BSNL opens tender to lay undersea cable for A&N Islands Project to equip Islands with unlimited bandwidth and telecom connectivity

Port Blair, Feb.7

The Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd (BSNL) has opened a tender on 6th Feb 2018 for the project of laying of submarine Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) with an estimated cost of Rs. 1102.38 crores which would connect the mainland of Chennai to Andaman and Nicobar Islands. This move will boost internet connectivity in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

The project which was approved by Cabinet in September 2016 will be funded through the Universal Service Obligatory Fund (USOF). The fund is used for providing telecom services in rural areas especially in areas where return on investment is low.

Aadhaar data is completely safe: Minister

New Delhi, Feb 7

There has been no breach of Aadhaar data and a majority of the country's people trust the scheme as it is completely safe, Union IT Minister Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad said today. Terming Aadhaar a game changer, Shri Prasad said in Lok Sabha that as of now 120 crore people have the Aadhaar cards and 57 crore bank accounts were linked with it, which resulted in saving Rs 57,000 crore which otherwise would have been pocketed by some unscrupulous elements. The Minister said Unique Identification Authority of India has a well-designed, multi-layered robust system in place and the same is being constantly upgraded to maintain the highest level of data security and integrity.

project is Rs. 1102.38 crore including operational expenses for 5 years. The materialization of the project will equip Andaman & Nicobar Islands (ANI) with unlimited bandwidth and telecom connectivity for implementation of e-Governance initiatives; establishment of enterprises & e-commerce

facilities. It will also enable the provision of adequate support to educational Institutes for knowledge sharing, availability of job opportunities and fulfill the vision of Digital India. Currently the only medium of providing telecom connectivity between Mainland and Andaman & Nicobar Islands is through

satellites. Satellite bandwidth is very costly and its availability is limited due to which future bandwidth requirement cannot be met solely through it. Then, there is an issue of redundancy, that is, no alternate media

The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar inaugurated the seminar as the chief guest. Dr. Mallika S Ghanti, Vice Chancellor, Kannada University, Hampi presided over the seminar, being organized by the Department of Anthropology & Kannada Language Studies, Vidyaranya, Kannada University, Hampi, Karnataka in collaboration with Department of Tribal Welfare, Govt. of Karnataka, Bengaluru, Akhila Bharatiya Adivasi



Vikasa Parishad, Andaman & Nicobar and Anthropological Survey of India, Kolkata. Inaugurating the seminar, the Chief Secretary said that the subject for the seminar has been the topic of discussion at various fora for many reasons. It demands serious attention towards tribal people for their overall development in the field of education, health and economic activities. There is need to address the issues concerning them and to protect their interest. They must also be involved in the forefront of development, he said mentioning that developments have been taking place at the cost of the tribals, in different parts of the world. Stating that the Islands has

indigenous tribes such as Sentinelese, Jarawa, Great Andamanese, Onges, Shompen and Nicobarese, the Chief Secretary said that policies have been formulated for the protection of these tribes and the Administration is striving to implement those policies. However, Sentinelese are yet to be contacted as they are hostile in nature for the very reason that they are protecting themselves from interference by outsiders. However, efforts are on towards the socio-economic development of the other tribes, he said, highlighting the tribal welfare activities of the Administration. "In the past few years, lot of attentions have been given to the tribal issues and we have now better

understanding of the community", he said. The Chief Secretary appreciated the organizers of the seminar and expressed hope that it will see fruitful discussions, which will help in formulating plans for the tribal communities. Earlier, the chief guest and other dignitaries lit a ritual oil lamp, to inaugurate the seminar. In his keynote address, the Advisor, Social Welfare Department, Bangalore, Dr. E Venkataiah highlighted Karnataka Government's activities for the welfare of

Khelo India to have separate women's Games in future

New Delhi, Feb 7

The Government's ambitious Khelo India Games initiative will be expanded in the next few years to include a separate women's championship, Sports Minister Col Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore announced on Tuesday. Addressing a press conference at the sidelines of the ongoing Khelo India School Games (KISG), Col Rathore said the number of disciplines in the ongoing event will also be increased from the current 16. The KISG will be followed by the College Games.

"There will be encouragement of women's sports and for that there will be a separate championship within the Khelo India. We now have 16 sports in the Khelo India School Games but next year we will increase this number," Col Rathore said. "Unless we create an aspirational level in these Games there cannot be upward movement in Indian sports. Any child in every school can aspire to be in the Khelo India Games and become a hero." The Sports Minister expressed happiness at the standard of competition at the ongoing Games and hoped that it will further improve. "We wanted to create something on the lines of College Games of America. We are proud of the standard we have set which every Khelo India Games will follow in



future. I am happy that this standard was better than we have thought," he said. "Today, the level of performance may not be as high as probably what the international level demands but I am very confident that in three to four years the level of competition will be as high as international level." He said from the organisational point of view the KISG have set a high standard. "This is the first time that the Sports Ministry and the SAI organising such an event, the NSFs have been doing this all along. But I feel we have organised the Games very well so far. "We had earlier planned to hold the the Games next year but then decided to have it this year. Despite this short time, it has been a very good organisation of the Games. We will continue to improve by learning from this edition," said

the Olympic medalist shooter. He said the KISG will provide the "pathway" for the talented youngsters reach the highest level from school and college levels. "All the young children need not wait for the Olympics. With Khelo India, we will have a level similar in organisation with that of Olympics. "You can live with your dream at the first level at Khelo India Games and then in line for podium in Commonwealth and Asian Games. Then, I am sure we will have Olympic medalists. That is the pathway we want to create." At the end of every Games in the next five years, 1000 talented children will be selected and they will be given scholarship of Rs 5 lakh for eight years. The aim is to groom athletes who can win medals in the 2024 and 2028 Olympics. The athletes will be selected by

a panel (Talent Identification Committee) consisting of Arjuna and Dronacharya Awardees in each of the disciplines.

India's U-17 WC star Dheeraj leaves for Scotland

Mumbai, Feb 7

His confidence bolstered after a stint with former England goalkeeper David James, India's U-17 custodian Dheeraj Singh Moirangthem today left for a trial at Scottish Premiership club Motherwell FC.

His training sting is starting from tomorrow. Dheeraj, who manned India's post at the FIFA U-17 World Cup at home last year, quit Indian Arrows, the All India Football Federation's developmental squad playing in the I-League, after the end of his contract on December 31, 2017.

And while Arrows' Portuguese coach Luis Norton de Matos

was disappointed by his decision, a stint with James at Indian Super League (ISL) franchise Kerala Blasters has been encouraging. According to Dheeraj's agent Anuj Kichlu, the 17-year-old goalkeeper from Manipur will train with Motherwell FC's first time.

In case he manages to impress the coaches at Motherwell FC, Dheeraj will still have to wait till July, when he turns 18, to obtain an international transfer. Motherwell's interest in the Indian goalkeeper grew after his impressive showing at the U-17 World Cup.

Dheeraj's trial in Scotland is expected to be for three weeks.

case a candidate belonging to ST/OBC who is selected on the same standards as applied to general category candidates and who appears in the general merit list is treated as own merit candidate. Such candidate is adjusted against general category.

The Short-Listed Candidates will need to undergo Type-Test on Computer tentatively in last week of February 2018. As per notified Recruitment Rules of the post, the required typing speed on Computer is 35 words per minute in English or 30 words per minute in Hindi. The Type-Test will be of qualifying in nature and its marks will not be included in the category wise Provisional Merit list. The Candidates will get their result of the Type-Test at the end of the Test. However those who fail to clear the Type-Test will not be included in the Provisional Merit lists.

The Candidates included in the Provisional Merit lists will be required to submit self-attested copy of their documents with regard to educational qualification, age proof, valid employment registration card, local and category certificates and other testimonials. The Original documents need not be submitted but these are to be produced for verification on a specified date and time. After verification of the original documents, if it is found that he/she is not eligible as per the notified Recruitment Rules then his/her candidature will be rejected irrespective of his/her performance in the written examination and the Typing Test.

Anusha. We will provide the required financial help till she completes her academics," the commissioner said. He said families should encourage girls and women to excel in life and stop the discrimination against them. As per the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act-2006, the marriage of a girl under 18 years of age and a boy below the age of 21 is prohibited, and a punishment of up to two years of imprisonment and Rs 1 lakh fine is imposed on those found guilty, he noted.

West Indies to host first day-night Test at the Kensington Oval

Kensington, Feb 7

West Indies are set to host their first day-night Test at the iconic Kensington Oval in Barbados where they play Sri Lanka on June 23. The occasion will also mark the first time that Sri Lanka play a Test match at the Kensington Oval.

The day-night Test match between West Indies and Sri Lanka will be the third in the series, which start on June 6 at Queen's Park Oval in Trinidad. According to the original schedule announced by Cricket West Indies last year in December, it was the second Test that was scheduled to be held at Kensington Oval and the third was planned at Darren



Sammy Cricket Ground in St. Lucia. However, a release from Sri Lanka Cricket Board suggested that the venues have been swapped for the second and the third Test. The last time Sri Lanka visited West Indies for a Test tour was ten years back which ended in a 1-1 draw. It was a memorable trip for the visitors, who recorded their first win in the

Caribbean. The first day-night Test between Australia and New Zealand in November 2015 has been followed by eight more. West Indies have had an unsuccessful record in the two day-night matches they participated in while Sri Lanka recorded a win when they beat Pakistan on their day-night Test debut.
