India, Nepal committed to stopping misuse of open borders: PM Modi

New Delhi, April 7
 Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has said, India and Nepal have strong relations in the area of security and are committed to stopping misuse of open borders. In a joint media briefing after holding delegation-level talks with Prime Minister of Nepal Mr K P Sharma Oli in New Delhi today, Shri Modi assured that India remains committed to strengthening its partnership with Nepal. He stated that government's vision of 'Sabka Saath Sabka Vikas' is a guiding framework for India's engagement with



its neighbours for a shared vision of inclusive development and prosperity. The Prime Minister said, there is a long history of India's contribution to Nepal's development and assured that it will continue in future. He said, India would like to improve waterways and rail connectivity with Nepal and it has agreed to work towards a new railway line to connect Kathmandu.

Prime Minister Mr Oli stated that his government attaches high importance to further strengthening friendly relations with India. He expressed his government's desire to develop bilateral relations in a way so as to benefit from India's progress and prosperity for economic transformation and development. Three separate joint statements on the key areas of mutual interest - rail linkage, inland waterways and agriculture - were issued after the delegation level talks.  All tobacco products and cigarette packs will have a national toll-free number printed on them from September this year to assist users to quit addiction. The number is -1800112356. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has notified new sets of specified health warnings for all tobacco product packs by making an amendment in the Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Packaging and Labeling) Rules, 2008.



An official release said, the toll-free number will help in creating awareness among tobacco users and give them access to counselling services to effect behaviour change. The text messages that will be printed on the packs are tobacco causes painful death and tobacco causes cancer.

NABARD highlights activities & performance in Isles

Total disbursement during financial year 2017-18 stood at Rs. 2606.44 lakhs

Port Blair, April 7
 Briefing about the initiatives/activities of NABARD for the year 2017-18, the General Manager/Officer in-charge, Shri B. V. S. Prasad in a press briefing recently informed that



NABARD had designed the Micro Entrepreneurship Development Programme, which envisages end to end support to SHG members starting from extending skill training to providing hand holding and final settlement with credit support. Under the MEDP programme, RO had sanctioned 24 projects, against which an amount of Rs.9.68 lakh was released during 2017-18. The total grant assistance released for SHPIs during 2017-18 was Rs.10.46 lakh. He further disclosed that the total disbursement by the Regional Office, including refinance and grants stood at Rs. 2606.44 lakhs as on March 31, 2018. Similarly, achievement under Short Term (SAO) refinance

stood at Rs. 2 lakh and achievement under long term refinance was Rs. 2151 lakhs.

During the Financial Year 2017-18, under 'Go Digital' camps support was extended to 27 rural branches and 7 FLCs of A&NSCB and 12 rural branches and 5 FLCs of SBI for conducting 247 & 110 'Go Digital Camps' respectively. These camps have benefited nearly 10200 rural people across the Islands.

The GM further informed that the 'Gramya Vikas Nidhi' (OFSPF) was set up in NABARD to promote off farm activities like handicrafts, handlooms, village and cottage Industries, small and micro enterprises etc., including capacity building and skill development programmes for target groups.

Similarly, NABARD also provided 3 NGOs with 6 copra drying machines developed in technical collaboration with CIARI and to be used by SHG members, thus helping them in value addition and enhanced price realization for the coconuts produced in their farm. Commonwealth Games 2018: Sathish Kumar wins Gold Medal in Weightlifting

Gold Coast, April 7
Indian weightlifters continued the country's medal rush at the 2018 Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, Australia on Day 3 as Sathish Kumar Sivalingam won the gold medal in the men's 77kg weightlifting category. This is India's third gold and fifth medal overall at the 2018 Games and all have been won by weightlifters. The 25-year-old had won the gold medal in the 2014 Commonwealth Games at Glasgow in Scotland and repeated the feat by beating a stiff challenge from England's



Jack Oliver, who won the silver, on Saturday. Sathish Kumar was crowned the Commonwealth Games 2018 champion after finishing with a combined score (snatch, clean and jerk) of 317. The

bronze medal went to Australian showman Francois Etoundi, who lifted 305kg (136kg+169kg). Etoundi injured his shoulder after his final lift. Sathish started the event with a bang, successfully lifting 136kg in snatch that straightaway put him in the lead. However, England's Oliver, who set his first snatch weight at 141kg, made a successful lift in his first attempt to leapfrog the Indian into top spot. The Indian weightlifter added extra four kgs to his weight and his second attempt successfully lifted 140kg to strengthen his second spot. The Englishman continued to impress and stay ahead of the Indian with a successful lift of 145kg in his second attempt.

Weightlifter Venkat Rahul Ragala wins Gold medal for India

Gold Coast, April 7
Weightlifter Venkat Rahul Ragala claimed India's fourth Gold medal in 85-kg category at 21st Commonwealth Games with a total lift of 338 Kg in Gold Coast today. Earlier, Weightlifter Sathish Sivalingam won India's third gold medal. In the process, the 25-year-old also retained the title he won in the event at the 2014 Games in Glasgow, Scotland with a total lift of 317 kg. In Men's Hockey match against arch-rivals Pakistan,



all the excitement came down to the last seven seconds as the Indian team's perennial problem of conceding late goals left them with a disappointing 2-2 draw

in their opening group fixture after leading 2-nil at half-time. In Badminton, India outplayed Mauritius 3-nil to advance to the semifinals of mixed team event.

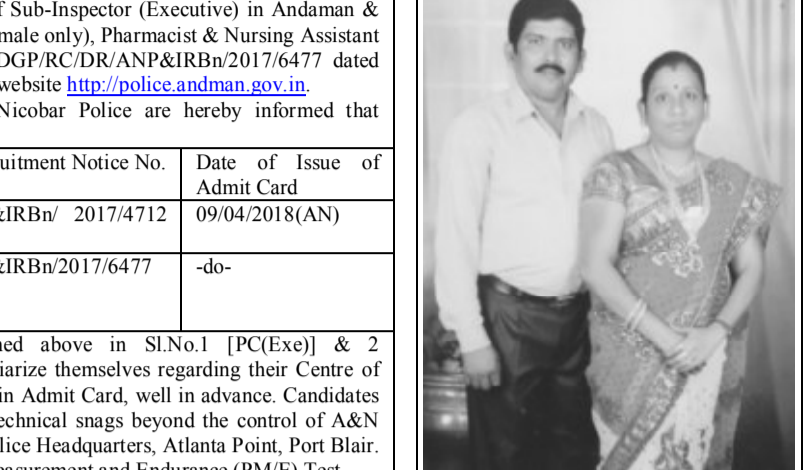
