Ms. Jayalalithaa laid to rest with full state honours

Chennai, Dec 6
Former Tamil Nadu Chief Minister, Ms. Jayalalithaa has been laid to rest, with full state honours in Chennai today. The last rites of the departed leader were performed by her long term associate Sasikala and other close relatives at MGR Memorial, Marina beach.



The 68-year old AIADMK Chief passed away last night at Apollo Hospital. Following her demise, Ms Jayalalithaa's body was taken to her Poes Garden residence before being taken to Rajaji Hall. Lakhs of people from all walks of life paid their last respects to the departed soul.

President Shri Pranab Mukherjee and Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today paid homage to Jayalalithaa by offering flowers at Rajaji Hall in Chennai.

Earlier the President, the Vice President and the Prime Minister expressed grief over the demise of Ms. Jayalalithaa. Several Union Ministers and leaders have mourned the death of Ms. Jayalalithaa.

Both the Houses of Parliament were adjourned for the day today as a mark of respect to Ms. J. Jayalalithaa.

Cyclone caused by depression over Southeast Bay of Bengal declared as 'L1' type Disaster

Port Blair, Dec.6

A severe depression over Southeast Bay of Bengal has formed causing heavy rainfall, strong wind and rough sea conditions, and is likely to continue for the next 48 hours.

The cyclone caused by depression has already hit the A & N Islands on 5th Dec 2016. The worst affected parts are Havelock and Neil Islands which are

separated by approx 40 kms from Port Blair. The only means of transportation are Ship/Boat/Helicopter which have stopped operation since Dec 5, 2016.

About 1400 tourists, who had visited the Islands on previous days are now finding themselves stranded and are unable to return to Port Blair to fly back home.

Meanwhile, the local populace of 10 villages of Havelock & Neil Islands have also been affected severely by the cyclone which has hampered the movement of essential supplies.

Accordingly, the Deputy Commissioner South Andaman has declared this as L1 Disaster as the damage/spread of disaster

Incessant rain lashes Islands; heavy rain forecast for next two days

The A&N Islands experienced heavy and incessant rain since morning today. The Met Office, Shadipur has recorded today's rainfall (8.30 am up to 5.30 pm) at 43.6mm while the progressive rainfall from January 2016 upto date has

been recorded as 3220.9mm. The Scientific Assistant, Met Office, Port Blair, Shri P. K. Mandal, informed that heavy to very heavy rain (7 to 20cm) is likely to occur in few places over Nicobar Islands and heavy rain (7 to 11cm) is likely to occur at isolated places over Andaman Islands coupled

with wind speed of 40 - 50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph with squally weather during the next two days.

As per information from Fire Control Room, Aberdeen Bazaar, the Fire Department has received several calls since morning regarding tree falling in various parts of the

Lifeline Express to have 2 more coaches for cancer treatment

New Delhi, Dec 6
Railway Minister Shri Suresh Prabhu and Health Minister Shri JP Nadda inaugurated augmentation of two additional coaches to the existing five-coach hospital train Lifeline Express in New Delhi today. New coaches will work for the detection and control of oral,

breast and cervical cancer, prevention of stroke and family health services.

These additional services will be provided to augment the existing restorative surgeries conducted for sight, hearing, clefts, burn contractures and orthopedic impairment and treatment of

Epilepsy and Dental problems. Three fully equipped operation theaters will be available for free-of-cost services to the rural poor across country. The augmented Lifeline Express will commence its 178th project at Satna, in Madhya Pradesh from 15th of this month till 5 January of next year.

Petroleum Minister inaugurates 5th International Energy Forum

New Delhi, Dec 6
Petroleum Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan today inaugurated the 5th International Energy Forum (IEF) and the International Gas Union Ministerial Forum in New Delhi. The forum is being held as a parallel event to the 3-day Prototech-2016.

On the occasion, Shri Pradhan said compared to international average, the share of gas in India's primary energy basket is only at about 6.5 percent and the government has set a

target to raise the share from the current level to 15 percent.

Shri Pradhan gave details of the initiatives taken by the government, allowing 100 percent FDI in many segments of the hydrocarbon sector, successful conclusion of open bidding under a new marginal fields policy and introduction of new hydrocarbon exploration licensing policy.

He said, the government is also giving top priority to

allocation of domestically produced gas for city gas distribution and pooling of gas for fertilizer and power plants.

The Minister said the world needs even greater co-operation among countries on gas technologies, such as shale and gas hydrates. Similarly, a number of large Asian LNG buyers, including India, could benefit by joining hands and thereby, possibly, bring in more equitable trade deals.

IMD Director, Ministry of Earth Sciences Secy inaugurate WIFEX 2016-17

New Delhi, Dec 6
Ministry of Earth Sciences Secretary Dr. Madhavan Nair Rajeevan, and Director, Indian Meteorological Department Dr. M. Mohapatra, today inaugurated the Winter Fog Experiment (WIFEX) 2016-17 at Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi.

Speaking on the occasion Dr. Rajeevan said, the presence of heavy fog in the northern regions of the

country is one of the major reasons that leads to delay in flights. Forecast of the fog from the WIFEX model will be made operational for winter 2017-18. Dr. Mohapatra, said, the aim of the observational campaign is to achieve the better understanding of the fog life cycle and improve capability in fog prediction.

Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) is carrying out the multi-institutional initiative during 2016-17 winter.

The fog observational campaign is being conducted at the Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA) with the cooperation and support of airport authority of India and GMR. India Meteorological Department, National Center for Medium Range Weather Forecast and Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER) are participating in the campaign being led by Indian Institute of tropical Meteorology, Pune.

Haryana to launch e-Ticketing system to promote cashless transactions

Chandigarh, Dec 6
Haryana Transport Minister Shri Krishan Lal Panwar has said that his department will soon launch e-Ticketing system to promote cashless transactions in the state.

In the initial phase, this system will be implemented for services operating along the highway routes. In a statement, the Minister said work is being undertaken at a rapid pace to make all departments, including

Transport, high-tech under the 'Digital Haryana' programme. Shri Panwar said, e-Soochna Centres will be established at all bus stands in the state to provide information regarding timetable of buses, routes and tourist destinations.

The first such Centre has been established at Kurukshetra ahead of International Gita Mahotsav-2016. Shri Panwar said option of e-Payment of road tax has also been made available.

Aadhaar cards mandatory for senior citizens to avail concessions on train ticket

New Delhi, Dec 6
From 1st of April next year, reservation of rail tickets for senior citizens will be directly linked to Aadhaar or Unique Identification cards on a mandatory basis for availing concessions at both counter and e-tickets. However, such a requirement will be optional from next month till March.

Chairman and Managing Director of Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC),



Shri AK Manocha said, it is a salutary measure designed to streamline the reservation process for people in such a category.

He said, it is a most

ambitious push to A a d h a a r - b a s e d ecosystem in Indian Railways network that would end fraudulent bookings and curb cases of impersonation.

ISRO to launch Resource Sat-2A on 7th of Dec

Sriharikota, Dec 6
The Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO, will launch PSLV C 36 Resource Sat-2A tomorrow at 10.25 am from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota. The 36-hour count down of the satellite launch started at 10.25 pm yesterday. It is intended to continue the remote sensing data services to global users and would carry similar payloads as carried by its predecessors RESOURCESAT-1 & RESOURCESAT-2.

PSLV-C36 is the thirty eighth flight of ISRO's Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle. It will place the 1,235 kg RESOURCESAT-2A into an 817 km polar Sun Synchronous Orbit PSLV which has emerged as the workhorse launch vehicle of ISRO for launching satellites for international customers. During 1994-2016 period, PSLV has launched a total of 121 satellites. 79 satellites are from abroad and 42 Indian satellites.

INS Sumitra reaches Darwin, Australia



Sydney, Dec 6
In pursuit of India's Act East policy and outreach to friendly countries, the Indian Navy's Offshore Patrol Vessel Sumitra, has reached Darwin, Australia today.

The ship is on her return passage to India after participating in the Royal New Zealand Navy International Naval Review 2016. The three day visit aims at strengthening bilateral ties and enhancing maritime security cooperation between the two countries. During

Patrol Vessels' stay in harbour, various activities are planned towards enhancing cooperation and mutual understanding between the two navies such as professional interactions with Royal Australian Navy and discussions towards further enhancing inter-operability.

In addition, calls on senior government and military authorities, sporting and cultural interactions and sharing of best practices would also be

undertaken. On departure, the ship would also undertake a Passage Exercise with Royal Australian Navy ships. Sumitra, is the fourth of the Saryu class ships, based on an indigenous design.

Since commissioning in 2014, the ship has been deployed for multiple operational tasks, the most notable being Operation Rahat, which entailed the evacuation of personnel of various nationalities from war-torn Yemen in 2015.

higher secondary schools and non provincilised schools who got financial incentives, among others.

Russia, India to hold joint naval drills on December 14-21

New Delhi, Dec 6
The Russian-Indian-INDRA NAVY-2016 naval exercise will be held from 14th to 21st of this month. Russian Eastern Military District spokesman for the Pacific Fleet

Captain 2nd Rank Vladimir Matveyev has said the exercise will be held in the city of Visakhapatnam and in the Bay of Bengal.

The first Russian-Indian naval exercises were held in May 2003.

Maha govt works on 'Maha wallet'

Mumbai, Dec 6
Maharashtra government is working on 'Maha wallet' to encourage cashless transactions. The aim is to mitigate the impact of demonetization on people. Maha wallet will be an e-service where the citizens' money would be secure. State Finance Minister Shri Sudhir Mungantiwar said that he has asked IT department

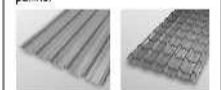

Dhoni may play for India A vs England warm-up games in Mumbai

New Delhi, Dec 6

India's limited overs captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni will hopefully get a chance to play atleast a couple of warm-up matches before the England ODI series starting in Pune on January 15, next year. Before the start of the limited overs series, England are scheduled to play a warm-up matches (50 overs) against an India A on January 10 and 12 at the CCI ground in Mumbai. Dhoni, who has not been playing since the home series against New Zealand in October, would have gone into the ODI series without proper game time for 77 days. Dhoni has been training regularly with the Jharkhand Ranji team which has qualified



for the knock-out stages of the Ranji Trophy. However JSCA secretary Rajesh Verma had made it clear that Dhoni was only a 'mentor' to the team and will not be donning whites since he has already retired from Test cricket. It will be interesting to see

whether the selectors also pick young Rishabh Pant as a back-up or a pure wicketkeeper knowing his big hitting skills in domestic cricket. It will not be a bad idea if both Dhoni and his heir apparent play in the same game which could be a treat for the handful who will be attending the match.

No Roger or Serena but IPTL promises to get bigger

New Delhi, Dec 6

Not having stars such as Roger Federer, Rafael Nadal and Novak Djokovic is a blow to the IPTL, the organisers conceded today but promised to bring back the big names in the future editions. The organiser urged the fans to not forget the good work done in the last two years. After Hyderabad replaced Delhi as the venue for IPTL's India leg this year, none of the big players, save Serena, found a mention in the team roster named earlier. IPTL founder Mahesh Bhupathi had announced that at least one of the 'Big Four' will be there in Hyderabad, but he confirmed today that neither Federer nor Serena will be part of the League due to the "current economic climate" in India, referring to demonetisation. The American legend was named in Singapore Slammers squad. "Yes, it's a huge blow to IPTL but don't forget what has been done in the last two years. People tend to forget the good work. Federer, Rafael and Djokovic have come to India and played. Was it possible before?" Somdev Devvarman,

who is now associated with IPTL, said. Somdev, who has steered India to many a Davis Cup wins with his dogged style of play

but is missing from action due to injury for a long time now, said uncontrollable circumstances have resulted in the absence of stars.

Former FIFA President Sepp Blatter loses appeal against ban

Zurich, Dec 6

Former FIFA President Sepp Blatter has lost his appeal against a six-year ban for ethics violations, imposed amid the biggest corruption scandal to shake the world soccer body. The Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) ruled that Blatter had authorised payments to former European football boss Michel Platini worth more than 2 million US dollars that amounted to undue gifts and therefore violated FIFA's code of ethics. Blatter led FIFA for 17 years, resigning in June last year after several dozen football officials, including FIFA executive committee members and former members, had been indicted in the United States on corruption charges, along with two sports marketing firms. The 80-year old Swiss was not among those indicted, but became embroiled in scandal

when he was banned from all football-related activity the following December by FIFA's Ethics Committee along with Platini, then President of the European soccer body UEFA.

Gill vrooms to second APRC title

Chikkamangaluru, Dec 6

Three days, 225.25 kms of dirt tracks, 450 pages of pace-notes and with at least 10 calls per page later, Gaurav Gill finally laid hands on his second FIA-Asia Pacific Rally Championship title here on Monday evening in emphatic style. He had won it in 2013. Monday's win ensured that Gill is the first ever rallyist to win all the events in a year in the APRC.

tournament. He will next take on fourth seed Wang Tzu Wei of Korea at the Seogwipo Olympic Stadium at Jeju in Korea. A former top 10 player, Kashyap had suffered multiple injuries in the run-up to the Olympics and eventually could not make it to the Rio Games.

Australia Clinch ODI Series Vs New Zealand

Opener David Warner scored a run-a-ball century - 119 from 115 deliveries - to lead Australia to a 116-run victory over New Zealand and a 2-0 win in the three-match one-day international series. Australia scored an imposing total of 378-5 after being sent into bat. New Zealand captain Kane Williamson later scored 81 and Jimmy Neesham added 74 but New Zealand was bowled out

for 262 in the 48th over. Some pre-toss rain induced Williamson to bowl first despite the fact that the small Manuka Oval had been kind to teams batting first in the past five ODIs at the ground - 348, 411, 372, 267 and 329 runs had been put on the board. Australia captain Steve Smith, who scored 164 runs to lead Australia to a 68-run win in Sydney on Sunday in the opening match, scored 72 on Tuesday.
