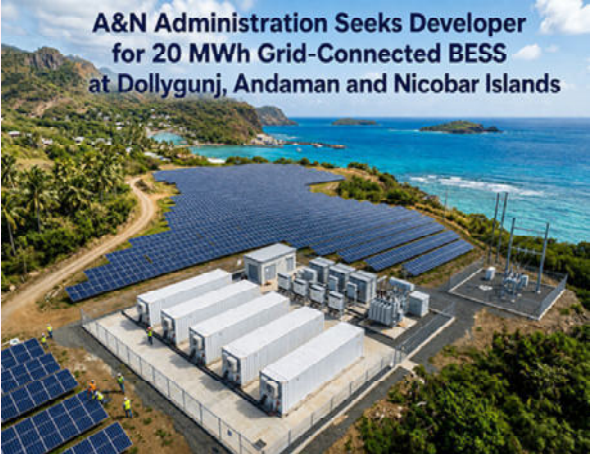
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Andaman and Nicobar Invites Bids for 20 MWh BESS Project Under RESCO Mode

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 5

The Electricity Department, A&N Administration, has floated a tender for developing a 20 MWh grid-connected Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) at Dollygunj, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, on RESCO mode.

The BESS Project shall comprise two subsystems, one with a rating of 4 MW/4 MWh (ESS-1) for grid stability support functions and the other with a rating of 4 MW/16 MWh (ESS-2) for storage and delivery of power. Setting up of both ESS-1 and ESS-2 will constitute one project and will be under the scope of a single BESS

developer (BESSD).

The project must be developed under a build, own and operate (BOO) model and include 12 years of comprehensive operation and maintenance (O&M). The indicative capital cost of the project is INR 60 crore.

Bidders need to furnish INR 1.20 crore as an earnest money deposit (EMD). The selected bidder must deposit INR 3 crore as a performance bank guarantee (PBG).

The last date for submission of bids is September 29, 2026. The techno-commercial

bids will be opened on September 30, 2026.

The total project capacity of 20 MWh BESS must be located in the premises of the 20 MW Solar PV (SPV) plant of NLC India at Dollygunj, Sri Vijaya Puram in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The BESSD must guarantee a minimum system availability of 95 percent on an annual basis. The BESSD must also guarantee AC-to-AC round-trip efficiency (RtE) of 85 percent of the system on a monthly basis.

The net worth of the bidder must be at least INR 10 crore, as on the last date of FY26 or as on the day at least seven

Amendment of A&N Excise Policy, 2013 and launch of online portal for registration of Liquor Brands

The Andaman & Nicobar Excise Policy, 2013 has recently been amended by the A&N Administration with the objective of simplifying and streamlining the licensing and liquor brand registration process, enhancing transparency, promoting ease of doing business and ensuring time-bound disposal of

applications through a digital platform.

The amendments introduce several important measures, including extension of the validity of specified excise licences to three years, introduction of eligibility criteria for registration of liquor brands, and provision for time-bound processing of applications. These

measures are aimed at providing a more transparent, efficient and structured framework for excise-related services and facilitating greater convenience to the stakeholders.

In addition to this, the Excise Department, A&N Administration has launched the Online Portal for Registration of Liquor

Brands, which is now live and operational for online submission and processing of applications relating to liquor brand registration. All concerned stakeholders are requested to make use of the online services available through the official Excise Department portal at https://

Rural women entrepreneurs showcase handcrafted products, agri-produce & traditional delicacies

The two-day Self-Help Group (SHG) Mela being organised by the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Rural Livelihood Mission (ANIRLM), functioning under the aegis of the Department of Rural Development, commenced at Marina Park here today. The

SHG Mela is providing a vibrant platform for rural women artisans and entrepreneurs to showcase and sell their unique handcrafted products, organic agricultural produce and traditional culinary delights.

The initiative reflects the continued efforts of the Department of Rural

Development towards promoting economic independence, strengthening rural livelihoods and empowering women and rural households across the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The mela has attracted visitors with a diverse range of products and local offerings displayed by

Self-Help Groups from different parts of the Islands. About 60 stalls have been setup in the mela. The event also provides an opportunity for citizens to directly connect with and support grassroots entrepreneurs.

The mela will be open to the general public tomorrow (Sept. 6) also from 3 PM to 9 PM.

Secretary (Fisheries) reviews open sea cage culture activities at Chidiyatapu

The Secretary (Fisheries), A&N Administration, along with officials from the Department of Fisheries visited Chidiyatapu, South Andaman, to review the ongoing commercial open sea cage culture projects being undertaken in the Islands and to assess the progress of mariculture initiatives being implemented by private firms.

At present, two firms, namely M/s Aqua

World Exports and M/s Canares Aquaculture LLP, are undertaking cage culture activities at Chidiyatapu at the leased sea area issued by the Department of Fisheries, Andaman and Nicobar Administration. The activities have been taken up with the objective of promoting mariculture, diversification of fisheries activities and sustainable utilization of marine resources in the Islands.

The cage culture



project involves HDPE circular cages of 10-metre diameter under an open sea cage culture system. A total of 8 cages are available. The culture activity is focused on Asian Seabass (Barramundi), a commercially important marine finfish species.

During the visit, the Secretary reviewed the stocking, growth, feeding and cage management practices being followed by the firm. The project commenced with the

initial stocking of approximately 20,000 Asian Seabass fingerlings on 30th May, 2026, with an initial size of about 1.5 inches (approximately 0.4 gram). At present, approximately fishes attained an average body weight of around 150 grams. The fish are being provided high-protein and high-fat feed, with the current feed requirement being approximately 20 kg per day.

Bharat Challenge Track, is being conducted online through the MY Bharat Portal from 17th August to 30th September, 2026. Complex fracture surgery successfully performed at Veterinary Dispensary, Swaraj Dweep

A complex orthopaedic surgical procedure was successfully performed at the Veterinary Dispensary, Swaraj Dweep, by the Senior Veterinary Officer and team on a dog that sustained multiple fractures following an automobile accident. The dog was brought to the Veterinary Dispensary after the accident. Considering the nature of the injuries, surgical intervention was undertaken to restore stability and facilitate



proper healing of the fractured bones.

Under general anaesthesia, both fractures were successfully stabilised using the retrograde and normograde intramedullary pinning technique, an established method of internal fracture fixation in veterinary

orthopaedic surgery. Following fixation, the affected limbs were further immobilised with appropriate supportive bandaging. The animal tolerated the procedure well and has been placed under post-operative care and observation, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

AH&VS distributes Nicobari Fowl to Jarawa PVTG

In a significant initiative aimed at promoting sustainable backyard poultry farming and nutritional support among the Jarawa P a r t i c u l a r l y Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG), the Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, has for the first time distributed 200 indigenous Nicobari fowls to the Jarawa community on 3rd September, 2026 from the Government Poultry Farm, Dollygunj.

The birds were handed over to Shri Aswath, Tribal Welfare Officer, Kadamtala, for further distribution among the Jarawa community. The entire distribution has been made under 100% subsidy by the Department.

The Nicobari fowl has been specifically



chosen because it is an indigenous poultry genetic resource of the A&N Islands and is well adapted to the local hot and humid climatic conditions. Being a hardy backyard bird, it is suitable for rearing under comparatively low-input conditions and can utilise locally available feed resources. The birds can provide both eggs and meat for h o u s e h o l d consumption.

The initiative is

intended to inculcate a sense of domestication among the community and to teach them to rear hens for eggs and meat. The pilot programme will also help assess the adaptability and acceptance of backyard poultry farming among the Jarawa community and explore its potential for s u p p l e m e n t a r y nutrition through availability of fresh eggs and poultry meat, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

The programme was coordinated by Shri. Abdul Arif, Sub-Inspector of Fisheries, with the technical support from Sree Narayan, Ex-Afloat



Section official, Department of Fisheries, as the resource person along with the Sagar Mitra. During the training, participants were provided practical demonstrations and guidance on routine maintenance, basic repairs, troubleshooting and safe operation of marine diesel engines used in fishing vessels. The participants were further imparted practical training on repairing and mending fishing nets, including

identification of damaged portions, basic n e t - m e n d i n g techniques and proper maintenance of fishing gear. On completion of the training, certificates were distributed to all 20 participants, along with essential safety and working inputs such as goggles and hand gloves to promote safe practices during engine maintenance and net-repair activities, a press release from Zonal Fisheries Office, South Andaman said.

expected to reach harvest stage by April 2027, subject to the growth and culture conditions. The s u c c e s s f u l implementation of the project is expected to demonstrate the potential of open sea cage culture as a viable mariculture activity in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands and encourage greater participation in sustainable marine aquaculture.

The Secretary (Fisheries) also reviewed the operational aspects of cage management, including fish growth, feeding practices, stock maintenance and overall site management. The Department emphasized the importance of maintaining proper stocking density, regular monitoring of fish health and growth, scientific feeding practices, cage maintenance and adherence to prescribed environmental and biosecurity measures.



The Department of Fisheries is promoting mariculture activities in the Islands with the aim of enhancing fish production, improving livelihood opportunities for fisheries stakeholders and reducing pressure on wild marine fishery resources. The open sea cage culture initiative at Chidiyatapu represents an important step towards strengthening the mariculture sector and demonstrating the scope for technology-based and sustainable aquaculture practices in the Islands.

The Department of Fisheries is in the process of allotment of more sites for promtion of Mariculture in the form of open cage culture and seaweed culture, with emphasis on sustainable production, environmental responsibility and the long-term development of the fisheries sector. The visit was carried out as per the latest direction issued by Chief Secretary to Secretaries and Directors to make frequent field visit, a press release from Zonal Fisheries Office, South Andaman said.

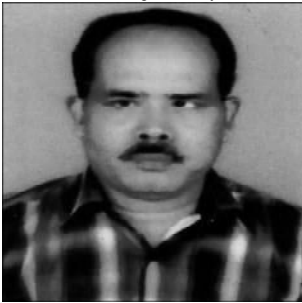
