encounter.

considering the fact that all these vessels have life saving equipments only as per their capacities.

The Directorate of Shipping Services in order to avoid overcrowding in the passenger and vehicle ferries, through their staff regulates passenger and vehicular traffic in the harbour sector. As per the evolved system, both passengers and vehicles are required to maintain separate queues while boarding the vessels and tickets will be issued at the embarkation point/ entry point. The number of passengers and vehicles boarding is to be restricted as per the capacity of the vessel. Once a particular vessel is full to its capacity, remaining passengers if any, are to be boarded in the subsequent ferry/ vehicle ferry. The above regulated embarkation / disembarkation of passengers will be strictly implemented with immediate effect. Further, the passengers are also requested to occupy their seats in the designated seating area in the vessels.

The Directorate of Shipping Services has solicited the cooperation and support of all passengers regularly availing these ferry services, in implementing the above regulatory system to ensure safe and efficient services. All required assistance / support shall be provided by the staff of the Directorate available on the jetty / site, a communication received here said.
