Thereafter, the Hon'ble Vice President will witness Light & Sound Show at National Memorial Cellular Jail.

As per the itinerary, on August 9, the Hon'ble Vice-President will participate in the 'Har Ghar Tiranga Abhiyaan' by hoisting the National Flag at Flag Point in Sri Vijaya Puram. Thereafter, the Hon'ble Vice President will attend a State Function - 'Tiranga Concert on Vande Mataram' at DBRAIT auditorium. The Hon'ble Vice President will also witness the 'Har Ghar Tiranga Exhibition' set up at the Auditorium premises. A&N Administration simplifies electricity connection process for low-risk consumers

Self-Certification introduced for consumers up to 20 kW to promote Ease of Living & Ease of Doing Business

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 7 Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2023 and based on the recommendations of the Central Electricity Authority and with the approval of the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands, the Administration has permitted a deviation under Regulation 33 by permitting self-attested test reports/self-certification in place of the mandatory certified test reports for low-risk electricity consumers with connected load up to 20 kW. The notification has been published in the Extraordinary Gazette of the Andaman & Nicobar Administration. The initiative is expected to substantially reduce procedural delays, simplify documentation requirements and facilitate faster release of electricity connections to eligible domestic, commercial and other low-risk consumers. By minimizing compliance burden while maintaining safety standards prescribed by the Central Electricity Authority, the Administration has taken another progressive step towards improving

Albendazole Tablet to be administered to all children & adolescents through schools & Anganwadi Centres

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 7 The Government of India is committed towards Anaemia Mukta Bharat and a worm-free future for the children of India. Worm infestation impairs the nutritional status of the children. The nutritional impairment has significant impact on growth and physical development. Worms consume nutrients meant for the human body and cause blood loss, poor nutrition and stunted growth. Due to heavy infection, of children are often too sick or tired to concentrate at school or attend school/Anganwadi. Worm infestations negatively affect children's physical and cognitive development which could have long term negative impact on them. Studies show that absenteeism in schools decreases with regular deworming. In order to reduce the load of intestinal worms which is a major cause of Anaemia and related morbidity in the country, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in co-ordination with Department of Women and Child Development and Department of School Education and Literacy, Government of India has initiated National De-Worming Day (NDD) all over the country, wherein all children and adolescents from 1-19 years of age are given de-worming tablet through the platform of Schools and Anganwadi Centres.

ORDER NO. 887

Whereas, a communication has been received from the Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District, regarding the scheduled visit of the Hon'ble Vice President of India to the Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 08.08.2026 and 09.08.2026, during which he is scheduled to visit various locations within Sri Vijaya Puram, South Andaman District.

And Whereas, adequate security arrangements are required to be made for the visit of the Hon'ble Vice President of India and the operation of remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS)/drones and other aerial activities in the vicinity of vital installations, the VVIP's place of stay and places of visit may pose a potential threat to security and public safety.

And Whereas, I, Purva Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, I am satisfied that sufficient grounds exist for taking immediate preventive measures under Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 to ensure the maintenance of public order and the security of the VVIP during the aforesaid visit.

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, I, Purva Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, hereby order as follows:

1. The flying, operation, or use of all types of Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems (RPAS)/Drones, Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs), and any other similar aerial platforms, as well as all para-jumping/paragliding and other aerial recreational activities, is hereby prohibited in and around the following locations:

- Veer Savarkar International (VSI) Airport;
- Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Institute of Technology (DBRAIT);
- National Memorial Cellular Jail;
- Flag Point;
- Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose (NSCB) Island

2. This prohibition shall remain in force from 08.08.2026 to 09.08.2026 (both days inclusive), or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

3. Any person found violating this order shall be liable for action under Section 223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, in addition to any other applicable provisions of law, including the relevant provisions governing civil aviation and unmanned aircraft operations.

4. Considering the emergent nature of the matter and the requirement for immediate preventive action, this order is issued ex parte and shall come into force with immediate effect.

5. This order shall be promulgated by affixing copies on the Notice Board of the Office of the District Magistrate, South Andaman District, and the District Court, Sri Vijaya Puram, and shall also be given wide publicity through the Directorate of Information, Publicity & Tourism, A&N Administration, and by publication in local newspapers having circulation in the district.

Scheme and avail its incentives and benefits. The Government provides substantial financial assistance towards certification, with 80% subsidy for Micro Enterprises, 60% subsidy for Small Enterprises and 50% subsidy for Medium Enterprises. In addition, an extra 10% subsidy is available for MSMEs owned by Women or SC/ST entrepreneurs and those located in Island Territories, North Eastern Region, Himalayan Region, LWE areas and Aspirational Districts. A further 5% subsidy is available for MSMEs covered under the SFURTI and MSE-CDP programmes.

To encourage participation, a Joining Reward of Rs.10,000 is provided after taking the ZED Pledge, which can be utilized towards certification expenses within the prescribed period. Further, MSMEs securing a minimum Bronze Certification are eligible for handholding and consultancy support up to Rs 5.00 lakh. Out of this, up to Rs. 2.00 lakh may be utilized for consultancy and handholding support through approved consulting organizations, while up to Rs. 3.00 lakh may be utilized for technology upgradation, pollution control measures, cleaner technologies and other Zero Effect solutions, subject to the recommendations of the Consultant, verification by the concerned MSME Development Institute and approval by the Project Monitoring and Advisory Committee (PMAC).

Under the certification process, MSMEs are required to first take the ZED Pledge and thereafter submit an online application for the desired certification level. The enterprise must comply with all the prescribed requirements of the selected level. In case any non-conformities are identified during assessment, sufficient opportunity is provided to rectify them within the stipulated period. The final certification is awarded based on the recommendations of the Accredited Assessment Agencies. The Ministry of MSME may also conduct post-certification inspections of MSMEs that have availed benefits under the Scheme.
