Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation addresses a press conference on Narcotics Control

A three-year roadmap from July 2026 to July 2029 is ready to create a 'Drug-free India': Hon'ble Home Minister

New Delhi, Sept. 6 (PIB)

Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah today addressed a press conference on narcotics control in Panaji, the capital of Goa. Addressing the press conference, Hon'ble Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah said that since Shri Narendra Modi became the Prime Minister, the Government of India has taken numerous steps to strengthen the country's internal security. He said that when Modi Ji became the Prime Minister, the country was facing three formidable problems, which included rising terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir, Naxalism, and the unrest created by several armed organisations in the Northeast. In addition, on the internal security front, the country was also greatly troubled by several bomb blasts. There were large-scale movements regarding the safety of women. It was precisely during that period that Modi Ji assumed the office of the Prime Minister of the country.

Looking back from 2019 to



now under his leadership, the situation has changed significantly. After the abrogation of Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir, the feeling of separatism has reduced considerably. The figures of terrorism are gradually shrinking and moving towards zero, and Jammu and Kashmir has progressed on the path of development. Successful efforts have also been made to bridge the mental distance that existed between Jammu and Kashmir and the rest

of the country. The five-decade-old problem of Naxalism has today almost become a thing of the past. Most of the people who imagined the Red Corridor have today surrendered by laying down arms and are joining the mainstream. Similarly, in the Northeast as well, around 11,000 youth have laid down arms. The Government of India has signed more than 14 agreements with them, and today the Northeast is also

progressing on the path of development.

After 2019, a campaign has also been launched against fugitives who fled after committing crimes. From 2019 to July 2026, 274 fugitives have been extradited from 36 countries. These include people involved in serious crimes such as economic offences, terrorism, narcotics, and gang wars. All of them have been brought before the courts of India. In the last three years, 401 Red Corner Notices have been issued. In 2026 alone, up to July, the entire process of issuing 182 Red Corner Notices has been successfully completed. For this, a new system has been created in the form of 'BHARATPOL'. More than 14 central agencies and the police of all states are connected to 'BHARATPOL'. A well-organised mechanism has been prepared through 'BHARATPOL' for the extradition of fugitives from

Amendment of A&N Excise Policy, 2013 and launch of online portal for registration of Liquor Brands

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 6

The Andaman & Nicobar Excise Policy, 2013 has recently been amended by the A&N Administration with the objective of simplifying and streamlining the licensing and liquor brand registration process, enhancing transparency, promoting ease of doing business and ensuring time-bound disposal of applications through a digital platform.

The amendments introduce several

important measures,

including extension of the validity of specified excise licences to three years, introduction of eligibility criteria for registration of liquor brands, and provision for time-bound processing of applications. These measures are aimed at providing a more transparent, efficient and structured framework for excise-related services and facilitating greater convenience to the

stakeholders.

In addition to this, the Excise Department, A&N Administration has launched the Online Portal for Registration of Liquor Brands, which is now live and operational for online submission and processing of applications relating to liquor brand registration. All concerned stakeholders are requested to make use of the online services available

Retailers and wholesalers cautioned against illegal hoarding of potato for black-marketing & profiteering

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 6

The Directorate of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs has inspected the major vegetable markets of Sri Vijaya Puram, including Ratnam Market, Mohanpura Market and Haddo Market, in view of the recent non-availability of potato and the rise in its retail price.

The inspections revealed a temporary shortage. No stock was found with the major

wholesalers or in cold storage. A cargo vessel carrying potato from Kolkata had to return mid-voyage due to engine failure, disrupting the regular island supply. A limited air-lifted quantity is being sold by a few retailers at about Rs.120 to Rs.140 per kg.

M.V. TCI Laxmi arrived at Sri Vijaya Puram on 04.09.2026 with approximately 140 bags (7 MT) of potato. M.V. APJ Karan 2,

carrying about 368 MT of potato, is expected between 9-11 September 2026. Arrival and distribution of this consignment is expected to improve availability and help in stabilising the retail price.

The retailers and wholesalers are cautioned that illegal hoarding of potato (essential commodity) for black-marketing and profiteering are

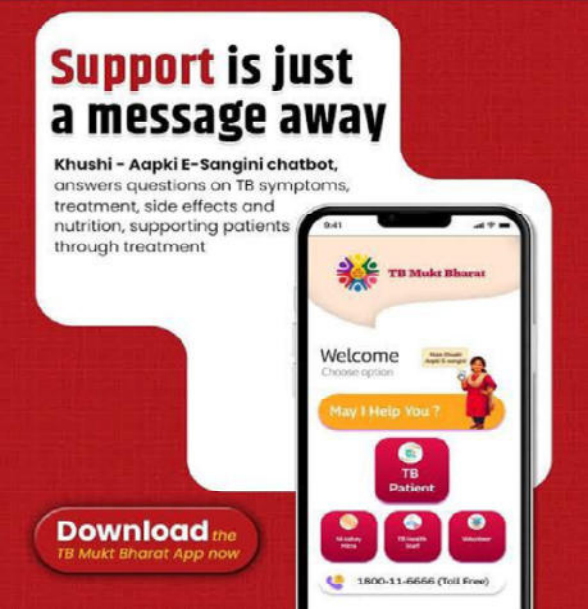
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TB MukT Bharat App launched to enhance TB care, public awareness & community participation

The Central TB Division, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, has launched the TB MukT Bharat App, a digital initiative under the National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP) aimed at strengthening tuberculosis (TB) care, enhancing public awareness, and promoting community participation in TB elimination efforts.

The TB MukT Bharat App is a user-friendly digital platform designed to provide easy access to TB-related information and services. The application supports TB patients in their treatment journey by offering guidance, adherence support, and follow-up assistance. It is also integrated with existing systems such as Nikshay to ensure seamless delivery of



patient-centric services.

In addition to patient support, the app serves as a powerful tool for disseminating accurate information on TB, including its symptoms, prevention, and treatment, thereby helping to reduce stigma and encourage early diagnosis.

A key feature of the

application is the facilitation of community engagement through the Nikshay Mitra initiative. Members of the general public, institutions, corporates, and organizations are encouraged to register as Nikshay Mitras through the app and extend support to TB patients by

DAY-NRLM emerges as a catalyst for rural livelihood transformation: A success story

From Tradition to Enterprise: Women Behind NiCoShe - A Unique SHG Brand of Virgin Coconut Oil



Nancowry, Sept. 6

Long before anyone spoke of brands or business plans, the tribal women of Nancowry Island were already coconut oil makers in their own right. For decades, using methods passed down from their mothers and grandmothers, they had been extracting virgin

coconut oil by hand - for their own kitchens, for local use, and occasionally for sale within their own community. It was skilled, patient work, done the way it had always been done, and it never asked for recognition beyond the household. That quiet tradition was about to

be noticed far beyond Nancowry.

In January 2025, this ancestral craft reached a milestone - the traditional virgin coconut oil of Nancowry was conferred a Geographical Indication (GI) tag, a recognition facilitated by NABARD with the support of A&N

Administration. With that recognition, and with coconuts growing in abundance across Nancowry Island, it became clear that virgin coconut oil could be far more than a household product - it could be the foundation of a genuine, income-generating enterprise for the local tribal women who

already held the skill.

During this period, another important aspect of the journey was unfolding at the grassroots level. The tribal community members who were already producing and selling virgin coconut oil locally in village fairs, but the product was

every state. From 2019 to 2026, properties worth approximately Rs.17,874 crore belonging to fugitives have been sealed or confiscated. The new criminal laws and justice codes have also made the path of legal action against fugitives easier.

Hon'ble Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah said that a systematic mechanism has also been prepared for cyber crimes, which is being monitored by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi Ji himself. Today, the 1930 helpline has become an effective medium for protection against cyber crimes. Success has been achieved in implementing the three new criminal laws up to the police station level through the Ministry of Home Affairs with the cooperation of the states. He said that he thanks the Chief Minister of Goa and the Goa Police for implementing the new Nayaya Sanhita and the three criminal laws in such a short time and raising the conviction rate in the state to 53.2 per cent. This means that there has been an increase of approximately 30 per cent in the rate of securing convictions in registered FIRs.

Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah said that narcotics is a crime that can destroy our future generations. He said that the earnings from narcotics are also used for terrorism. The narco-terror module is active in many countries of the world, and the entire world is today grappling with this problem. He said that since 2019, we have put in place a robust system to curb it. For this, we have changed the systems, caught the networks, broken the financial chain, and also provided handholding to those addicted so as to free them from drugs. Shri Shah said that before 2014, this battle was fought in a piecemeal manner, and satisfaction was derived from making small seizures and catching small accused persons. But since 2019, the Modi government has made this subject a priority of national security. He said that the fight against drugs has moved beyond files and the actions of separate agencies and has now become a coordinated and continuous campaign at the national level. Hon'ble Union Home Minister said that in 2019, a four-tier NCORD mechanism was created. A model for the formation of dedicated Anti-Narcotics Task Forces was sent to all States and Union Territories, and a Joint Coordination Committee was constituted. With the coordination of central agencies, State Governments and their departments, a scientific method was adopted to address large networks, inter-state and international links, and operational gaps. The '1933' Manas helpline was started for the rehabilitation of drug-addicted youth. The cadre of the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) was restructured. A national database of narcotics offenders was created through the NIDAAN portal. Using CCTNS data and integrated data fusion, a data-based map of hotspots, modus operandi and seizures across the country was prepared. A new concept of investigation was adopted with both Bottom-to-Top and Top-to-Bottom approaches. He said that now even if a small packet of drugs is seized, it is examined where it originated from in the country. Similarly, if a large consignment is seized at the border, it is traced how it was going to reach the youth in the form of small packets. In this way, reverse investigation of the entire network has been started.

Shri Amit Shah said that a three-year roadmap from July 2026 to July 2029 has been prepared. A decision has been taken to achieve all targets in a time-bound manner. He said that we are advancing the fight against drugs as one of the biggest national battles of the country. He said that the goal of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is that by 2047, a drug-free youth power should form the foundation of a developed India. To make this mission successful, the Ministry of Home Affairs and all State Governments are working together. He said that the period from 2026 to 2029 has been declared as mission mode. Timelines have been fixed, different ministries have been made accountable, measurable outcomes have been decided, and quarterly reviews along with outcome-based accountability will be ensured. He said that this roadmap is based on four pillars. First-intelligence and operation-based enforcement; second-precursor and synthetic drugs control; third-demand and harm reduction; and fourth-capacity building and coordination. He said that all these pillars together will prepare dossiers of drug kingpins, coordinate on backward-forward linkages, and tighten the noose through financial investigation of every case involving commercial quantities. He said that the BSF, CISF, Indian Coast Guard, Customs and DRI will carry out risk-based profiling and install scanners at land borders, ports, airports and cargo for sharper surveillance. The Hon'ble Home Minister said that the CBI, Ministry of External Affairs and Interpol will bring back the fugitives. The Enforcement Directorate, Financial Intelligence Unit and the banking system will catch the money trail.

being packed with locally available used glass and plastic bottles. Despite the quality and traditional value of the product, the women were earning only a modest Rs.150-200 per litre. The absence of standardized packaging and a common identity limited the product's potential to reach better markets and generate higher returns.

In one of the block-level meetings, the possibility of standardizing the packaging of the product was discussed with SHG members. The tribal SHG women expressed their interest and requested support in procuring suitable packaging bottles. The Block Office, with the support of DAKSHIN Foundation, a local NGO working in the Islands, came forward to facilitate the required packaging support. This became one of the early steps towards transforming a traditionally prepared household product into a more organized and marketable enterprise.

It was also observed that although the virgin coconut oil was being produced using similar traditional practices across different villages and islands within the Block, the product was generally being sold under the name of individual SHGs. There was therefore an opportunity to bring these women together and create a common platform that could give greater strength, identity and bargaining power to their collective effort.

Through a series of discussions, extensive ground-level mobilization and continued interaction with SHG members, the idea of bringing together women from different SHGs, including those located in geographically distant villages, gradually took shape. This collective vision ultimately led to the formation of the Manula Mathai Payuh Producer Group 5 - a platform that brought together SHG women under the DAY-NRLM framework, with a common purpose, collective ownership and an established Bye-Law framework. The brand name of the product was thoughtfully chosen as "NiCoShe" - "Ni" representing the Nicobari community, "Co" for Coconut, and "She" symbolizing the collective efforts of women. The initiative received an honor no one had anticipated. Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi spoke about it in the 118th episode of Mann Ki Baat, praising the way tribal women were being organized into Self Help Groups to produce coconut oil as a meaningful step toward economic independence. For a group that had been formally registered only days earlier, it was an extraordinary, almost overwhelming, start and a moment of immense pride for everyone in Nancowry.

The national attention that followed Mann Ki Baat prompted the initiative to move quickly and deliberately, scaling up institutional support for the group from expert agencies. The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) with the support of District Administration - Nicobars conducted hands-on decentralized training across villages with the support of the Tribal Councils and Village Captains to bring about quality improvement and standardization. Thereafter, the product labelling and brand logo were designed and finalized. Using the revolving funds sanctioned to the SHGs, the labels were printed, giving the product a professional and attractive appearance.

Thus, the unique SHG brand of Virgin Coconut Oil, "NiCoShe," operated and managed by the Manula Mathai Payuh Producer Group, was formally launched during the two-day Block Melacum-Tribal Food Festival held on 15th and 16th August, 2025 at Nancowry.

In order to establish market linkages, the product was introduced through Government emporiums, AVSAR stalls, Sagarika and Samudrika Museum outlets by coordinating with the concerned agencies.

With steady support, teamwork and collective determination, NiCoShe has carved a distinct identity in the islands and continues to scale greater heights. The product was also recently sourced by the Government of India for a Parliamentary Conference in New Delhi, marking a significant recognition of the brand beyond the islands. Further strengthening this journey, the A&N Administration has committed convergence support of Rs.70 lakh in collaboration with the Coconut Development Board, with the assistance of the District Administration, Nicobar, and ICAR-KVK, Car Nicobar, to enhance production, value addition and market reach.

From a modest SHG initiative to a recognised island brand, NiCoShe stands as a testament to what women can achieve when collective effort, institutional support and opportunity come together, a press release from BDO Nancowry said.

N&MA district police intensifies anti-drug drive; Diglipur Police arrest two

North & Middle Andaman District Police continued its sustained anti-drug enforcement drive with two significant operations conducted on 05.09.2026.

Acting on reliable information, a police team led by SI Mohd. Rafique, In-Charge PS Diglipur, intercepted a person near Subashgram and recovered approx. 104 grams of suspected ganja from his

possession. In another operation at Sagar Dweep, police recovered four suspected cannabis plants cultivated behind the house of a resident. Both accused were arrested, and cases were registered at PS Diglipur under the relevant provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985. Further investigation is underway to trace the source of contraband and identify other persons involved, a press release from SP, N&M Andaman said.
