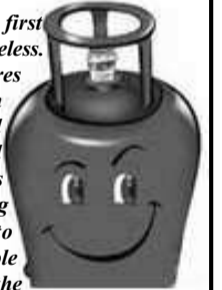

Third successful night landing

GoAir proving flight lands at VSI Airport; to operate chartered flight between Bangalore-Port Blair

First flight on Jan 20

Yet another proving flight, this time GoAir, with its Airbus A-320 neo series aircraft, carried out a successful landing at the Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair tonight (Jan 7, 2016). It may be recalled here that the first two successful night landings of Spice Jet and Air India flights were carried out at VSI Airport, Port Blair on Sept 11, and Oct 27, 2015 respectively.

This night landing facility has become a reality under the dynamic leadership of the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Lt. Gen. A.K. Singh (Retd) and the concerted follow up by the A&N Administration with the support of the Ministry of Civil Aviation, DGCA, A&N Command, Airport Authority of India and Air India which conducted the safety risk assessment for night landing at Port Blair, said the Secretary Civil Aviation, Shri NK Sharma while speaking to 'The Daily Telegrams' here tonight. The Lt. Governor during the 'Khas Mulaqat' programme held at Megapode Resort yesterday had disclosed about this night landing by the GoAir flight tonight (Jan 7). The Administration is trying its best to bring more private Airlines to fly in Andaman sector for which the Civil Aviation Department of the Administration is in constant touch with some of the private airlines, the Lt Governor said amidst a gathering of people from cross section of the society. The Lt. Governor, since taking over the reins of A&N



Islands has been emphasizing the need for opening Port Blair airport for night flights as being very important for the growth and development of these Islands and also for exigencies. The GoAir flight which departed from Bhubaneswar at 8 pm landed at Port Blair at 10 pm and departed for Kolkata at 10.55 pm on Jan 7. The Vice President of GoAir and his technical team were onboard this flight. The Deputy Director, Civil Aviation, Shri Ravichandran, who was present at Veer Savarkar International Airport terminal to receive the flight on behalf of the Administration later

informed 'The Daily Telegrams' that GoAir will commence its scheduled chartered flight service between Bangalore and Port Blair with effect from Jan 20, 2016. It will operate three flights in this sector during January, five flights in February and six flights in March 2016. This service will be night flights. Accordingly, the flight will

**Tournament's 'best shooter'
Chandela wins another gold**

New Delhi, Jan 7
India's Apurvi Chandela shot her way to a second successive gold medal and emerged as the 'Shooter of the Tournament' in the Swedish Cup Grand Prix in Sajsjo, Sweden.

The 23-year-old Chandela shot 208.9 in the final to clinch the top prize in women's 10-metre tri-series event.

Chandela, who had secured a quota for the Rio Olympics, won her first gold medal of the tournament late Tuesday with a world record score of 211.2, to surpass the feat of Chinese Olympic gold medalist Yi Siling (211).

For her outstanding performance in the tournament, the rising shooter was awarded a Walther rifle, besides being crowned the best shooter (men and women combined).

After giving a tough fight to Chandela, Norway's Malin Westerheim won the silver with a score of 208.4, while another shooter



from her country bagged the bronze after managing 186.1.

In qualifications, Chandela shot 416.1 and was on fourth, and fought like a champion to emerge victorious in what was a tri-series match. On the first day on Monday, Chandela was ranked 10th. Having missed the train, she waited unsuccessfully for a bus when the temperature plummeted to -10 degree celsius, before reaching the venue

through a road covered in snow. The result marked a positive start for Chandela ahead of the multi-sport extravaganza in Rio.

Chandela had clinched the gold in the National Championships held last month. She had won an Olympic quota place for India after winning a bronze in the ISSF World Cup in Changwon, Korea in April last year.

Siril Verma tops junior badminton rankings

New Delhi, Jan 7
India's Siril Verma climbed up a whopping 11 places to occupy the number one spot in junior men's singles category in the Badminton World Federation (BWF) rankings issued on Thursday.

Verma, the current world junior championships runners-up and regarded as the next big thing in Indian badminton, is ahead of second placed Toma Junior Popov of France while another Indian Chirag Sen occupies the third spot. Meanwhile, star Indian women's shuttler and London Olympics bronze medalist Saina Nehwal continues to occupy the second spot in the rankings behind Carolina Marin of Spain, while Li Xuerei of China is at the third position. Saina's compatriot and two-time world championship bronze medalist PV Sindhu maintained her 12th position in the new rankings.

Ranchi to host semifinal, final of HIL 2016

New Delhi, Jan 7
Defending champions Ranchi Rays will play host to the semifinals and final of the fourth edition of the Coal India Hockey India League on February 20 and 21 respectively at the Birsa Munda hockey stadium.

The Hockey India League (HIL), the flagship event of Hockey India, is scheduled to be played across six venues in the country starting January 18.

The six franchises battling for supremacy in the richest field hockey league in the world are Jaypee Punjab Warriors, Delhi Waveriders, Kalinga Lancers, Uttar

Pradesh Wizards, Dabang Mumbai and title holders Ranchi Rays, co-owned by India limited overs cricket captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni.

The opening match of the tournament will be played between Kalinga Lancers, who made the biggest buy of the season in German Moritz Fuerste and Uttar Pradesh Wizards, who were able to draft in young Indian forward Akashdeep Singh.

The tournament opener will be staged in Bhubaneswar. Defending champions Ranchi Rays will open their campaign against last year's runners-up Jaypee Punjab Warriors in Chandigarh on January 19.

India to bid for Under-20 World Cup

New Delhi, Jan 7
Encouraged by the renewed interest in football generated by the success of the ISL, India will consider bidding for either the 2019 or the 2021 editions of the under-20 World Cup, revealed the All India Football Federation general secretary Kushal Das.

India will host the under-17 World Cup in 2017, and the AIFF will seek to continue with its grassroots development schemes by giving the junior players another top-level youth tournament.

"We have the infrastructure in place for the under-17 World Cup, and there is a group of very talented footballers who we are getting ready for the tournament. Naturally, the next step will be to bid for the under-

20 World Cup and sustain the momentum of development," said Das, as the AIFF launched a fresh edition of the I-League, which will begin on January 9.

The junior boys, training under German coach Nicolai Adam in the AIFF academy, have the potential to be the future game changers, he said.

"They will be going on a series of exposure trips, starting with South Africa. And I expect them to play in leagues in Europe and Latin America in future," Das said. He said he expected the Indian boys to earn qualification for the under-17 World Cup on merit when India hosts the AFC Asian qualifiers and not utilise the berth reserved for the host country.

Tickets are priced at 20 rupees and will be sold from Saturday. School children and disabled will be permitted entry for free. Last year, over 10 lakh visitors attended the Fair organised by the National Book Trust in association with the Indian Trade Promotion Organisation.
