More than 16,39,000 street bulbs replaced with LED across country under SLNP

New Delhi, Feb 7
More than 16 lakh 39 thousand street bulbs have been replaced with LED Lights throughout the country under Street Lighting National Programme. Power Minister Shri Piyush Goyal informed this in a written reply in the Rajya Sabha yesterday. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi had launched the SLNP on January, 2015 to attain significant savings by promoting LED based

lighting. The scheme is being implemented by Energy Efficiency Services Limited and has target to install 3.5 crore LED street lights in all the Urban Local Bodies by March, 2019. Shri Goyal also informed the Rajya Sabha that out of 18,452 un-electrified villages, more than 11 thousand 900 villages have been electrified under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana.

Electricity Department appeals for judicious consumption of power

Use minimal lights; switch off all non-required gadgets

Port Blair, Feb 7
The Electricity Department is carrying out a load shedding of about 45 minutes to 1 hour during evening peak hours in Port Blair & South Andaman area due to power shortage of around 8 MW. Besides this, additional power cuts are also experienced by the residents due to outage of DG Sets during day time for maintenance purpose. The existing DG Sets are old and are prone for frequent breakdown. The Superintending

Engineer, Electricity Department, in a press release received here today has stated that the Govt. of India as well as the Administration of the UT of A&N Islands have decided to phase out DG Sets completely, hence no new proposal is there to add more DG sets in these Islands. However, for long term solution, the Administration is in a

process of establishing a Gas based Power Plant of 50 MW which will be set up at Hope Town. Apart from this, there is also a proposal for establishing 15 MW Power Plant having a Dual Fuel Engine generator at Phoenix Bay Power House Complex under Grant-in-Aid by Japan International Cooperation Agency. Both these power plants will

however be established during next 3-4 years.

Meanwhile, to cope up with the growing power demand and to meet the present power demand, the Electricity Department has proposed for Short term Procurement of Power through hiring of DG Sets of the order of 10 MW and 05 MW during the current Financial Year till any big

ICC Rankings: Ravichandran Ashwin, Ravindra Jadeja turn rivals in battle for no.1 spot ahead of Bangladesh Test

Dubai, Feb 7
India's star spinner Ravichandran Ashwin would be feeling the heat from his team-mate Ravindra Jadeja as the two spinners take on Bangladesh in a one-off Test in Hyderabad on Thursday. Ashwin is the number-one ranked bowler in the rankings Test bowlers, but Jadeja is breathing down his neck as he is just eight points behind.



It means that if Jadeja outshines Ashwin with the red cricket ball, he can potentially move ahead of the off-spinner, who has been sitting on the top of the tree since bowling India to a comfortable 321 runs victory over New Zealand in Indore in October 2016. Bangladesh's Shakib Al Hasan is the third highest-ranked bowler in (14th place) to feature in the series. He is followed by India's Ishant Sharma (23rd), Mehedi Hasan of Bangladesh (36th), India's Umesh Yadav (37th) and Tajjul Islam of Bangladesh (39th).

JNRM cross country competition

A cross country competition for the students of JNRM was organized by the Department of Physical Education on Feb 4, 2017. 51 boys and 17 girls registered for the competition. In Boys' category the first position was bagged by N. Eswaran, BPES, III year, while the 2nd and 3rd positions went to P. Sathis Kumar, BPES, II year and P. Mohammed Shahid, BA Eco, 1 year. Similarly in girls, the first 3 positions were bagged by Manisha Kumari, BPE II year, Sushmita Biswas, BPES, II year and 3rd Position - Laxmi, Pol. Sci. III year.

In the batting table, India captain Virat Kohli is 58 points behind number-one ranked Steve Smith. Kohli will be aiming to carry his strong form into the Hyderabad Test, which will certainly help him narrow the gap with his Australian opposite number. Other high-ranking batsmen to feature in the Test include Cheteshwar Pujara (12th), Ajinkya Rahane (15th), Shikhar Dhawan (22nd), Murali Vijay (27th), and Virat Kohli (29th).

In the team rankings, number-one ranked India leads ninth-ranked Bangladesh by 58 points. As such, because the rankings are weighted to reflect this difference, Bangladesh's win will earn it five points, while India will drop from 120 points to 118 points.

If India lives up to its ranking and wins the match, then it will earn one point while Bangladesh will drop only one point.

India v Bangladesh Test: Amit Mishra injured, Kuldeep Yadav included

New Delhi, Feb 7
Uncapped Uttar Pradesh left-arm wrist spinner Kuldeep Yadav has earned his maiden call-up to an Indian Test squad following news of Amit Mishra being ruled out of the one-off match against Bangladesh in Hyderabad this week. A BCCI release on Tuesday stated that legspinner Mishra was not available for the Bangladesh Test on account of a knee injury sustained during the third T20I against England last week, and that he requires further medical examination. Mishra played India's last Test, also against England, in December when Haryana team-mate Jayant Yadav was ruled out with injury. Kuldeep, 22, has taken 81 wickets in 22

first-class matches at an average of 18.94 apiece. He finished the recent Ranji Trophy with 35 wickets in eight matches, with a best of 6/79, apart from scoring 466 runs at 35.84 with one century and five half-centuries. This earned him a place in the Rest of India team that won the Irani Cup over Ranji winners Gujarat, in which Kuldeep went wicketless. He has now been added to India's Test squad after a good showing for India A in the practice game versus Bangladesh, taking three wickets including those of Mahmudullah, Soumya Sarkar and Mominul Haque. The solitary Test match starts on Thursday in Hyderabad. This is the first Test visit by Bangladesh to India.

Russia banned from London World Athletics Championships: IAAF

Alpes-Maritimes, Feb 7
Russia will miss August's World Athletics Championships in London after their doping ban was extended on Monday, world governing body president Sebastian Coe said. Coe said Russia, whose 15-month ban from athletics was prolonged at the IAAF's Council meeting in Cap d'Ail near Monaco, could not be reintegrated into the sport before November.

Double Olympic 1500-metre champion Coe was speaking after the IAAF Council approved the Taskforce's recommendation that Russia was "not ready for reinstatement". Russia has been barred from international competition since November 2015 following a

Lyon, Steve O'Keefe turn to spin greets for help ahead of tour to India

Sydney, Feb 7
Nathan Lyon and Steve O'Keefe have sought help from two of Test cricket's greatest off-spinners ahead of Australia's series in India later this month. The front-line pair approached New Zealand's Daniel Vettori and Australia's chief destroyer in Sri Lanka last year, Rangana Herath, for advice ahead of the four-Test tour, which starts on February 23 in Pune. Between them, left-arm spinners Vettori and Herath have captured more than 700 Test wickets and boast outstanding performances in Asia. "The main things you get away from those guys is challenging the batter's defence," O'Keefe told Cricket Australia's website Tuesday from the team's pre-tour training camp in Dubai.

damaging report alleging that state-sponsored doping was rife in the country. The ban had already been extended in March and then June 2016, preventing Russia's athletes from competing at the Rio Olympics. The Taskforce, which was set up to oversee Russia's reintegration into international athletics, produced recommendations detailing a roadmap to reinstatement. But while "acknowledging several positive developments" at recent meetings in Moscow with RusAF, the Russian Athletics Federation, and new Russian Sports Minister Pavel Kolobkov, the Taskforce also "pointed to some negative

developments" including "unhelpful public comments recently made by some Russian sporting officials". It said that RusAF "continues to face practical and legal difficulties in enforcing provisional doping bans and there continues to be very limited testing of Russian track and field athletes at the national level as well as troubling incidents at what testing is taking place". The roadmap to reinstatement specifies that "testing of Russian athletes must take place without further incidents or difficulties" and that RusAF takes "demonstrable objective and practical steps to cultivate the clean sport movement".
