PM to launch National Nutrition Mission on mar 8 North & Middle Andaman District also selected for implementation of NNM

Port Blair, March 6 Government of India has approved setting up of National Nutrition Mission (NNM) commencing from 2017-18. The goal of National Nutrition Mission (NNM) is to achieve improvement in nutritional status of children from 0- 6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers in a time bound manner during the next three years. The Mission will be rolled out in a phased manner. Phase I of the Mission will cover 315 Districts wherein North & Middle Andaman has also been selected. NNM aims to ensure convergence of various programmes; give incentive to States/UTs for achieving goals; IT enabled Real Time Monitoring (ICT-RTM) by using smart phones and tablets; evaluation; weighing efficiency and making nutrition visible; community mobilization awareness advocacy; IEC, 'jan andolan' for children, Nutrition message

through folk songs and songs on WASH, sending messages on nutrition and also creating ring-tones, Yoga for children at AWCs; strengthening human resource; measuring height of children below 6 years of age etc. The Mission includes provision of Supplementary Nutrition @ Rs. 13/- for Children between 6 month to 6 years, Rs. 15/- for pregnant & lactating mothers, Rs. 19/- for malnourished children and Rs. 15.50/- for Adolescent Girls (11-14 years, Out of School), Immunization, Health & Nutrition Education, Referral Services and Pre School Education in Anganwadi Centres. All beneficiaries have been advised to enroll themselves in the nearby Anganwadi Centres for availing these services. The Prime Minister will be formally launching the Mission on 8th March (Contd. on last page)

SI Kunji Mohammed of A & N Police sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for three years

Port Blair, March 6 Shri Ashutosh Sarkar, Additional Sessions Judge, Andaman & Nicobar Islands pronounced a verdict on Mar 5, 2018 convicting and sentencing accused Kunji Mohammed, Sub Inspector of A & N Police Force to rigorous imprisonment for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.50,000/- in default to undergo rigorous

imprisonment for a further period of three months for the offence punishable under section 218 I.P.C. for his negligence and dereliction of duties after arresting one Supriyan Barla who, after being taken by the police into custody, subsequently committed suicide. As per the Prosecution story, one girl of Kadamtala lodged a complaint to the PS

against Supriyan Barla alleging that he outraged her modesty, assaulted her and tore right side of her salwar on 16.04.2007. She however managed to escape and lodged a complaint to police station. Indian women's hockey team beats South Korea 3-2 in second match

Incheon (South Korea), Mar 6
Indian women's hockey team registered their second consecutive victory of the South Korea tour as they defeated hosts 3-2 in the second match of the five-match series here at the Jinchun National Athletic Centre on Tuesday. Goals for India were scored by Poonam Rani (6'), skipper Rani (27') and Gurjit Kaur (32') while Yurim Lee (10') and Jungeun Seo (31') scored for Korea. With the confidence levels high after their victory in the first match on Monday, India started the first quarter aggressively by making attacking forays inside the opposition's half, and were

rewarded for their efforts as Poonam Rani scored for the visitors in the sixth minute to give her side the lead. South Korea also had chances in the first quarter as they were awarded two PCs, and made a comeback into the match by converting the first one through Yurim Lee in the 10th minute to make the scores 1-1. The hosts could have taken the lead in the latter stages of the first quarter but India defended well to save the second PC as the teams ended the first period locked at a goal apiece. The second quarter saw South Korea start off from where they left in the first quarter as they won back-to-back

penalty corners to put India under pressure. However, the visitors stuck to their task as they defended well as a unit, with their young goalkeeper Swati making crucial saves to deny the hosts from going in front. With the pressure piling on India, it was a brilliant team-move from the visitors on the counter which saw captain Rani find the back of the net to give her team an important 2-1 lead in the 27th minute. The teams went into half-time with India leading by a single goal, but with South Korea having the better chances in the opening half-hour, the hosts looked to make them count in the last two quarters.

Virat Kohli, Cheteshwar Pujara hold spots but R Ashwin slips in ICC Test rankings

Dubai, Mar 6
India captain Virat Kohli and senior batsman Cheteshwar Pujara held their second and sixth positions respectively on the batsmen's list while off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin slipped a notch to be at sixth among bowlers in the latest ICC Test rankings. Australian speedster Mitchell Starc reached a career-best fifth position among bowlers after his 'Player-of-the-match' performance in the Durban Test against South Africa helped his side win by 118 runs and take a 1-0 lead in the four-match series. The 28-year-old Starc finished with a match haul of nine for 109, enabling him to overtake South Africa's new-ball bowlers Morne Morkel and Vernon Philander among others, eclipsing his previous best sixth position that he enjoyed in December 2016. Further, the left-hander's 42



runs in the Test have not only helped him gain three slots to reach 74th position among batsmen but have also helped him make it to the top-five among all-rounders. He is now on 312 points, 35 less than his tally when he was fourth on the all-rounders' list in August 2016. Other Australia players to have gained in the latest rankings update include the Marsh brothers. Shaun Marsh has reached a career-best 16th position among batsmen with his 73 runs in the match while his brother Mitchell has moved up

to 43rd place from his 56th rank before the Test, to also reach his highest ranking among batsmen thus far. Mitchell has also gained one slot to reach 58th slot among bowlers. For South Africa, Aiden Markram's scores of 32 and 143 have helped him gain 28 slots to reach a career-best 19th place. Markram, who had led South Africa to victory in the ICC U19 Cricket World Cup in 2014, has had a phenomenal rise as he sees himself in the top-20 after only his seventh Test, notching three centuries and two scores in the 90s.

seated outside the police lock up and he managed to escape due to negligence on the part of the police. On the following day (18.04.2007) Supriyan Barla was found dead hanging at his house at a look of having committed suicide. Accused S.I. Kunji Mohammed was the SHO of Kadamtala PS at that time. It was the Prosecution case that had the police taken due care and action on the complaint lodged by the girl who was outraged and assaulted by Supriyan, the suicidal death of Supriyan by hanging himself could have been prevented. The dead body was subjected to autopsy when the autopsy surgeon noticed some injuries. Thereafter second autopsy was also conducted by a team of Doctors. Thereafter FIR against Kunji Mohammed was registered alleging murder of Supriyan Barla, his wrongful confinement causing bodily injury, negligence in the discharge of duties which he was lawfully bound to do and causing disappearance of evidence, punishable under sections 302/342/330/218/201 IPC.

Prosecution examined as many as 23 witnesses in court and produced many documents and material objects to substantiate the case. Accused did not adduce any evidence in support of his innocence. On an overall consideration of the evidence in the nature of oral, documentary and material objects, the Additional Sessions Judge came to the conclusion that the Prosecution has miserably failed to establish charges under sections 302, 330, 342 and 201 IPC but held that the Prosecution has been able to establish with cogent and unequivocal evidence to prove the charge under section 218 IPC against the accused holding that the death of Supriyan Barla could have been prevented had the police taken due care and caution and that when a person is taken by police into custody, it is the paramount duty of the police to keep him safely, but due to negligence of the police the unfortunate incident took place. On such observation the learned Judge convicted accused on 28.02.2018 under section 218 IPC and gave the convict opportunity of making his submissions on the quantum of sentence on 05.03.2018.

After hearing the accused on the quantum of sentence and the Public Prosecutor the learned Judge observed that the offence committed by the convict should not be regarded as less serious and that the convict being a responsible public servant violated the oath of office with the intention or knowledge to cause injury to the victim girl as well as the society and to save the deceased Supriyan Barla from legal punishment. Accordingly the learned Judge passed the above sentence upon the convict. Mr. Ananda Halder, Additional Public Prosecutor conducted prosecution in the case.

Manu Bhaker wins second gold at shooting World Cup

Mexico, Mar 6
The sensational Manu Bhaker, all of 16, shot her way to a second successive gold medal in a mixed team event as India consolidated their position at the top in the ISSF World Cup in Guadalajara, Mexico. Partnering Om Prakash Mitharval, the Indian teenager clinched the 10m air pistol mixed team title, a day after she won the women's 10m air pistol individual gold on what is turning out to be a memorable senior World Cup debut. The 11th standard student could be the youngest ever to win senior World Cup gold medals for India, though the National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) could not confirm. Also, the duo of Deepak Kumar and Mehuli Ghosh won the country its sixth medal of the competition - a bronze in the 10m air rifle mixed team



event. Deepak and Mehuli shot 435.1 in the five-team final, finishing behind the Romanian pair of Alin Moldoveanu and Laura-Georgeta Coman who shot 498.4 for silver. China's Xu Hong and Chen Keduo won gold in a world record score of 502.0. But it was Bhaker, the girl from Jhajjar, Haryana, who stunned the shooting world with a second successive gold in as many days. For someone who took to shooting just a little over two

years ago, winning two gold medals in a global event of this magnitude would easily qualify as some achievement. Shooting happened to her by chance after a brush with contact sports (boxing, martial arts) and Bhaker has already stamped her class in the tournaments she competed in.

Defending champions Eastern Sporting Union will take on Indira Gandhi Academy for Sports & Education on the opening day as the 2nd edition of the Hero Indian Women's League in Shillong on March 25. The tournament will be played among seven teams who face each other once with the top four teams advancing to the semi-finals to be played on April 12. The final is slated for April 15. I-League 2017-18 debutants Gokulam Kerala FC, the sole club from I-League to have fielded a team in the IWFL will also be in action on the first day itself when they take on Rising Student Club of Odisha.

Sultan Azlan Shah hockey: India go down to table-toppers Australia

New Delhi, Mar 6
A listless India went down to Australia 2-4 for their second loss in three matches, pushing them out of the race to reach the final at the 27th in Ipoh on Tuesday. Late goals by Ramandeep Singh (52', 53') were only enough to avoid a whitewash against table toppers Australia. Mark Knowles (28'), Aran Zaleski (35'), Daniel Beale (38') and Blake Govers (40') scored for Australia.

India, who have rested many senior players for the tournament, had lost their opener to Argentina 2-3 before drawing 1-1 with England. Against Australia, it was a must-win match for India but getting the better of the Australians proved to be tough as always. With better ball possession in the first quarter, India created three potential chances to score but could not convert.
